

Calvinist Can't Read, Think, or Understand!

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Romans 11:5, "Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace."

What is the election of grace? Did someone elect grace to do something? Or is this an elect group of people that got grace? Is it not the election of grace that God gave to save sinners? OR is it an elect group of predestined to heaven elitist that are chosen before the world began to go to heaven. Looks like by this that the elect are already saved before the foundation of the world! How is this possible?

Proof Text: Ephesians 1:4, "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:"

This claim is that the chosen before the foundation of the world are IN HIM that is Christ and they are holy and without blame; and not sinners born in this world. They are also before him in love... how is that? That is like standing before him... not like a Calvinist teaches at all. How can this mean that they are a sinner when they are born if this is their state before birth?

All Calvinist frustrate the space / time continuum! They will always do this, because they can't read, think or understand!

Here it is so you can get it: John 17:24, "Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world." It is Jesus Christ that was before the foundation of the world with the Father, NOT YOU! Jesus Christ is the only one that has the preeminence: Colossians 1:18, "And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence." Our start is with Christ Jesus in this life. We did not exist before this life. Ecclesiastes 3:19, "For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, they have all one breath; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all is vanity." We are like the beast of the field in that when we are born we start our lives. The difference is we have a soul. But in this context physically we are here like the beast of the field. We are born and we live and then we die. We did not exist prior to this physical life.
