

Where did Devils come from?

The gods: Jude 1:6, “And **the angels** which kept not **their first estate**, but **left their own habitation**, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.”

The sons of God in Genesis 6 that fell did not fall with Lucifer, this happened at a later time. These angels left their first estate; that estate was of the heavenly host. They by nature put on flesh as men to cohabit with women and thereby died in the flood, but remain as spirits reserved in chains. These are not the devils, but it was the product of these angels and the women that became the men of renown, the gods that are worshiped throughout the Bible.

Satan’s Lie: Genesis 3:5, “For God doth know that **in the day ye eat thereof**, then your eyes shall be opened, and **ye shall be as gods**, knowing good and evil.”

The **images of their gods**: Deuteronomy 12:3, “And ye shall overthrow their altars, and break their pillars, and burn their groves with fire; and ye shall hew down **the graven images of their gods**, and destroy the names of them out of that place.”

These gods require burnt sacrifices: Deuteronomy 12:31, “Thou shalt not do so unto the LORD thy God: for every abomination to the LORD, which he hateth, have they done unto **their gods**; for even **their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods**.”

These gods require blood sacrifices: Ezekiel 16:36-37, “Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thy **filthiness** was poured out, and thy **nakedness** discovered through thy **whoredoms** with thy **lovers**, and with all the **idols** of thy **abominations**, and **by the blood of thy children**, which thou didst **give unto them**; Behold, therefore I will gather all thy lovers, with whom thou hast taken pleasure, and all them that thou hast loved, with all them that thou hast hated; I will even gather them round about against thee, and will **discover thy nakedness unto them**, that **they may see all thy nakedness**.”

The gods are abominations because they are the product of fallen angels or sons of God also called stars and molten gods:

Genesis 6:2-4, “That **the sons of God** saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he **also** is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when **the sons of God** came in unto the daughters of men, and **they bare children to them, the same became mighty men** which were of old, **men of renown**.”

Job 1:6, “Now there was a day when **the sons of God** came to present themselves before the LORD, and **Satan** came also among them.”

Job 2:1, “Again there was a day when **the sons of God** came to present themselves before the LORD, and **Satan** came also among them **to present himself** before the LORD.”

Job 38:4-7, “Where wast thou **when I laid the foundations of the earth?** declare, if thou hast understanding. Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it? Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof; **When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?**”

Exodus 34:17, “Thou shalt make thee no **molten gods.**”

2 Corinthians 4:4, “In whom **the god of this world** hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.”

The Great Red Dragon is that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan:

Revelation 12:7-9, “And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the **dragon**; and **the dragon fought and his angels**, And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. And the **great dragon** was cast out, that old **serpent**, called **the Devil, and Satan**, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and **his angels** were cast out with him.”

Revelation 20:2, “And he laid hold on **the dragon**, that old **serpent**, which is **the Devil, and Satan**, and bound him a thousand years,”

Isaiah 14:12, “How art thou fallen from heaven, O **Lucifer, son of the morning!** how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!”

This is that Lucifer who became Satan by the nature of his first fall here. What he did in his heart is listed: Isaiah 14:13-23, “For **thou hast said in thine heart, I will** ascend into heaven, **I will** exalt my throne above the stars of God: **I will** sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: **I will** ascend above the heights of the clouds; **I will** be like the most High. Yet **thou shalt be brought down to hell**, to the sides of the pit. They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms; That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners? All the kings of the nations, even all of them, lie in glory, every one in his own house. But thou art cast out of thy grave like an abominable branch, and as

the raiment of those that are slain, thrust through with a sword, that go down to the stones of the pit; as a carcase trodden under feet. Thou shalt not be joined with them in burial, because thou hast destroyed thy land, and slain thy people: the seed of evildoers shall never be renowned. Prepare slaughter for his children for the iniquity of their fathers; that they do not rise, nor possess the land, nor fill the face of the world with cities. For I will rise up against them, saith the LORD of hosts, and cut off from **Babylon** the name, and remnant, and son, and nephew, saith the LORD. I will also make it a possession for the bittern, and pools of water: and **I will sweep it with the besom of destruction**, saith the LORD of hosts.”

See: Ezekiel 28:12-19 for the covering **cherub**. Lucifer was a Cherubim. However after he fell he became **Satan**: the **Great Red Dragon**: see: Job 41. So, **Cherubim** are **Morning Stars**; and the **Angels** are **sons of God**. This covering cherub was very powerful from the beginning: Ezekiel 28:12-19, “Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou **sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty**. Thou hast been in **Eden the garden of God**; **every precious stone was thy covering**, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy **tabrets** and of thy **pipes** was prepared in thee **in the day that thou wast created**. Thou art **the anointed cherub that covereth**; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon **the holy mountain of God**; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of **the stones of fire**. Thou wast **perfect in thy ways** from **the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee**. By the **multitude of thy merchandise** they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of **the mountain of God**: and I will destroy thee, O **covering cherub**, from the midst of **the stones of fire**. **Thine heart was lifted up** because of thy **beauty**, thou hast **corrupted thy wisdom** by reason of **thy brightness**: I will **cast thee to the ground**, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the **multitude of thine iniquities**, by the **iniquity of thy traffick**; therefore will I bring forth **a fire from the midst of thee**, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: **thou shalt be a terror**, and never shalt thou be any more.”

Isaiah 27:1, “In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword **shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent**, even **leviathan that crooked serpent**; and he shall slay **the dragon** that is in the sea.”

Psalms 74:13-14, “Thou didst divide the sea by thy strength: **thou brakest the heads of the dragons in the waters**. Thou **brakest the heads of leviathan in pieces**, and gavest him to be meat to the people inhabiting the wilderness.”

1 John 3:8, “He that committeth sin is **of the devil**; for **the devil sinneth from the beginning**. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.”

Who are these **men of renown** that the sons of God who left their first estate had as **children**?

1 Kings 11:5, “For Solomon went after **Ashtoreth** the goddess of the Zidonians, and after **Milcom** the abomination of the Ammonites.”

1 Kings 11:7, “Then did Solomon build an high place for **Chemosh**, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for **Molech**, the abomination of the children of Ammon.”

2 Kings 23:13, “And the high places that were before Jerusalem, which were on the right hand of the mount of corruption, which Solomon the king of Israel had builded for **Ashtoreth** the abomination of the Zidonians, and for **Chemosh** the abomination of the Moabites, and for **Milcom** the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king defile.”

Numbers 21:29, “Woe to thee, Moab! thou art undone, O people of **Chemosh**: he hath given his sons that escaped, and his daughters, into captivity unto Sihon king of the Amorites.”

Amos 5:26, “But ye have borne the tabernacle of your **Moloch** and **Chiun** your images, the **star** of your god, which ye made to yourselves.”

Acts 7:43, “Yea, ye took up the tabernacle of **Moloch**, and the **star** of your god **Remphan**, figures which ye made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon.”

Leviticus 18:21, “And thou shalt not let any of thy seed **pass through the fire** to **Molech**, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I am the LORD.”

2 Kings 23:10, “And he defiled **Topheth**, which is in the valley of the children of **Hinnom**, that no man might make his son or his daughter to pass through the fire to **Molech**.”

Jeremiah 32:35, “And they built the high places of **Baal**, which are in the valley of the son of **Hinnom**, to cause their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire unto **Molech**; which I commanded them not, neither came it into my mind, that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin.”

2 Kings 23:5, “And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto **Baal**, to **the sun**, and to **the moon**, and to **the planets**, and to **all the host of heaven**.”

Isaiah 46:1, “**Bel** boweth down, **Nebo** stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages were heavy loaden; they are a burden to the weary beast.”

Jeremiah 50:2, “Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, and conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, **Bel** is confounded, **Merodach** is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.”

Revelation 9:11, “And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is **Abaddon**, but in the Greek tongue hath his name **Apollyon**.”

Deuteronomy 4:3, “Your eyes have seen what the LORD did because of **Baalpeor**: for all the men that followed **Baalpeor**, the LORD thy God hath destroyed them from among you.”

Deuteronomy 13:13, “Certain men, the children of **Belial**, are gone out from among you, and have withdrawn the inhabitants of their city, saying, Let us go and serve **other gods**, which ye have not known;”

1 Samuel 2:12, “Now **the sons of Eli were sons of Belial**; they knew not the LORD.”

2 Kings 1:2, “And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that was in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, enquire of **Baalzebub the god** of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.” Verses 3-6 & 16.

2 Kings 17:16, “And they left all the commandments of the LORD their God, and made them **molten images**, even two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all **the host of heaven**, and served **Baal**.” (2 Kings 21:3; 2 Kings 23:4; 2 Kings 23:5.)

Job 40:15, “Behold now **behemoth**, which I made with thee; he eateth grass as an ox.”

Psalms 106:28, “They joined themselves also unto **Baalpeor**, and **ate the sacrifices of the dead**.” (Remember they sacrificed their children! Jeremiah 19:5, “They have built also the high places of **Baal**, to **burn their sons with fire for burnt offerings** unto **Baal**, which I commanded not, nor spake it, neither came it into my mind:”)

Jeremiah 32:35, “And they built the high places of **Baal**, which are in the valley of **the son of Hinnom**, to **cause their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire unto Molech**; which I commanded them not, neither came it into my mind, that they should do this **abomination**, to cause Judah to **sin**.”

Jeremiah 43:13, “He shall break also **the images of Bethshemesh**, that is in the land of **Egypt**; and **the houses of the gods of the Egyptians** shall he burn with fire.”

Zephaniah 1:4, “I will also stretch out mine hand upon Judah, and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and I will cut off the remnant of **Baal** from this place, and the name of the **Chemarims** with the priests;”

Judges 11:24, “Wilt not thou possess that which **Chemosh thy god** giveth thee to possess? So whomsoever the LORD our God shall drive out from before us, them will we possess.”

Judges 16:23, “Then the lords of **the Philistines** gathered them together for to offer a great sacrifice unto **Dagon their god**, and to rejoice: for they said, Our god hath delivered Samson our enemy into our hand.”

1 Samuel 5:1-12, “And **the Philistines** took the ark of God, and brought it from Ebenezer unto Ashdod. When the Philistines took the ark of God, they brought it into **the house of Dagon**, and

set it by **Dagon**. And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, **Dagon was fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of the LORD**. And they took **Dagon**, and set him in his place again. And when they arose early on the morrow morning, behold, **Dagon was fallen upon his face to the ground before the ark of the LORD**; and the head of **Dagon** and both the palms of his hands were cut off upon the threshold; only the stump of **Dagon** was left to him. Therefore neither the priests of **Dagon**, nor any that come into **Dagon's** house, tread on the threshold of **Dagon** in Ashdod unto this day. But the hand of the LORD was heavy upon them of Ashdod, and he destroyed them, and smote them with **emeralds**, even Ashdod and the coasts thereof. And when the men of Ashdod saw that it was so, they said, The ark of the God of Israel shall not abide with us: for his hand is sore upon us, and upon **Dagon our god**. They sent therefore and gathered all the lords of the Philistines unto them, and said, What shall we do with the ark of the God of Israel? And they answered, Let the ark of the God of Israel be carried about unto **Gath**. And they carried the ark of the God of Israel about thither. And it was so, that, after they had carried it about, the hand of the LORD was against the city with a very great destruction: and he smote the men of the city, both small and great, and they had **emeralds** in their **secret parts**. Therefore they sent the ark of God to Ekron. And it came to pass, as the ark of God came to Ekron, that the Ekronites cried out, saying, They have brought about the ark of the God of Israel to us, to slay us and our people. So they sent and gathered together all the lords of the Philistines, and said, Send away the ark of the God of Israel, and let it go again to his own place, that it slay us not, and our people: for there was a deadly destruction throughout all the city; the hand of God was very heavy there. And the men that died not were smitten with the **emeralds**: and the cry of the city went up to heaven.”

2 Kings 17:29-31, “Howbeit every nation **made gods of their own**, and put them in the houses of the high places which the Samaritans had made, every nation in their cities wherein they dwelt. And the men of Babylon made **Succhothbenoth**, and the men of Cuth made **Nergal**, and the men of Hamath made **Ashima**, And the Avites made **Nibhaz** and **Tartak**, and the Sepharvites **burnt their children in fire** to **Adrammelech** and **Anammelech, the gods of Sepharvaim**.”

Ezekiel 25:16, “Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will stretch out mine hand upon the Philistines, and I will cut off the **Cherethims**, and destroy the remnant of the sea coast.”

Micah 6:16, “For the statutes of **Omri** are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.”

Some of the names of the renown: (the gods, the devils, the disembodied spirits, the product of the fallen angels of Genesis 6):

Ashtoreth (a female devil), Milcom, Chemosh, Molech, Chiun, Remphan, Topheth, Hinnom, Baal, Bel, Nebo, Merodach, Abaddon, Apollyon, Baalpeor, Belial, Baalzebub, Bethshemesh, Chemarims, Dagon, Succothbenoth, Nergal, Ashima, Nibhaz, Tartak, Adrammelech, Anammelech, Sepharvaim, Cherethims, Omri, etc.

Notice that IDOLS are inhabited by devils:

Leviticus 17:7, “And **they shall no more offer their sacrifices unto devils**, after whom they have gone a **whoring**. This shall be a statute for ever unto them throughout their generations.”

Deuteronomy 32:17, “**They sacrificed unto devils**, not to God; **to gods** whom they knew not, **to new gods that came newly up**, whom your fathers feared not.”

2 Chronicles 11:14-15, “For the Levites left their suburbs and their possession, and came to Judah and Jerusalem: for Jeroboam and his sons had cast them off from executing the priest's office unto the LORD: And he ordained him priests for the high places, and **for the devils**, and for **the calves** which he had made.”

Psalms 106:34-39, “They did not destroy the nations, concerning whom the LORD commanded them: But **were mingled among the heathen**, and **learned their works**. And they **served their idols**: which were a snare unto them. Yea, **they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils**, And **shed innocent blood**, even **the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan**: and the land was **polluted with blood**. Thus were they **defiled** with their **own works**, and went **a whoring** with their **own inventions**.”

1 Corinthians 10:19-21, “What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing? But I say, that **the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils**, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils. Ye cannot drink the **cup of the Lord**, and the **cup of devils**: ye cannot be partakers of **the Lord's table**, and of **the table of devils**.”

Psalms 97:1-7, “The LORD reigneth; let the earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad thereof. Clouds and darkness are round about him: righteousness and judgment are the habitation of his throne. A fire goeth before him, and burneth up his enemies round about. His lightnings enlightened the world: the earth saw, and trembled. The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth. The heavens declare his righteousness, and all the people see his glory. Confounded be all they that serve graven images, that boast themselves of idols: **worship him, all ye gods**.”

Jude 1:9, “Yet **Michael the archangel**, when contending with **the devil** he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, **The Lord rebuke thee**.”

Daniel 9:2, “In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood **by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet**, that he would accomplish **seventy years** in the desolations of Jerusalem.”
