

# A Letter to The Prophets Chair

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First why is your name not on your web site?

Second you do have some good stuff on Noah's Ark and the Giants of Genesis 6 which I have also on my site. However there are some things I must disagree with you on.

You have stated in many occasions the written word you refer to as the Word of God when in fact “the Word” of God is always a reference to the Lord Jesus Christ (John 1:1, 14; 1 John 1:1, 1 John 5:7; Revelation 19:13). The Bible or the scriptures are always referred to in the Bible as “the word” or “the words” of God. This defining difference designates the Lord as the incarnate “Word” whilst the written “word” is not personified making the distinction. There is; however as you point out, a connection between them but also there is a line drawn so that they are not the same at all. When referring to the written script of the Bible as “the word” the Biblical lower case should be used else you are calling the Bible: “the Lord Jesus Christ.” You can spill milk on the Bible which is the very words of the Living God; but you cannot spill milk on the Lord Jesus Christ. Well then, don't cry over that spilt milk, you can just go out and buy another Bible; but you will NEVER buy the Lord Jesus Christ. There is a distinction between them.

Notice all the references where the word “Word” is capitalized are always a reference to the pre-incarnate Lord Jesus Christ. Eating Jesus Christ is synonymous with ingesting the words that he the Word said because the words that He spoke they are spirit and they are life. John 6:63, “It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the **words** that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.” So we see that eating the Bible is likened to eating food is important for spiritual growth and this is why the devil attacks the words of God throughout the Bible.

1. Bread: Deuteronomy 8:3; Amos 8:11; Matthew 4:4; Luke 4:4; John 6:35, 48
2. Meat: Hebrews 5:12 & 14
3. Milk: Hebrews 5:13; 1 Peter 2:2
4. Honey: Psalms 119:103; Revelation 10:9
5. Water: Amos 8:11; Ephesians 5:26

6. Eat the words: Jeremiah 15:16
7. Words better than food: Job 23:12

This is why the modern Bibles after 1881 are corrupt: they are from the Alexandrian manuscript text base and not the Antiochian text base where they were first called Christians. Alexandria is in Egypt and the Bible warns against going down to Egypt to get answers. Isaiah 30:1-3, “Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but **not of my spirit**, that they may add sin to sin: That walk to go down into Egypt, and **have not asked at my mouth**; to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to trust in the shadow of Egypt! Therefore shall the strength of Pharaoh be your shame, and **the trust in the shadow of Egypt your confusion**.” However God is NOT the author of confusion:

1 Corinthians 14:32-33, “And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets. For **God is not the author of confusion**, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.” God IS an author of something: Hebrews 5:9-14, “And being made perfect, **he became the author of eternal salvation** unto all them that obey him; Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec. Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull of hearing. For when for the time **ye ought to be teachers**, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have **need of milk**, and **not of strong meat**. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But **strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age**, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.” God not only authored the Authorized Bible but the Bible is God’s record: 1 John 5:10-13, “He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: **he that believeth not** God hath **made him a liar**; because he **believeth not the record that God gave** of his Son. And **this is the record**, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. **These things have I written unto you** that believe on the name of the Son of God; **that ye may know that ye have eternal life**, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.”

The NIV, NASV, NRSV, ESV, YLT and the NKJV are all perpetrated based on the Egyptian manuscripts. Alexandria, Egypt: Acts 6:9, “Then there arose certain of the synagogue, which is called **the synagogue of the Libertines**, and Cyrenians,

and **Alexandrians**, and of them of Cilicia and of Asia, **disputing with Stephen.**” A Libertine is a person, especially a man, who behaves without moral principles or a sense of responsibility, especially in sexual matters. Synonyms: philanderer, playboy, rake, roué, Don Juan, Lothario, Casanova, etc. The Alexandrians were Libertines! This is where the word Liberal comes from. The scholars claim that “the oldest” is “the best”; and yet there is no Biblical proof of this rule. The rules of textual criticism start with treating the sacred text like any other text. The rules are paganistic, unbiblical and ridiculous. “Oldest” is not a criterion for “best” any more than “what I like” is a criterion for “right”.

It is important to believe the record that God gave and that it is not in error: 1 John 4:1-3, “Beloved, **believe not every spirit**, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.” And 1 John 4:6, “We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we **the spirit of truth**, and **the spirit of error.**” When you say there is an error in the Bible you are saying that **the spirit of error** which is the same as **the spirit of antichrist** has altered the text and messed it up. Yet God has promised to preserve His words: Psalms 12:6-7, “**The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.**” With Psalms 119:89. “**For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.**” And Psalms 119:160, “Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments **endureth for ever.**” And Isaiah 40:8, “The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but **the word of our God shall stand for ever.**” And 1 Peter 1:23-25, “Being born again, **not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.** For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But **the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.**” If there is an error in the Bible, then there is a lie in the truth. There MUST be one Bible that is pure and 100 % TRUE! 1 John 2:21, “I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but **because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth.**”

Truth, to be true by its very virtue must be 100 % true; else it would be a lie. Second thing is that “things that are not the same: are different.” Ergo “Things that are not the same: are not equal.” Now I know that sounds elementary, but when dealing with the most important issue in the world we must be careful to understand what the Truth of God actually IS if it is available and can I get a copy of it? Can I trust that it is completely perfect and without error? If not then God is a liar and lied, right? NO? Ok then where is IT?

However, God is not a liar. God gave you His record. Truth must be virtuous. A lie can be 99.9 % true. But truth must be 100 %. Now did God give us ONE Bible or many? Did God give us ONE truth or many truths? Which one do you follow? Which one do you BELIEVE? Which one do you trust is telling you the truth?

Your soul depends on the truth from the Bible telling you about the very gospel. If the Bible is not true in one place how can you trust it to be true any other place? If there is an error that you have found in the Bible: you should always vindicate the Bible and not the so called error. If you think you have found an error in the Bible: no doubt the error is with you. I say this because I am a Bible Believer.

In the case of “let” and “letteth” meaning allow or disallow: you missed the reference in the context: 2 Thessalonians 2:6-7, “And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.” You do know that the word for “withholdeth” is the same word for “letteth”? However, why did they use “letteth” instead of using what they just already used in translating as “withholdeth” if that were a problem unless there is a supernatural reason? When something is withholden from doing something that is also the same as allowing something else: so withholding and letting or allowing can happen at the same time. Besides all that when the “taking out of the way” happens then there actually IS an allowance and therefore letteth is actually more accurate in that context with the opposite being in the previous verse withhold. So as in the verse there is the allowing when the withholding is taken out of the way and is let to do it. Furthermore to “let” is the same as when leasing. You allow someone to lease from you, while at the same time you disallow ownership. Let in this case can be used both ways at the same time. It is not a mistake: it is advanced revelation in the King James Bible. God’s ways are far above our ways.

One last thing to think about: God told you already which Bible to BELIEVE: He told you the name of that Bible and the date that it would be given: Isaiah 41:21, “Produce your cause, saith the LORD; bring forth your strong reasons, saith the **King of Jacob.**” 1 Chronicles **16:11**, “**Seek the LORD** and his strength, seek his face **continually.**” And Psalms **16:11**, “Thou wilt **shew me the path of life:** in thy presence is fulness of joy; **at thy right hand** there are pleasures for evermore.” And Proverbs **16:11**, “**A just weight and balance are the LORD'S:** all the weights of the bag are his work.” (Look at 1 John 4:2-3 for a just weight and compare the KJB with the modern unjust weight versions) Going into battle with a butter knife is what a Christian is doing with an NIV or ESV or any modernist perversion.

9 is the number for fruits of the Spirit: There are 54 fruits in 9 passages with 9 fruits in each passage making 81. Subtracting the duplicates 27 leaves 54 total fruits of the Spirit: notice the numbers:  $9: 5+4=9$ ;  $2+7=9$ ;  $8+1=9$ ! SO, 1611:  $1+6+1+1=9$  and King James! 9 Letters! Holy Bible! 9 Letters! The Bible that produces the Fruits of the Spirit in your life!

I am a Bible Believer and the Lord God Almighty showed me that the King James Bible is God’s Authorized Version indisputably the Absolute Truth without any proven error. IF you think you have found an error in the Holy Bible: why then call it HOLY?

Get back to the BOOK and hear it, read it, study it, memorize it, meditate on it and KNOW it, but most importantly BELIEVE it 100%!
