

The Calvinistic Logic Is Flawed By a Lie

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Logic never over-rides Revelation; there is a true logic of faith in rightly dividing the words of truth; but when running a logical hop-scotch smorgasbord magpie like Calvinism does you're just asking for a strait-jacket. Sometimes logic is just illogical especially when you juggle the tidily winks of the pentagram points of the pagan fatalistic menagerie of the elitist group Calvinism.

Acts 7:51, "Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, **ye do always resist the Holy Ghost**: as your fathers did, so do ye." Stephen was preaching to the Jews from Judah, Jacob, who is Israel as well as the nation Israel; as you might know: Isaiah 45:4, "For Jacob my servant's sake, and **Israel mine elect**, I have even called thee by thy name: I have **surnamed** thee, though thou hast not known me." So in Acts Stephen preaches to the ELECT and they resisted the Holy Ghost and the grace of God being preached to them. Calvin was a bald faced LIAR! So is anyone and everyone that espouses his elitist pagan fatalist lie!

The logic starts with Predestination. Let's put on the goo-goo goggles of Calvinism and see how they see what the Bible says:

1. What the Calvinist sees in: Ephesians 1:4-6, "According as he **in him** hath **elected us prior to the creation** of the **earth**, that we should be holy and without blame **prior to** him in love: Having **predestinated us unto heaven** which is the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the **will of his good pleasure**, To the praise of the glory of his graces, wherein he hath made us **elected** in the beloved."

What the Bible actually says: Ephesians 1:4-6, "According as he hath **chosen us in him** before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having **predestinated us unto the adoption** of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein **he hath made us accepted in the beloved**."

2. Then here comes the logical domino effect with the Roman doctrine of “original sin” so they see Romans 5:12 as saying: “Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that **Adam sinned...**”

But the Bible actually says: Romans 5:12, “Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so **death passed upon all men**, for that **all have sinned...**”

3. Based on this Roman papist false doctrine it is assumed we are born dead in trespasses and sins so it is vied in this way: Ephesians 2:1, “And you hath he quickened, who were **born** dead in trespasses and sins...”

But the Bible actually says: Ephesians 2:1, “And you hath he quickened, who **were dead** in trespasses and sins...”

4. Here is where the first point comes in with TULIP:

T Total Depravity: **because you are born dead** you cannot do anything right because you are spiritually dead. Logical! You must therefore baptize babies so they remain safe so water baptism is a sacrament. And because you are totally depraved you cannot choose to do anything right; God must do it for you...

U Unconditional Election: so because **you cannot choose to do right** you must be elected by God prior to the creation of the earth. So God in His infinite wisdom picked the Calvinist to be elected obviously and did not pick those freewillers because everyone knows that having freewill is NOT in the Bible. And if the election is unconditional then...

L Limited Atonement: **if the election is unconditional** then the atonement must be limited to only those that are elected; because if the atonement was wasted on anyone it would not be pure for the elected. God only saves 100% of whom he has elected this would place a limit not only on the atonement but also on Grace...

I Irresistible Grace: If the atonement is limited and the election is unconditional then grace **MUST** be irresistible (logical). God **MUST** save His elect after all He elected them prior to the creation of the earth, right? They then must count on their election first and foremost because they cannot choose to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ. This leads to the Saint enduring to the end to be saved...

P Perseverance of the Saint: (this has been changed by many to Preservation of the Saint but Calvin did not teach this.) You must endure to the end to be saved and then you will know you were after all one of the elect. Without endurance you might actually not be one of the elect and just thought you were; but in the end you will find out and if you wake up in hell; ops, I guess you were not one of the elect after all. Because it is God who does all the work involved you cannot know you are going to heaven: no one can know until you get there; Right?

That is their logical progression into the abyss...

The Calvinistic logic is actually sound; however, it starts with a lie and every deduced logical step is also therefore a lie; and with each step the lie further exponentially complicates the lie adding sin upon sin:

1. There is no story anywhere in the Bible about the Calvinistic predestination. It is a fabrication and diabolical LIE bent to one purpose: deception in order to bring YOU back in line with Rome (even though on the outside Rome looks like they believe in Freewill; but the system is tyrannical; with forced conversions; else being burned alive.) In the Bible the word used is predestinate Romans 8:29-30 or predestinated Ephesians 1:5 & 11. Never does it say predestined to heaven or predestine to heaven. It is NEVER spoken of, to or about anyone that is lost. It is always someone that is already saved that is now and hereafter predestinated to:

- a. Be conformed to the image of his Son (Romans 8:29-30)

Lost people are NOT predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, the Lord Jesus Christ because God is NOT their father.

- b. The adoption (Ephesians 1:5) this is not being born again...

Lost people are NOT predestinated unto the adoption; their destination is Hell Fire and Damnation and their father is Satan.

- c. Obtain an inheritance (Ephesians 1:11)

Lost people are NOT predestinated to obtain an inheritance; they are NOT in the family of God to get any inheritance; they are NOT joint-

heirs with Christ.

2. Adam ate from the tree of the knowledge of GOOD & evil. Jesus Christ said in Matthew 7:11, “If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children...” How can you being evil do good? Jesus Christ said you can. You have a moral sense that when asking what must I DO to be saved: the answer is: Acts 16:30-31, “And brought them out, and said, Sirs, **what must I do to be saved?** And they said, **Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved**, and thy house.” So the sinner CAN choose to believe on the Lord Jesus Christ. But the Bible makes it clear that you can choose NOT to believe the truth: John 5:37-47, “And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape. And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, **him ye believe not**. Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. **And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.** I receive not honour from men. But I know you, that **ye have not the love of God in you**. I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive. **How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only?** Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even Moses, in whom ye trust. **For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me:** for he wrote of me. But **if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?** (See below the rejection of the Elect Nation of Israel.)
3. The only people ever called Elect in the Old Testament:
 - a. “**...Mine elect...**” Isaiah 42:1 is prophetic about the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - b. “**...Israel mine elect...**” Isaiah 45:4 is the nation of Israel His OWN.
 - c. “**...bring forth a seed out of Jacob...**” and “**...mine elect...**” like a. above.
 - d. “**...my people, and mine elect...**” Isaiah 65:22 again the nation of Israel.

There is no story about anyone elected prior to the creation of the

earth anywhere in the Old Testament. It is a fable.

4. FREEWILL:

- a. "...which are minded of their own **freewill** to go..." Ezra 7:13
- b. "...of his **own voluntary will**..." Leviticus 1:3
- c. "...the prince shall prepare a **voluntary** burnt offering or peace offerings **voluntarily** unto the LORD..." Ezekiel 46:12

Freewill is IN the Bible and God would require this for God to have grace and forbearance. Without an ability to be minded of your own freewill to voluntarily do right in what the Lord wants then grace is not grace but tyranny.

5. Grace:

- a. John 1:14, "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) **full of grace and truth.**"
- b. John 1:17, "For the law was given by Moses, but **grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.**"
- c. Acts 15:11, "But we believe that **through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved**, even as they."
- d. Romans 3:24-28, "**Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:** Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation **through faith in his blood**, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him **which believeth in Jesus.** Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but **by the law of faith.** Therefore **we conclude that a man is justified by faith** without the deeds of the law."
- e. Romans 4:4-5, "Now to him that worketh is the reward **not reckoned of grace**, but of debt. But to him that worketh not, but **believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.**"
- f. Romans 5:20-21, "Moreover the law entered, **that the offence might abound.** But where sin abounded, **grace did much more abound:**

- That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might **grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.**”
- g. Galatians 2:21, “I do not frustrate **the grace of God:** for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.”
 - h. Ephesians 2:8-9, “For **by grace are ye saved through faith;** and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God : Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

6. The Atonement

- a. Exodus 30:10, “And Aaron shall make **an atonement** upon the horns of it once in a year **with the blood of the sin offering of atonements:** once in the year shall he make **atonement** upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD.”

This is the only verse where the plural word “atonements” shows up and the word atonement singular is also in the verse. The word shows up three times in these forms. It is a special verse about the Atonement; as this is the blood atonement of the sin offering during the Passover which was done as it says in the verse once a year.

There is only ONE passage in the New Testament that has the word atonement in it: Romans 5:8-11, “But **God commendeth his love toward us,** in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, **being now justified by his blood,** we shall be **saved from wrath** through him. For if, when we were enemies, **we were reconciled to God** by the death of his Son, much more, **being reconciled,** we shall be **saved by his life.** And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, **by whom we have now received the atonement.**” Verse 11. So by this can you tell if in the New Testament the atonement is limited? What sins are NOT covered by the atonement? If the sinner’s sin is not covered in the atonement then the sinner cannot be covered by it. If a sinner is not covered by the atonement then the sin of his transgression is not covered. If that sinner was a liar then Lying is NOT covered by the atonement! Really? Same logic used in Calvinism!

- b. The atonement is compensation; it is expiation, reparation, a payment. However a payment can only be made if that payment satisfies the debt. This satisfaction of payment is called propitiation: 1 John 2:1-2, “My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, **we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.**” So if God is satisfied with Jesus Christ payment for all our sins and not for ours only but also for the sins of the WHOLE WORLD; then the atonement is NOT limited to any select group of people or any select group of sins; but available to everyone.
 - c. What IS limited is the imputation of this payment of your debt personally because you MUST receive the person who paid that debt: you must receive HIM. You may not have gotten that so I will repeat it: **YOU MUST RECIEVE HIM!** By receiving you are to act on the gospel; not just reckon that God has done it for you. The admonition is that Israel God’s elect rejected Him: John 1:11-13, **He came unto his own** (Israel is His own elect!), and **his own received him not** (it was the Elect that REJECTED Him!). But **as many as received him,** to them gave he power **to become the sons of God**, even to them that believe on his name: **Which were born**, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but **of God.**” You MUST avail yourself of this by receiving HIM. Salvation is in a person; not in things. When you receive the Lord Jesus Christ; you become the righteousness of God in Him by imputation; and your sins are imputed to Him. This is how it becomes effectual for you individually. The offer for salvation is universal; but the effectual application of individual salvation offered by the gospel and by the very nature of grace: it MUST be received. A gift that is given requires reception; a gift forced on someone is not a gift and not by grace; it is a Tyrannical LAW.
7. This brings us to preservation of your salvation and knowing you are saved which go hand in hand:
- a. 1 John 5:11-13, “And **this is the record**, that God hath given to us **eternal life**, and **this life** is in his Son. **He that hath the Son hath**

life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you **that believe** on the name of the Son of God; **that ye may know that ye have eternal life**, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.”

- b. 2 Corinthians 1:21-22, “Now he which establisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is **God; Who hath also sealed us**, and **given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.**”
- c. Ephesians 1:13-14, “In whom **ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation:** in whom also **after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,** Which is **the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession**, unto the praise of his glory.”
- d. Ephesians 4:30, “And **grieve not the holy Spirit of God**, whereby **ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.**”
- e. John 10:27-28, “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And **I give unto them eternal life;** and **they shall never perish**, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.”

The most ridiculous points are Limited Atonement and Irresistible Grace as both of these are total obnoxious moronic oxymorons. There is nothing limited in the atonement or Christ did not pay for ALL your sins. And the most obnoxious putrefying paganistic doctrine of Calvin is Irresistible Grace. It takes the cake in oxymorons because for grace to be irresistible: it would cease to be grace and be tyrannical. That is like saying Forced Grace! This is a tyrannical pagan ideology perpetrated to deceive people back to Tyrannical Rome without actually going back to Rome. Calvin got every one of his lies from Augustine including what he wrote about water baptism and the Lord’s Supper both Calvin calls Sacraments. This Roman Papist pagan would have you believe what he taught was protestant and not Catholic! But Roman Catholic Papist Paganism it is, in a deceptive and diabolical wrapping. He is a wolf in sheep’s clothing plain and simple.
