

# LYES vs. BEST (OSAS)

## **Lose Your Eternal Salvation vs. Believer's Eternal Salvation is Timeless**

Romans 3:24-28, "Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law."

We that are saved are justified freely by his grace; we did not work for it; or it would not be free; and if it was forced it would not be grace. Justification is a prerequisite to salvation as is imputation and the new birth. God is not satisfied with your good works, or your water baptism no matter whose name that was done in. God is not satisfied with your repenting from your sins or repenting to not sinning. God is satisfied with the Lord Jesus Christ's sacrifice for the redemption through faith in his blood and God is satisfied with Jesus Christ's righteousness and no one else's. If you can lose your salvation over any certain sin then you can boast about not doing that sin to keep your salvation just like getting saved all over again and again. You are not justified by the deeds of the law. The conclusion is that a man IS justified by FAITH; but faith misplaced is NOT this faith. Justification comes by faith of him which believeth in Jesus. That faith is the only faith that counts for salvation. It is Jesus plus nothing else that saves a person during this age.

Romans 10:3-4, "For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth."

If anyone goes about to establish their own righteousness no matter the reason; they have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God; and therefore are LOST. It is Christ that is the end of the law; NOT your own righteousness. Christ is our righteousness to every one that believeth WITHOUT the works of the law.

The real question is found in: Acts 16:30-31, "And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house."

The question when put to the test "What must I do to be saved?" is very simple: Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved! When you add anything else to that then you are not saved. The key element is faith in Christ; but you must also admit to God that you are WICKED! God holds you responsible for your own sins because of what you are. If you confess that you are a sinner God will deal with you in your honesty. You must confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus AND believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead:

Romans 10:9-10, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

Righteousness is imputed by your faith by believing on the Lord Jesus Christ; because HE is God's righteousness unto salvation when you confess HIM to the Lord God Almighty.

Romans 4:5-8, "But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works, Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin."

You are ungodly; but you can believe on the Lord Jesus Christ; God accounts your faith as righteousness imputed to you; and your sin imputed to the Lord Jesus Christ and the Lord does not impute sin to you anymore. Sin is only in your flesh now and NOT in your soul. That is safety in the Lord.

Romans 4:14-16, "For if they which are of the law be heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect: Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression. Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,"

It is of faith and not of the law and where no law is, there is no transgression. I am fully persuaded that, what God had promised, He IS able also to perform IN ME.

Romans 4:20-25, "He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him; But

for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification."

"...If we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification..." Then nothing else can be added to this else this becomes nul and void; and a person does NOT get saved to begin with. Many church goers these days are living a lie thinking that what they have is salvation when it is not. They have been deceived in to thinking that faith and works justifies them before God, it does not have to be a work contained IN the law; it could be a work nevertheless like water baptism, church membership, repentance from sins, doing good deeds. The turning over a new leaf is NOT salvation. People that believe in LYES (Losing Your Eternal Salvation) have been trusting in something other than JUST the Lord Jesus Christ and therefore do not have any spiritual discernment to know right doctrine from the LIES. We are NOT justified by works of any kind we are justified by His BLOOD! We were not reconciled by water baptism; we are reconciled to God by the death of the Lord Jesus Christ and being reconciled we are saved by HIS LIFE with is ETERNAL LIFE! Your Salvation IS Jesus Christ plus nothing.

Romans 5:9-10, "Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life." You are NOT saved by anything you are saved by a PERSON: The Lord Jesus Christ.
