

Intro to Numerology & Galatians 3:13

Galatians 3:13, "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree..."

It was because of a three-fold curse!

Notice the word here is word number 7, 14 and 21: 7 words apart from each other! First of all notice that in the Old Testament there is a Curse placed on the earth because of Adam causing death to pass on all people, animals and plants; secondly there is a Curse of the law given by Moses of which no one can attain and thirdly the last words of the Old Testament ends in "...a curse." The Old Testament containing 39 books and 39 is 3 times 13.

1. Genesis 3:17-19, 'And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life; Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.'
2. The Law: Galatians 3:10, "For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them." And Deuteronomy 11:28, "And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known."
3. Malachi 4:5-6, "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse."

Malachi 3:9, "Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation." Word 3 and 6 or $3 \times 6 = 18$ thus in Malachi 4:5&6 has 51 words $5 + 1 = 6$ & $4 + 5 + 6 = 15$ & $1 + 5 = 6$ & The verse of the words "a curse" is verse 6. So 666 & $18 \times 37 = 666$,

Also notice that Christ is number 1 in the verse above and the US is word number 4! Number 1 is Jesus Christ, so as the Bible says: 2 Corinthians 5:19, "To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation." God was IN CHRIST,

reconciling the WORLD unto HIMSELF! The word US is the world or number 4 because: John 3:16, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." $1 + 6 = 7$ and so 3 sevens or 777. Thus: 2 Corinthians 5:21, "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

The words Curse are 7 words apart, because Christ is a 7, and even further, he is a triune 7: Colossians 2:9, "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily." And when we look at: Revelation 19:16, "And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS." Notice that the all CAPS words are 7 in number AND that there are 25 words: $2+5=7$ and the verse is 16 and $1+6=7$ then notice that the Chapter is 19 and $1+9=10$ and $1+0=1$ so, Christ is #1 and he is the 777!

The word "redeemed" is word number 3 because Jesus Christ redeemed your spirit, soul and body.

For the Spirit: 1 Peter 1:18-21, "Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God." And 1 Peter 1:23-25, "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you." John 3:6-7, "That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again." 1 Corinthians 6:17, "But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit."

For the Soul: Romans 3:24-26, "Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus." Isaiah 61:10, "I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels."

For the Body: Romans 8:23, "And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body." Again: Ephesians 4:30, "And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption." Furthermore: Colossians 1:12-17, "Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: Who is the image of the

invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.”

The word Law is word number 10 and written is 20 or 2 x 10. Ring a bell? You think it's The Ten Commandments maybe? And what is written is 20 would be the rest of the law 2 times 10. So 3 tens is 30, and one of the commandments is NOT a moral commandment and has to do with SEVEN. None of the other commandments are numerical. So you have 30 plus 7 or 37. And again Romans 3:20, “Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.” Justification does not come by keeping the law. Galatians 3:24, “Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.” And again we read in Romans 3:24-26, “Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.”

Let's put all this together: The 777 became a 13 13 13 to redeem spirit, soul and body, so that the actual numerics of Galatians 3:13, shows precisely what the verse says! Only found in a King James Bible!

The trouble is man has fallen short of the glory of God: Man is a 6 fallen short of God the 7. Math shows this very truth: $6 \times 6 = 36$ and all the numbers from 1 to 36 equals 666; however, if you add just ONE more number (37) to that you get 703.

$$3 \times 6 = 18 \times 37 = 666 \ \& \ 6 + 6 + 6 = 18 = 6 \times 3$$
$$3 \times 7 = 21 \times 37 = 777 \ \& \ 7 + 7 + 7 = 21 = 7 \times 3$$

There is only one single digit number that will not divide into a circle evenly; and it is 7. Next to that is 11 and next is 13. So you have a positive (7) a neutral (11) and a negative (13). $7 \times 11 \times 13 = 1001$ & the decimal of the binary 1001 is 9. 9 is the inversion of 6. So 6 the number of man would also be for the works of the flesh opposed or inverted from the 9 or the fruits of the Spirit.

This is a small sampling of numbers and the Bible. The bottom line is what have you done with Jesus Christ? He paid the price for you to miss hell fire and damnation. If you have never received HIM you are not ready to die, and you will die in your sins and face judgment. Your sin debt MUST be recognized and payment must be RECEIVED by YOU. Or what the Lord did for YOU was in vain and you PAY for your own SINS.

It is not enough to just understand the gospel; you MUST believe unto the saving of the soul. It is not a head thing, it is a heart thing: Romans 10:9-10, “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

I was a sinner and
That is why I needed a saviour:
YOU are a sinner and
That is why YOU need a saviour.

1 Timothy 2:5-6, "For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time."

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."
