The gospel? Why such animosity to what the Bible SAYS?

Paul told you there is more than ONE gospel...

Galatians 1:6-7, "I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ."

The perverted gospel is what is called another gospel. It is still called a gospel, even when it is perverted.

For the record I preach the Gospel that Paul preached from 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, "Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:"

The gospel of the grace of God: Acts 20:24; Romans 1:1,9,16; 2:16; 10:15-16; 15:19-20, 29; 16:25; 1 Corinthians 1:17; 4:15; 9:12, 14, 16-18; 15:1-4; 2 Corinthians 2:12; 4:3-4; 9:13; 10:14, 16; 11:7; Galatians 1:11; 2:2-7; 2:14; Ephesians 1:13; 3:6; 6:15, 19; Philippians 1:5, 7, 12, 27; 2:22; 4:3; Colossians 1:5, 23; 1 Thessalonians 1:5; 2:2, 4, 8-9; 3:2; 2 Thessalonians 1:8; 2:14; 1 Timothy 1:11; 2 Timothy 1:8-10; Hebrews 4:2; 1 Peter 1:12, 23-25; 4:6, 17. (THIS IS THE ONE WE PREACH IN THE CHURCH AGE.)
6. Another gospel: 2 Corinthians 11:3-4, 13-15; Galatians 1:6-9
7. The everlasting gospel: Revelation 14:6

These are NOT the same gospel. If you think they are, that is fine; it does not affect the truth at all. It only affects your relationship with God. You are to believe what God SAID; not alter what God said because of what you believe.
