Biblical Numerology 101







Numbers in the Bible is a subject of great importance. Even math is important in the Bible. God DIVIDED the light from darkness, among other things, and God told Adam to MULTIPLY, and God ADDED to the church in the Book of Acts; and God took away the sins of the world! So we have division, multiplication, addition and subtraction; and a whole book in the Bible called NUMBERS.

- 1. Deuteronomy 6:4, "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:" and Isaiah 47:4, "As for our redeemer, the LORD of hosts is his name, the Holy One of Israel." And Isaiah 54:5, "For thy Maker is thine husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called." And Isaiah 57:15, "For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones." And Zechariah 14:9, "And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one."
- 2. Philippians 1:23, "For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:" and Numbers 31:27, "And divide the prey into two parts; between them that took the war upon them, who went out to battle, and between all the congregation:"
- 3. 1 John 5:7, "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one." And Acts 17:29, "Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device."
