How to get a Grasp on the word of God

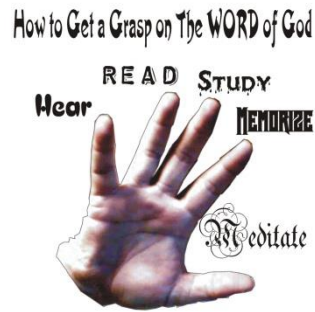

DON'T Ever Let Go!

1. Hear:
 - a. Joshua 3:9, “And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, Come hither, and hear the words of the LORD your God.”
 - b. John 8:47, “He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.”
 - c. Romans 10:17, “So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”
2. Read:
 - a. Nehemiah 8:8, “So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading.”
 - b. Jeremiah 36:23, “And it came to pass, that when Jehudi had read three or four leaves, he cut it with the penknife, and cast it into the fire that was on the hearth, until all the roll was consumed in the fire that was on the hearth.”
 - c. Acts 8:30, “And Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest?”
3. Study:
 - a. 2 Timothy 2:15, “Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”
 - b. John 5:39, “Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.”

- c. Acts 17:11, “These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.”
4. Memorize:
- a. Psalms 119:11, “Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.”
 - b. 1 Peter 3:15, “But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:”
 - c. Romans 12:2, “And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.”
5. Meditate:
- a. Psalms 1:2, “But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.”
 - b. Joshua 1:8, “This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.”
 - c. 1 Timothy 4:15, “Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.”
6. Preach:
- a. 2 Timothy 4:2, “Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.”
 - b. 1 Corinthians 1:18, “For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.”
 - c. 1 Corinthians 9:16, “For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!”
7. Teach:
- a. 2 Timothy 2:2, “And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.”
 - b. Hebrews 5:12, “For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.”
 - c. 2 Peter 2:1, “But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.”

The first 5 will help you get a grasp on the word of God to equip you to do the last 2. Also by doing the last two, you will maintain and excel even more on your grasp of the word of God. The equipment of our warfare are the word of God, but all will be lost if you do not BELIEVE the words of God. You MUST believe what God said to get saved to begin with:

- a. Admit you are a sinner before a Holy God.
- b. Believe on Jesus Christ to save your soul from hell fire when you die.
- c. Confess Jesus Christ in prayer to God about what you now believe.

Now you are ready to get a grasp on the word of God, start from the top again and read this study.
