

# Oneness Pentecostalism

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## This is Part 2

**Someone said that the blood and water that came out of Christ's side would be some sort of issue with water baptism.**

Sargent Answers: Only if you are baptized in that particular water and blood right? You would have had to be standing at the cross with a tub and catching all that water and blood to be baptized in! Yet for all that it would not save you! You **MUST** receive HIM! Salvation is in a person not in things. It took His shed blood to clear your sins completely not just remitting them. If you had the choice to take chemo therapy for cancer to get it remitted with a 50:50 chance of it coming back or to have it completely removed from your body by a blood transfusion that was guaranteed successful 100% of the time with no side effects and no possible reoccurring cancer lesions or tumors. Which would you choose? Water is used in the chemo therapy as an inhibitor and a flushing agent. In extreme cases the water however that is supposed to flush the system sometimes infects the entire system instead and then the success rate is 90:10 and you should make preparations for your death.

Water baptism unless you are drinking it only touches the outside of your body! Even if you drink it; it would only go into your body and then come out. There is no spiritual infusion of water baptism that washes your sins away unless you believe in some form of ritualistic superstitious Paganistic spiritism in matter like water. Perhaps water would save everyone that took a bath if that were the case. If water saves; then why was there a need for the death of the Lord Jesus Christ or His blood to be shed at all? If water saves then you should be able to find that also in the Old Testament or were they NOT saved? Exodus 12:13, “**And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.**” Ops, the Lord meant to say “when I see the water”! NO! It was BLOOD!

1 Peter 1:18-19, “Forasmuch as ye know that **ye were not redeemed** with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by

tradition from your fathers; But **with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:**”

Acts 20:28, “Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which **the Holy Ghost** hath made you overseers, to feed the church of **God**, which **he hath purchased with his own blood.**” It’s God’s blood that you were purchased with; not water; not your own blood; not sweet tea; it was sinless blood. Where do you find sinless water? If water saves; what gave it that power? Is it holy water? Is that not Romanism?

Romans 3:25, “Whom God hath set forth to be a **propitiation** through **faith in his blood**, to declare **his righteousness for the remission of sins** that are past, through the **forbearance of God**;” with Ephesians 1:7, “In whom we have **redemption through his blood**, the **forgiveness of sins**, according to the riches of his grace;” with Ephesians 2:13, “But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are **made nigh by the blood of Christ.**” These are more than remission: they are propitiation, forbearance, redemption, forgiveness and reconciliation: Colossians 1:20, “And, **having made peace through the blood of his cross**, by him to **reconcile all things unto himself**; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.” With Hebrews 9:12, “Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but **by his own blood** he entered in once into the holy place, having **obtained eternal redemption** for us.” It is NOT a water salvation! It is a blood atonement: Exodus 30:10, “And Aaron shall make **an atonement** upon the horns of it once in a year **with the blood of the sin offering of atonements**: once in the year shall he make **atonement** upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD.” Not a water atonement! Leviticus 17:11, “For **the life of the flesh is in the blood**: and I have given it to you upon the altar **to make an atonement for your souls**: for **it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.**” It is obvious the Passover Lamb become the blood atonement. The word “atonement” shows up ONE time in the New Testament Romans 5:8-11, “But God **commendeth his love** toward us, in that, **while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us**. Much more then, **being now justified by his blood**, we **shall be saved from wrath through him**. For if, when **we were enemies**, **we were reconciled** to God **by the death of his Son**, much more, **being reconciled**, we **shall be saved by his life**. And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, **by whom we have now received the atonement.**”

Water Baptism is similar to Spirit Baptism like your body is similar to your soul and spirit. The Soul is a spiritual body while the spirit is inside it and takes the shape of that soul. Your body is the image of your soul. When you receive the Lord Jesus Christ; He imputes His righteousness to you and then comes in to you and enters into your dead spirit and gives you a new birth (eternal life); then circumcises your flesh from your soul and thereby saving your soul from any penalty of the sins of the flesh. One day you will be raised up in a physical resurrection and this is when the body is redeemed.

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
