

Lesbian Transgender & Bisexual - Oh My! Lions, Tigers & Bears - Oh My!

It makes you think you are free and liberated, when you are in extreme bondage.

I can remember I was not always in this way; my particular perversion was sex, drugs and rock & roll. I know from experience that these things are evil, vile and filthy. And that they are against all that is good and right and clean. Most people have some sort of moral character where they might cross some lines they won't cross others; and when they do they still won't cross even other lines. So the question is where does God draw the line? We are good at drawing lines and crossing them because human beings are sinners and sinners, sin. That is the problem. So we need to see things from God's eyes and not from our own.

What does the Bible have to say about all this?

Ephesians 2:12, "That at that time **ye were without Christ**, being **aliens** from the commonwealth of Israel, and **strangers** from the covenants of promise, **having no hope**, and **without God** in the world:"

Jude 1:8, "Likewise also these **filthy dreamers** defile the flesh, despise dominion, and **speak evil** of dignities."

Jude 1:10-13, "But these **speak evil** of those things **which they know not**: but what they know naturally, as **brute beasts**, in those things **they corrupt themselves**. Woe unto them! for they have gone in **the way of Cain**, and ran **greedily** after **the error of Balaam** for reward, and **perished** in the **gainsaying** of Core. These are **spots** in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves **without fear**: clouds they are **without water**, carried about of winds; trees whose **fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up** by the roots; **Raging waves** of the sea, **foaming out their own shame**; **wandering stars**, to whom is reserved **the blackness of darkness for ever**."

Jude 1:15-16, "To execute **judgment** upon all, and **to convince all** that are **ungodly** among them of **all their ungodly deeds** which **they have ungodly committed**, and of all their hard speeches which **ungodly sinners** have spoken against him. These are **murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts**;

and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.”

Romans 1:18-32, “For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world **are clearly seen**, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; **so that they are without excuse**: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became **vain in their imaginations**, and **their foolish heart was darkened**. **Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools**, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into **an image made like to corruptible man**, and to birds, and fourfooted **beasts**, and creeping things. Wherefore **God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves**: Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. **For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections**: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; **men with men working that which is unseemly**, and **receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet**. And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, **God gave them over to a reprobate mind**, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, **haters of God**, **despiteful**, **proud**, **boasters**, **inventors of evil things**, **disobedient to parents**, **Without understanding**, **covenantbreakers**, **without natural affection**, **implacable**, **unmerciful**: Who knowing the judgment of God, **that they which commit such things are worthy of death**, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.”

Galatians 5:19-21, “Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; **Adultery**, **fornication**, **uncleanness**, **lasciviousness**, **Idolatry**, **witchcraft**, **hatred**, **variance**, **emulations**, **wrath**, **strife**, **seditions**, **heresies**, **Envyings**, **murders**, **drunkenness**, **revellings**, and **such like**: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.”

Proverbs 6:16-19, “These **six things** doth the **LORD** hate: yea, seven are an **abomination unto him**: A **proud look**, a **lying tongue**, and **hands that shed innocent blood**, An **heart that deviseth wicked imaginations**, **feet that be swift in running to mischief**, A **false witness** that **speaketh lies**, and **he that soweth discord among brethren**.”

Matthew 15:18-19, “But those things which **proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart**; and they defile the man. For **out of the heart** proceed **evil thoughts**, **murders**, **adulteries**, **fornications**, **thefts**, **false witness**, **blasphemies**:
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Mark 7:20-23, “And he said, **That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man**. For **from within, out of the heart of men**, proceed **evil thoughts**, **adulteries**, **fornications**, **murders**, **Thefts**, **covetousness**, **wickedness**, **deceit**, **lasciviousness**, an **evil eye**, **blasphemy**, **pride**, **foolishness**: **All these evil things come from within**, and **defile the man**.”

Revelation 20:11-15, “And I saw a **great white throne**, and him that sat on it, **from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away**; and there was found no place for them. And **I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God**; and the **books were opened**: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and **the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works**. And the sea gave up **the dead which were in it**; and **death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them**: and **they were judged every man according to their works**. And **death and hell were cast into the lake of fire**. **This is the second death**. And **whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire**.”

Revelation 21:8, “But **the fearful**, and **unbelieving**, and **the abominable**, and **murderers**, and **whoremongers**, and **sorcerers**, and **idolaters**, and **all liars**, **shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death**.”

Romans 5:6-12, “For when we were yet without strength, in due time **Christ died for the ungodly**. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. **But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners**, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now **justified by his blood**, we shall be **saved from wrath** through him. For if, **when we were enemies**, we were reconciled to God **by the death of his Son**, much more, **being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life**. And not

only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, **by whom we have now received the atonement.** Wherefore, **as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:**”

Romans 3:23, “**For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;**”

Romans 6:23, “For **the wages of sin is death;** but **the gift of God is eternal life** through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Ephesians 2:1-5, “And you hath he quickened, who were **dead in trespasses and sins;** Wherein in time past **ye walked according to the course of this world,** according to **the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:** Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, **fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind;** and were **by nature the children of wrath, even as others.** but God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, **Even when we were dead in sins,** hath quickened us together with Christ, (**by grace** ye are saved;)”

Ephesians 2:8-9, “For **by grace are ye saved** through faith; and that **not of yourselves:** it is **the gift of God: Not of works,** lest any man should boast.”

Romans 3:24-28, “**Being justified freely by his grace** through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation **through faith in his blood,** to declare **his righteousness for the remission of sins** that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time **his righteousness:** that **he might be just,** and **the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.** Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but **by the law of faith.** Therefore **we conclude** that **a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.**”

Romans 10:3-4, “For they **being ignorant of God's righteousness,** and **going about to establish their own righteousness,** **have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.**”

John 1:12-13, “But **as many as received him,** to them gave he power to become **the sons of God,** even to them that believe on his name: **Which were born,** not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but **of God.**”

John 3:5-7, “Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.** That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and **that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.** Marvel not that I said unto thee, **Ye must be born again.**”

Romans 10:9-10, “**That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.** For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

2 Corinthians 5:17-21, “**Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away;** behold, **all things are become new.** And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that **God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them;** and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: **we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.** For **he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.**”

1 John 5:10-13, “**He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar;** because he believeth not **the record that God gave of his Son.** And **this is the record,** that **God hath given to us eternal life,** and **this life is in his Son.** **He that hath the Son hath life;** and **he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.** These things have I written unto you **that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life,** and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.”

John 10:28, “And I **give** unto them **eternal life;** and **they shall never perish,** neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.”

Acts 17:30-31, “And the **times of this ignorance** God winked at; but **now commandeth all men every where to repent:** Because **he hath appointed a day,** in the which **he will judge the world in righteousness** by that man whom he hath ordained; **whereof he hath given assurance unto all men,** in that **he hath raised him from the dead.**”

The Bible is clear when it tells us in Romans 3:10-28, “As it is written, **There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.** Their throat is

an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips: Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness: Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways: And the way of peace have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes. Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: **that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin. But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, **through the forbearance of God;** To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: **but by the law of faith.** Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.”**

Anyone can receive the Lord Jesus Christ: the question is WILL you? 2 Peter 3:9, “The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, **not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.**” The Lord God finds no pleasure in your death even if you are wicked: Ezekiel 18:32, “For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith the Lord GOD: wherefore turn yourselves, and live ye.” **TURN FROM YOUR WICKEDNESS AND SIN AND TURN TO THE LORD JESUS CHRIST TODAY:** Ezekiel 33:11, “Say unto them, As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel?”
