THE QUESTION WAS:

66Will God Put Me in Hell

For Using a Modern Version

of The Bible?"

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Answer:

It's not like that. God condemns people to hell for not receiving his Son. As a Christian you can not lose your salvation: it would be like God saying YOU are no longer my son! IMPOSSIBLE! SO, no you're not damned for reading the "new" versions, I read them! I use them to show how wicked they are! You only have to answer to God for your SON-SHIP! Being a good son! It is not about damnation after you are saved, it is about your RELATIONSHIP with God. Having the whole counsel of God (EVERY WORD) is the basis of a good relationship with God and like the Philadelphia Church who kept the word of God, we should do the same. There are many even in Paul's day who perverted the words of God (Galatians 1:7); and even in Jeremiah's day! (Jeremiah 23:36)

The Devil will see to it that mass confusion over what the words of God actually are! (Genesis 3:1) He will stop at nothing to alter God's words and see that these words have none effect: Matthew 15:6; Mark 7:13; 1 Corinthians 1:17. This last one is extra special; because in case studies the King James Bible was found to be readable on a fifth grade level. While all the others are above this readability; and some are actually "college level" reading. This is based on the type of words used and the number of syllables, per word usage. The harder the words are, the higher an education needed to understand.

What makes the "new" versions more "readable" than the King James Bible? This is a smoke screen! The readability issues are words of antiquity that are not in usage. The number of which are insignificant in comparison to the alterations in all new versions. Besides you can overcome this by simply marking in the margin what the word means using a dictionary. This is one of those strain at the gnat (hard to understand: "Wilt thou also" or "I trow not" or "Peradventure there be" etc.) And swallow the camel: NIV: Matthew 18:11, "…"missing verse or Matthew 23:14, "…"missing verse or Matthew 27:35 where half the verse is missing! Or Mark 7:16, "…"missing verse or Mark 11:26, "…"missing verse! What a LOT of camels to swallow! A lot of missing passages!

The absence of these verses led the "scholars union" to NOT re-number the verses! WHY? If this is the "CORRECT" wording why not renumber the text? It's like they just PULLED the text OUT when it should have been there after all! How about Mark 15:28 "…"missing verse or Luke 17:36, "…"missing verse; this is one huge camel to swallow!

It seems that the "reason" for updating the King James was based on the few words that needed updating and all the while they are "updating" they are using the penknife to cut the Bible to shreds! (Jeremiah 36:23) The RV attacked the first time Christ shed his blood in the Garden by REMOVING Luke 22:43-44. The RV (1881) was the FIRST in a series of "NEW" and "IMPROVED" attacks on the words of God (Jeremiah 23:36). This was produced by favoring the Alexandrian mss. over the Antiochian mss. And allowing closet Catholics to inter into the committee to do this. One of these mss. is called the VATACANUS! The men responsible for this atrocity were Westcott and Hort. These men and others have set the stage for apostasy in the church for the end times. This age (Laodicean) is all about the people's rights! No longer are the masses concerned with what God says! This was the start of the falling away 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3.

A good example of this is found in the handling of Acts 8:37 in the NIV! The verse is the FIRST reference of someone getting saved like WE DO! His complete testimony STRICKEN FROM THE RECORD! The same we see in Acts 9:5-6 where much has been omitted about Saul's (Paul's) conversion. We have to take precaution for these things, because it is by the word of God that faith comes. (Romans 10:17) We can not rest on the laurels of the past, if we do NOT take a stand for the TRUTH! Who will?

Prior to the contention that Paul and Barnabas had over John Mark; the scriptures tell us that Silas was pleased to abide there unknowing of the calling of God soon to take place. However the NIV took this fact OUT of Acts 15:34. Then there is the accusation of Tertullus against Paul in Acts 24:6-8 where much of these verses are omitted, including all of verse 7. Again in Acts 28:29, we see that this missing verse from the NIV reveals that someone doesn't want to reason based on the words of God! Much more can be said about the NIV's perversion of the truth. The question you need to ask is: do you want the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth? Or will you settle for a few lies that you can read easier!

Try the spirits whether they are of God: 1 John 4:1-6 and KNOW which is of God or which is the spirit of ERROR! Compare these verses in the King James Bible and in the NIV: Be very precise in what it is saying!

1 John 4:1-6 Compared:

NIV

1 "DEAR FRIENDS, do not believe every spirit, but test (word form is passive) the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have (past tense) gone out into the world."

AV

1 "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try (word form is proactive) the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are (present tense) gone out into the world"

NIV

2 "This is how you can recognize (college level wording3 syllables) the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has (past tense) come in the flesh is of God:"

AV

2 "Hereby know (5 grade level wording 1 syllable) ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is (present tense) come in the flesh is of God:"

NIV

3 "but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus (MISSING TEXT) is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already it in the world."

ΑV

3 "And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus CHRIST IS COME IN THE FLESH is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world."

NIV

4 "You, dear children, are from God, and have overcome them, because the one (new age wording) who is in you is greater than the one (new age wording) who is in the world."

ΑV

4 "Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world."

NIV

5 "They are from the world and therefore speak from the viewpoint (anyone can speak from any certain viewpoint) of the world, and the world listens to them."

ΑV

5 "They are of the world: therefore speak they of (no viewpoint to it) the world, and the world heareth them."

NIV

6 "We are <u>from</u> God (proud, arrogant, pretentious and self-important), and whoever knows God <u>listens to us</u>; but whoever is not <u>from</u> God <u>does not listen to us</u>. This is how we <u>recognize</u> (college level wording3 syllables) the Spirit of truth and the spirit of falsehood."

AV

6 "We are of God (unassuming, meek, modest, and humble): he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know (5 grade level wording 1 syllable) we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error."

The phrases "from God" are consistently used in oppositions to "of God" and the phrases using "listen" for "heareth" and the alteration of "confesseth" replaced with "acknowledge" are all vastly different things! Christ was FROM God; we all are FROM this world and from Adam! Saved people are OF God being saved FROM this world! There IS a difference! To listen is also to hear; but to hear is not also to listen! This would mean that you can actually NOT be paying attention and not listening to the gospel being preached, and if you HEAR it then it will STILL have an effect on you! Romans 10:17 notice it's by HEARING, not LISTENING! This is why you don't have ear lids!

Notice again verse 3; and I take great issue with this passage because this is the test that the NIV actually fails in three ways! Notice the missing words that are IN the King James Bible. Now notice how the wording really reads without those missing words: "every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist..." This is saying if you do not acknowledge Jesus is not from God as the spirit of antichrist! DID YOU SEE THAT? Ok once again let's take OUT the double negatives: "every spirit that does acknowledge Jesus is from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist..." This Satanic counterfeit Bible just gave itself away! AND did it by taking OUT: "...CHRIST IS COME IN THE FLESH..." proved that it is an ANTICHRIST perversion of the TRUTH found in the AV text. The very TEST was FAILED in TWO COUNTS! Now for the third:

Proverbs 11:1, "A false balance is abomination to the LORD: but a just weight is his delight." The NIV's test is a false balance! The test is NOT equal on both sides! The test in the King James Bible is equal on both sides! SO, the NIV has failed in THREE COUNTS! You know what they say! 3 Strikes and you OUT!

2 Timothy 2:15, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." But if you go by the NIV you are NOT TO STUDY! Just "Do your best to present yourself to God..." YOU HAVE GOT TO BE KIDDING? Who in their right mind but a lost person would try such a thing? And the list goes on, and on, and on!

God will not put you in hell for reading a modern version – however your growth will be lacking, your "Christianity" will be less than what it could be. You will be part of the lukewarm churches; and part of the apostasy or falling away. You will not have the whole truth; the whole counsel of God.
