## Calvinism's Tyranny

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Calvinism cultist make a liar out of God by making God's grace a tyrannical vicious perversion. The Grace of God is not of Calvin's making and is NOT forced. Look up the word forced in your Bible: always has to do with sex sins and a whore. This is NOT descriptive of God, or His salvation.

Salvation is NOT forced on anyone. If you believe this, then it is no longer your faith or believing anything that gets you saved. Force salvation would be vindictive, vengeful, hatful and with malice of forethought. This is NOT descriptive of God.

Please show me where God is this totalitarian hater of all that is good. You can't and won't. It is not in your best interest to do so.

1. Predestination to Heaven or Hell: No lost person is predestined in the Bible. Every reference to predestination has to do with Saved people ONLY, and that destination is NOT ever HEAVEN, but the state that we will be in when we get there: We will be conformed to His image. And we will have an inheritance as joint heirs with Christ. Never does it imply or state that anyone is predestined to heaven or hell. If there was such a thing, this would be what the Gospel message would be and to trust in your predetermined outcome based on this story that is in Genesis 1:1; Oh wait, no it's NOT! Romans 8:29-30, "For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified." No "heaven" in that passage, the predestinate is not predestination to heaven but for US saved people to be conformed to the image of His Son. No LOST person is predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, only Saved people are. Next there is Ephesians 1:5, "Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will," this predestinated US is again Saved people ONLY no lost people are getting adopted until they receive Jesus Christ FIRST. Next is Ephesians 1:11, "In whom also we have

obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:" This is again ONLY saved people; notice the "we" and "inheritance" predestinated import is towards our inheritance which is promised to SAVED people ONLY.

2. Unconditional Election is a misnomer as it does not apply to anyone but Jesus Christ. He is the ONLY ONE who was elected by God before the foundation of the world. All others that were ever elected have been elected IN TIME. Israel as a nation is elected as God's nation. You are ONLY elected after you get IN CHRIST because HE is THE ELECT. Isaiah 42:1, "Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles." Here is prophecy of Jesus Christ and it is singular. Again in Isaiah 45:4, "For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known me." Is also singular as a nation Israel because out of Israel will come Jesus Christ the Elect. We understand this because Isaiah 65:9, "And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there." Here is another prophecy of Jesus Christ God's Elect. Again Isaiah 65:22, "They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands." This is a reference to Israel, who rejected Jesus Christ even though Calvin said election is unconditional. But the fact is they murdered their Messiah Jesus Christ and they were the elect. He came unto his OWN; the Jews and they REJECTED HIM. So this sets the president on the elect. It is either a reference to Jesus Christ or to the nation of Israel. Matthew 24:24, "For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect." Notice "if it were possible" no you cannot deceive the VERY elect because that would mean Jesus Christ could be deceived and it is IMPOSSIBLE. Matthew 24:31, "And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." A tribulation reference to the Children of Israel as his elect and a gathering during the tribulation. Mark 13:22, "For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall shew signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were possible, even the elect." This has the same answer as Matthew 24:24 above. Mark 13:27, "And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect

from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven." Same as Matthew 24:22 above. Luke 18:7, "And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?" again this is Israel as a nation. Romans 8:33, "Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth." As the body of Christ the church stands on earth as God's elect in light of the fact that we are IN HIM. We are IN the ELECT. Yet we were elected after salvation not before it. Colossians 3:12, "Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;" notice the "as" how do we as the church put on something as something that we are already? No the elect of God that is holy and beloved, bowels of mercies being the fruits of the Spirit is dealing with the Lord Jesus Christ as the elect of God we are to be AS. 1 Timothy 5:21, "I charge thee before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, and the elect angels, that thou observe these things without preferring one before another, doing nothing by partiality." The angels are elect when they were created. These were never saved or born again or redeemed and they were elect because there they were and God had made them and here calls them elect angels. Titus 1:1, "Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;" God's elect is NOT people, it is the Lord Jesus Christ, and it is His Faith. 1 Peter 1:2, "Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied." Is directly associated with verse 4, "To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you," This election has to do with the inheritance as predestinated of the same. This election is for Saved people ONLY, no lost person is Elected to heaven or hell. 1 Peter 2:6, "Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded." This elect one is none other than the Lord Jesus Christ as I have said before He is THE ELECT. 2 John 1:1, "The elder unto the elect lady and her children, whom I love in the truth; and not I only, but also all they that have known the truth;" to say elect lady is a term of endearment by

John of whom was charged to take care of Mary the mother of Jesus. But this is not meant as a doctrinal statement to create a frustration about this word elect. She was elected in TIME not before the foundation of the world. 2 John 1:13, "The children of thy elect sister greet thee. Amen." Same as above in 1:1.

- 3. Limited Atonement is an oxymoron; so say that the Atonement is limited is to make the Atonement NOT TAKE CARE OF EVERY SIN. Where does the Bible SAY that the ATONEMENT IS LIMITED? The Atonement covers more than just sin: it covers sins, sinners, the curses, the animal kingdoms, the earth, the first heaven and second heaven. Perhaps while Calvin meant to limit the atonement to just people that HE deemed worthy was why he accused people of heresy knowing that this was a death sentence in those days. He was a murderous villain and took his orders from Satan the master murderer. Calvin got his doctrines from the master deceiver Satan. Leviticus 17:11, "For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul." The atonement was blood atonement for the SOUL. This would mean that only the sinner needed the atonement to keep him OUT of HELL FIRE. So what we have in Calvinism is ONE verse in the New Testament out of 70 verses in the Bible with the word atonement in it: Romans 5:11, "And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement." And it does NOT say that the atonement is limited in any way shape or form. Where did Calvin get this limitation then? Out of the air! It is nowhere in the scriptures.
- 4. Irresistible Grace is another oxymoron as grace is gracious: the complete opposite of forced conversion. Calvin thought that forced conversion was needed by the fear and terror of being burned at the stake if you did not convert. But this is NOT God's doing, it is mans. There is no such thing in the Bible anywhere of anyone being FORCED to convert. Conversion is always by means of FAITH of the person who is to be converted. It is by believing on Jesus Christ that one secures salvation. Without this, you WILL die in your sins and wake up in HELL FIRE and DAMNATION. Trusting in your election will not replace trusting in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross. You still MUST receive Jesus Christ, and the offer to CHOOSE whole reason to present the gospel to others. Calvinism leads to Hyper-Calvinism when pressed towards the truth of the gospel. The gospel is defined in the Bible, and it is NOT believe in your election! The Gospel is that Christ died, and was buried according to the scriptures and rose the third day according to the scriptures of which Paul said that he receive: 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, "For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also

received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:" Now about grace being irresistible: Acts 7:51, "Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye." This is Stephen's message of the grace of God and man's failing and God's grace over and over again. His preaching created quite a mess: Acts 6:10, "And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake." So what did they do? 11-12, "Then they suborned men, which said, We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses, and against God. And they stirred up the people, and the elders, and the scribes, and came upon him, and caught him, and brought him to the council," and when he spoke to the council in chapter 7, they killed him for it. That is how they rejected Jesus Christ and the Grace of God that He gave them, but they WOULD NOT HAVE IT. It is resistible, and if you resist the grace of God you will die in your sins and wake up in a devil's hell fire and damnation.

5. Total Depravity is not depravity already as total as it can be? What we mean by depravity is sinful wretchedness. However if you are totally depraved in the Calvinistic meaning of the combined words then your will is so depraved that you cannot do anything good. Yet the Bible tells us different: Matthew 7:11, "If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?" and Luke 11:13, "If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?" The Lord is equating his own giving to man's giving good things. It is that man is depraved, that is; he is a sinner and sin resides in his mortal flesh, man's heart is wicked so that he loves the wrong things. But the man is the soul that thinks, and has a will, that will is an ability to make choices, which we do all the time. God allows men to choose sides: Joshua 24:15, "And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD." The lines are drawn and the question is whose side will you be on: Deuteronomy 30:15, "See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil;" Deuteronomy 30:19, "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou

and thy seed may live:" The choice is yours and yours alone: Choose the Lord Jesus Christ and LIVE! John 1:12-13, "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God." Not only spiritually but during Christ's time on earth he was received willingly: John 6:21, "Then they willingly received him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went." They were not forced to receive him; they willingly received him! Spiritually you MUST receive him or the wrath of God that abides on every lost man will be realized at death: John 3:36, "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." That wrath of God is perishing from all of what is good, and burning in hell fire: John 10:28, "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand." A gift is not forced on anyone; it is offered, and then must needs be received by choice. Doing nothing is rejecting that gift. Just assuming that God has already done it for you is doing nothing. Just thinking that God has already elected you is doing nothing. If you do nothing you will die in your sins: John 8:21, "Then said Jesus again unto them, I go my way, and ye shall seek me, and shall die in your sins: whither I go, ye cannot come." And John 8:24, "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins." You MUST believe in the Lord Jesus Christ; that is, you must receive HIM as your payment for your sins. God did not choose YOU; God chose Jesus Christ the Lord and gave Him the preeminence, NOT YOU. You have no preeminence; you came into this world IN TIME; and did not exist prior to that. You were NOT THERE during the creation of this world to be chosen, you were not even in the running. You were not nominated so you could not have been elected. There was only ONE that was nominated and elected. The Lord Jesus Christ. He gets all the glory, praise and honor. Chose HIM to be your saviour and NOT YOURSELF and defiantly not John Calvin aka Jean Cauvin (1509-1564). I suppose Calvinism should then be called Chauvinism. After all he was a Tyrannical Religious Chauvinist.

6. Perseverance of the Saints is the altered point in Neo-Calvinism making most Calvinist 4 point Calvinist, unless you add the Predestination to Heaven or Hell bit as I have done, so instead of 5 points there are 6. This perseverance of the Saints is from Calvin's reading of Matthew 10:22, "And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the

end shall be saved." The Calvinist believes that the endurance of the Christian to the end else he was never saved to begin with. The trouble with this is that Matthew 10:22 is tribulation, and not Church age. The enduring to the end is the end of that time; or the end of life. The end of time when the Lord comes back to set up His kingdom. Those looking for him will be physically saved from death. Those that have died, will have kept the commandments and the testimony or faith of Jesus: Revelation 12:17, "And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ." And Revelation 14:12, "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus." We are preserved by God: 1 Thessalonians 5:23, "And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." Jude 1:1, "Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:" This preservation is also called being sealed by the Holy Spirit: 2 Corinthians 1:22, "Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts." And Ephesians 1:13, "In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise," and Ephesians 4:30, "And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."

Calvinism is a Pagan Elitist Tyrannical Murderous Cult full of LOST people who deem themselves of high degree intellectuals who lie in wait to deceive the simple.

The Calvinist takes great strides in sophistry, imaginary story lines purported as scriptures when they are not.
