Isaiah 66:15-16, “For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by his sword will the LORD plead with all flesh: and the slain of the LORD shall be many.” => Revelation 19:19-21, “And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.”

Isaiah 66:22, “For as the new heavens and the new earth...” => Revelation 21:1, “And I saw a new heaven and a new earth...” and Revelation 22:1-21.

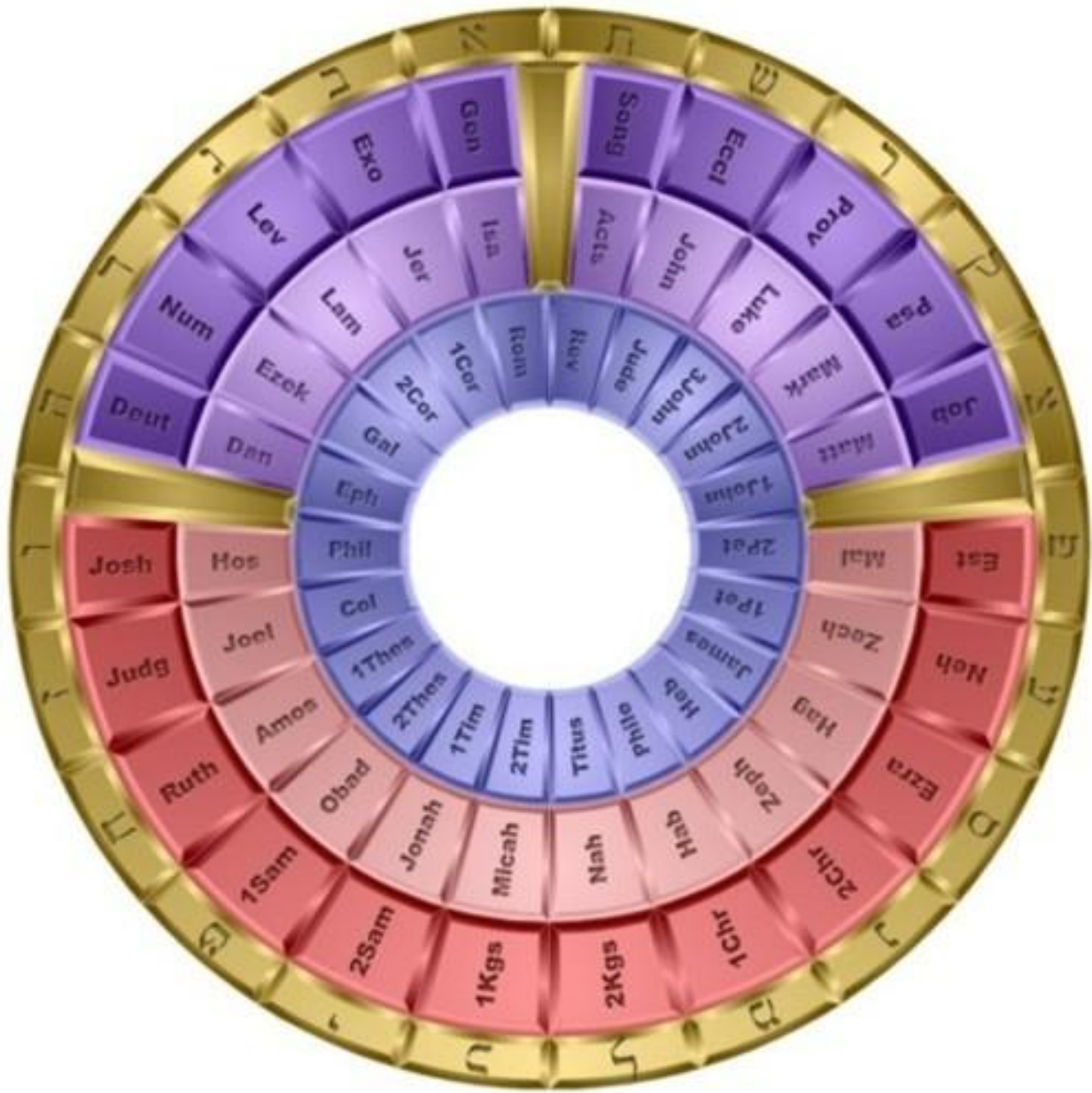
## The Circle of the Bible: 22 X 3 = 66

The Bible is divided in by 3 with the Hebrew alphabet of 22 letters and the book of Psalms chapter 119 which is about the word of God. Each letter in that Psalms gets eight verses and each verse starts with the letter of the alphabet group in Hebrew. So you have a number of maps that tells us not only how many books are in the Bible; but the divisions with Isaiah’s split between testaments and Psalms divisions of the groups with the Hebrew letters.

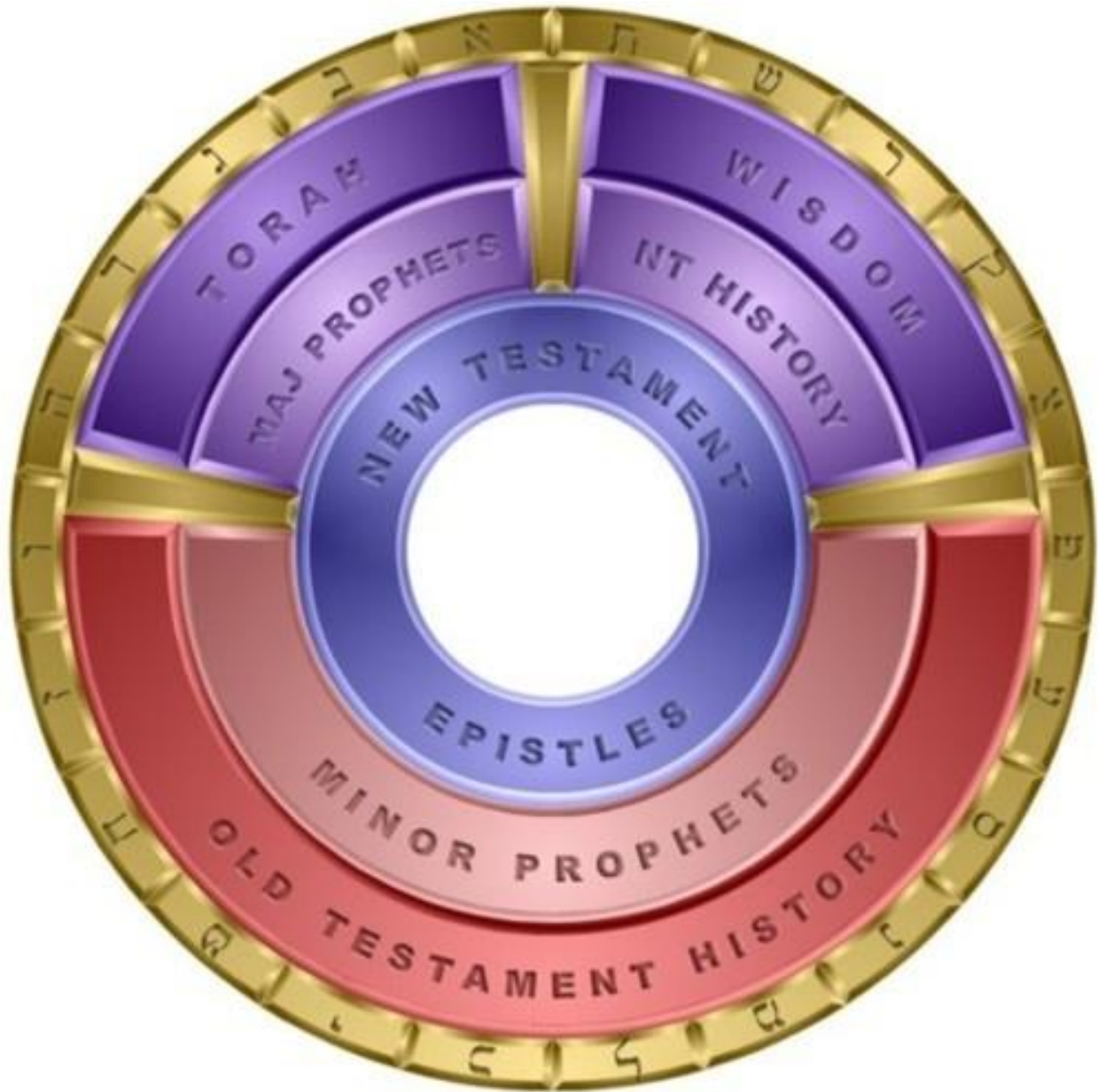

## Our Bible:

Any more books or less books these things would not map the Bible. There are proofs as to the historic account to the Biblical text as we have it in the King James Bible. It is the standard from which all other versions are compared. It is commonly called the Authorized Version. It is the only Bible that has lasted for over 400 years. It has passed this test of time and the test of 3 Maps within the Biblical text itself. The word of God are the words of God, they are inspired and preserved in English in the King James Bible. Rome had nothing to do with these revelations and they had nothing to do with the making of the Bible as we have it today. Rome tried to keep the Bible from the common man. Rome killed people for believing

in the Lord Jesus Christ and not their wafer god. God ordained the maps in the Bible so we would not be under a Roman tyranny either by a Caesar or Popery.

There are seven generations of the Bible and God preserved the seventh: Psalms 12:6-7, “The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.”

2 Timothy 3:15-17, “And that from a child thou hast known **the holy scriptures**, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. **All scripture is given by inspiration** of God, and is profitable for **doctrine**, for **reproof**, for **correction**, for **instruction in righteousness**: That the man of God may be **perfect, thoroughly furnished** unto all good works.”

2 Peter 1:17-21, “For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such **a voice to him** from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. And **this voice which came from heaven we heard**, when we were with him in the holy mount. **We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed**, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: Knowing this first, **that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation**. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.”

1 Thessalonians 2:13, “For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, **when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.**”
