1. The Judgment of Jesus Christ on the Cross:

- a. Isaiah 53:7-12, "He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the **slaughter**, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was **cut off out of the land of the living**: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because **he hath poured out his soul unto death**: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors."
- b. Galatians 3:13, "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:"
- c. 2 Corinthians 5:21, "For <u>he hath made him to be sin for us</u>, <u>who knew</u> <u>no sin</u>; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

2. The Judgment of the NT Believer my himself:

a. 1 John 1:6-10, "If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and <u>the blood of</u>
Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. If we say that we have

no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <u>If we confess</u> <u>our sins</u>, <u>he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins</u>, <u>and to cleanse</u> <u>us from all unrighteousness</u>. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us."

b. 1 Corinthians 11:28-32, "But <u>let a man examine himself</u>, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, <u>we are chastened of the Lord</u>, that we should not be condemned with the world."

3. The Judgment of Satan:

- a. Isaiah 14:12-15, "<u>How art thou fallen</u> from heaven, <u>O Lucifer</u>, son of the morning! how art thou <u>cut down to the ground</u>, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. <u>Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell</u>, to the sides of the pit."
- b. John 16:11, "Of judgment, <u>because the prince of this world is</u> <u>judged</u>."
- c. Romans 16:20, "And <u>the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your</u> <u>feet shortly</u>. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen."
- d. Revelation 20:2, "And he laid hold on <u>the dragon</u>, <u>that old serpent</u>, <u>which is the Devil</u>, <u>and Satan</u>, and bound him a thousand years…" with Revelation 20:7, "And when the thousand years are expired, <u>Satan</u> shall be <u>loosed</u> out of his prison…" with Revelation 20:10, "And <u>the devil</u> that deceived them <u>was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone</u>, <u>where</u> <u>the beast and the false prophet are</u>, and <u>shall be tormented day and</u> <u>night for ever and ever</u>."

4. The Judgment of Israel:

- a. Jeremiah 30:7, "Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even <u>the time of Jacob's trouble</u>; but he shall be saved out of it."
- b. Daniel 12:1-4, "And at that time shall <u>Michael stand up</u>, <u>the great</u> <u>prince</u> which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a <u>time of trouble</u>, <u>such as never was since there was a nation</u> even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased."
- c. Revelation 6 to 19...
- d. Matthew 24:3-31; Mark 13:4-27 & Luke 21:7-28.

5. The Judgment Seat of Christ:

- a. Romans 14:9-12, "For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living. But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before <u>the judgment seat of Christ</u>. For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God. So then <u>every one of us shall give account of himself to God</u>."
- b. 1 Corinthians 3:11-15, "For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man <u>build upon this foundation</u> gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; <u>Every man's work</u> <u>shall be made manifest</u>: for the day shall declare it, because <u>it shall be revealed by fire</u>; and <u>the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is</u>. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss:

but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire."

c. 2 Corinthians 5:10, "For <u>we must all appear before the judgment seat</u> <u>of Christ</u>; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad."

6. The Judgment of the Nations:

- a. Matthew 25:31-34, "When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world…" and Matthew 25:41, "Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels…" and Matthew 25:46, "And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal."
- b. Revelation 21:24, "And **the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it**: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it."

7. The White Throne Judgment:

- a. Psalms 9:7, "But the LORD shall endure for ever: **he hath prepared his throne for judgment**."
- b. Ecclesiastes 12:14, "For **God shall bring every work into judgment**, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil."
- c. Daniel 7:9 -11, "I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and <u>the</u> <u>Ancient of days did sit</u>, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand

times ten thousand stood before him: <u>the judgment was set</u>, and <u>the</u> <u>books were opened</u>. I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame."

d. 2 Peter 3:7-13, "But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness."

Revelation 20:11-15, "And I saw <u>a great white throne</u>, and him that sat on it, from whose face <u>the earth</u> and <u>the heaven fled away</u>; and there was found no place for them. And I saw <u>the dead</u>, small and great, <u>stand before God</u>; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and <u>the dead were judged</u> out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were judged every man according to their works.
And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire."
