The WIV is a Pagan Fatalistic Version

(New IV; 4? Ivy? Intra-Venous? Inter-Venomous?)

The trouble with the Calvinistic pagan fatalist is that they view the Bible through the goo-goo goggles of Calvinism. So when they are shown the Bible they "understand" it in light of their Calvinistic understandings. Luke 11:35, "Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness."

Here is the Calvinists starting gate prior to their pentagram points of pagan fatalism:

Ephesians 1:4-6, "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved."

The Calvinists reads this: "According as the sovereign God hath chosen us prior to the creation of the earth to get in the sovereign God, that later we should become holy and without blame at the last judgment in love because we are predestined unto heaven by Jesus Christ as children to the sovereign God being elected, according to the forced good pleasure of the sovereign God's predetermined will, To the praise of the sovereign glory of sovereign God's foreordained sovereign graces, wherein the sovereign God hath forced us to accept the sovereign beloved of sovereignty."

The Calvinist is a fatalistic pagan. They will alter the Bible to suit their teachings and use the Bible you use to pervert YOU. The actual Calvinistic Bible is the NIV. The word "sovereign" is not in the King James Bible. The NIV has "Sovereign" in it 297 times and replaces the word "God" in most of those place.

Other replacements aside from replacing God: Ruleth is replaced with sovereign; kingdom is replace with kingdoms; men is replaced with earth; it is replaced with them:

Daniel 4:17, "The decision is announced by messengers, the holy ones declare the verdict, so that the living may know that the Most High is **sovereign** over all

<u>kingdoms</u> on <u>earth</u> and gives <u>them</u> to anyone he wishes and sets over them the lowliest of people." NIV

Daniel 4:17, "This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High **ruleth** in the **kingdom** of **men**, and giveth **it** to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men." KJB

Know is altered to Acknowledge; ruleth is altered to sovereign over; kingdom is altered to kingdoms; men is altered to earth and will is altered to wishes:

Daniel 4:25, "You will be driven away from people and will live with the wild animals; you will eat grass like the ox and be drenched with the dew of heaven. Seven times will pass by for you until you <u>acknowledge</u> that the Most High <u>is</u> <u>sovereign</u> over all <u>kingdoms</u> on <u>earth</u> and gives them to anyone he <u>wishes</u>." NIV

Daniel 4:25, "That they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over thee, till thou **know** that the most High **ruleth** in the **kingdom** of **men**, and giveth it to whomsoever he **will**." KJB

Know is altered to Acknowledge; ruleth is altered to sovereign over; kingdom is altered to kingdoms; men is altered to earth and will is altered to wishes:

Daniel 4:32. "You will be driven away from people and will live with the wild animals; you will eat grass like the ox. Seven times will pass by for you until you **acknowledge** that the Most High is **sovereign** over all **kingdoms** on **earth** and gives them to anyone he **wishes**." NIV

Daniel 4:32, "And they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field: they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and seven times shall pass over thee, until thou **know** that the most High **ruleth** in the **kingdom** of **men**, and giveth it to whomsoever he **will**." KJB

Notice here that God is not called sovereign even though most passages where this shows up it would be a place where a good Calvinist would alter this to sovereign however because they are wanting to alter a kingdom to sovereignty it would sound very strange to give God's sovereignty to Nebuchadnezzar but there you go God relinquished His kingly status and gave it to men. God retained His Almighty Power. Sovereignty therefore does not even matter to God:

Daniel 5:18, "Your Majesty, the Most High God gave your father Nebuchadnezzar **sovereignty** and **greatness** and **glory** and **splendor**." NIV

Daniel 5:18, "O thou king, the most high God gave Nebuchadnezzar thy father **a kingdom**, and **majesty**, and **glory**, and **honour**:" KJB

Sovereign replaces ruled; acknowledged replaces knew; kingdoms replaces kingdom; earth replaces men and wishes replaces will:

Daniel 5:21, "He was driven away from people and given the mind of an animal; he lived with the wild donkeys and ate grass like the ox; and his body was drenched with the dew of heaven, until he <u>acknowledged</u> that the Most High God is <u>sovereign</u> over all <u>kingdoms</u> on <u>earth</u> and sets over them anyone he <u>wishes</u>."

Daniel 5:21, "And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling was with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; till he **knew** that the most high God **ruled** in the **kingdom** of **men**, and that he appointeth over it whomsoever he **will**." KJB

Most Calvinist I talk to would disagree with this statement that He was given "sovereign power" because He already has it. That kind of thing puts a blot on the sovereign graces of Calvinism. But the fact is Jesus Christ is given a kingdom like the Holy Bible says:

Daniel 7:14, "He was given <u>authority</u>, glory and <u>sovereign power</u>; all nations and peoples of every language <u>worshiped</u> him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed." NIV

Daniel 7:14, "And there was given him <u>dominion</u>, and glory, and <u>a kingdom</u>, that all people, nations, and languages, <u>should serve him</u>: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed." KJB

Kingdom is replaced with sovereignty, kingdom is replaced with kingdoms; dominion is replace with rulers and serve is replaced with worship:

Daniel 7:27, "Then the **sovereignty**, **power** and greatness of all the **kingdoms** under heaven will be handed over to the holy people of the Most High. **His**

<u>kingdom</u> will be an everlasting kingdom, and all **<u>rulers</u>** will **<u>worship</u>** and obey him." NIV

Daniel 7:27, "And the <u>kingdom</u> and <u>dominion</u>, and the greatness of the <u>kingdom</u> under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, <u>whose</u> kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all <u>dominions</u> shall <u>serve</u> and obey him." KJB

Sovereign is in the title; but there is something else going on it the verse:

Romans 9:6, "[God's **Sovereign** Choice] It is not as though God's word had **failed**. For **not all who are descended from Israel are Israel**." NIV

Romans 9:6, "Not as though the word of God hath <u>taken none effect</u>. For <u>they are</u> <u>not all Israel</u>, which <u>are of Israel</u>:" KJB

Sovereign is ADDED to the text; and they are also teaching that if you deny the sovereign Lord that you are a false prophet or a false teacher but then minimize the issue calling it destructive heresies instead of damnable heresies. Calvinism's teaching IS dimmable heresy:

2 Peter 2:1, "[False Teachers and Their Destruction] But there were also <u>false</u> <u>prophets</u> among the people, just as there will be <u>false teachers</u> among you. They will secretly introduce <u>destructive heresies</u>, even <u>denying the sovereign Lord</u> who bought them—bringing swift destruction on themselves." NIV

2 Peter 2:1, "But there were <u>false prophets</u> also among the people, even as there shall be <u>false teachers</u> among you, who privily shall bring in <u>damnable heresies</u>, even <u>denying the Lord</u> that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction." KJB

Here God is replaced with Sovereign again; and here this is saying that if you deny Jesus Christ our only Sovereign Lord that you are ungodly and condemned etc.:

Jude 1:4, "For certain individuals whose condemnation was written about long ago have secretly slipped in among you. They are ungodly people, who **pervert the grace of our God into a license for immorality** and **deny Jesus Christ our only Sovereign and Lord**." NIV

Jude 1:4, "For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, <u>turning the grace of our God into</u>



<u>lasciviousness</u>, and <u>denying the only Lord God</u>, and <u>our Lord Jesus Christ</u>."

Sovereign is added:

Revelation 6:10, "They called out in a loud voice, "How long, **Sovereign Lord**, holy and true, **until** you judge the inhabitants of the earth and avenge our blood?" NIV

Revelation 6:10, "And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O <u>Lord</u>, holy and true, dost thou <u>not</u> judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?" KJB

Calvinism in the King James Bible:

Revelation 13:8, "And all that dwell upon the earth <u>shall worship him</u>, <u>whose</u> <u>names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the</u> <u>foundation of the world</u>." KJB

Revelation 13:8, "All inhabitants of the earth <u>will worship the beast</u>—all <u>whose</u> <u>names have not been written in the Lamb's book of life, the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world."</u> NIV

Private interpretation of the NIV: the Lamb was NOT slain from the creation of the world! That is NOT what the Holy Bible SAYS! Names were not written in the book of life from the creation of the world. These are private interpretations of the Calvinist. The problem is that they are WORSHIPING the BEAST; their names are not IN the book of life because they were blotted out. The Lamb slain was Jesus Christ at Calvary: and "from the foundation of the world" has nothing to do with "prior to the creation of earth". He was slain in front of the very foundation of the world: everyone there saw it take place in time even the spirit world. The place in TIME when it happened was almost 2000 years ago. This did not take place prior to the creation of the earth! Err-duh!

Revelation 17:8, "The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is." KJB

Revelation 17:8, "<u>The beast</u>, which you saw, once was, now is not, and yet will **come up out of the Abyss** and go to its **destruction**. The inhabitants of the earth **whose names have not been written in the book of life from the <u>creation</u> of the**

world will be astonished when they see the beast, because it once was, now is not, and yet will come." NIV

Again the above is another private interpretation from the Calvinist. In the Holy Bible these people shall wonder WHEN BEHOLDING THE BEAST: whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world or as Calvin would put it: "...whose names have not been written in the book of life from the creation of the world..." This will be the LIE of the Beast to keep those people in darkness and without hope so that they take his mark. The Beast is a Calvinist!

The reason why the word Sovereign is NOT in the King James Bible:

Luke 4:5-7, "And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, <u>shewed unto</u> <u>him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time</u>. And the devil said unto him, <u>All this power will I give thee</u>, and <u>the glory of them</u>: <u>for that is delivered</u> <u>unto me</u>; <u>and to whomsoever I will I give it</u>. If thou therefore wilt worship me, <u>all shall be thine</u>."

God is Almighty and by this nature God can relinquish his Kingship (sovereignty) over His creation and still remain Almighty with no consequences other than that God's will; will be done regardless of anyone's sovereignty: even Satan.

New IV is the new 4. And it grows like ivy complete with poison. It will go intravenous like a poison inside which is inter venomous and it will attack every part of your being. The New 4 is the New World Order as 4 is the number of the world the NIV will have trouble with the world and adherents will have worldly troubles. They will think Christ died prior to the creation of the earth! They will think some people were not written in the book of life prior to the creation of the earth and by this follow Satan right into the Tribulation because they were trusting in their Election prior to the creation of the earth and for God to choose Christ FOR THEM instead of them receiving Christ as their personal savior and so they either died in their sin or they miss the Rapture and wind up in the Tribulation and there the Antichrist (the Beast) uses the Bible to show them that they were never in the elect after all and there is no hope so it doesn't matter if you take the mark or not so go ahead and take it so you can buy and sell! Pft!

The NIV is a Calvinistic Antichrist version while the King James Bible is the TRUTH.
