

# The Trinity & 1 John 5:7

**“For there are three that bear record in heaven,  
the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost:  
and these three are one.”**

1 John 5:7

Starting out with this verse in this Bible Study; many would say this is ridiculous because it does not belong in the Bible, however if you are needing information about the vindication of this verse please read my study: AV1611KJB - 1 John 5 - 7, The Vindication of; on my website: <http://biblestudies.av1611kjb.org> as this study is based on the AV text and is not assuming that it is in error in any way, shape or form. This study is from the Bible Believing perspective.

To begin with the verse has a word math problem in it that is at face value not a true expression; that is, in natural math. Three does not equal one unless you are God! The expression  $3 = 1$  in the passage is in fact a descriptive nature of the Godhead given as the three are listed in the verse. While the word God is not in the verse; this is considered assumed because each one has that attribute elsewhere. However we are not dealing with proving the Trinity. Again if you want to study any vindication of the Trinity or Trinitarianism see my Bible Study page. I have a few studies out there for that purpose. In this study we are taking the Trinitarian side of that debate and are not debating this in this particular study. The debates can be found on my page where I am dealing with Oneness Pentecostals and other Oneness groups.

Now we can start our study.

Perhaps the greatest mystery in the Bible is the first 4 words of the Bible: Genesis 1:1a, “In the beginning God...” However as a Bible Believer; I believe that God has revealed Himself and His very nature in the Bible: Romans 1:20, “For the invisible things of him **from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made**, even his **eternal power and Godhead**; so that they are without excuse.” God created math; and the math of or text shows clearly God’s eternal power and Godhead.

Given  $3 = 1$  (1 John 5:7)

It is then safe to say that if  $3 = 1$  then  $1 = 3$ . The laws of math allow for this in every possible way.

It is therefore safe to say by these that seven would come into play in this in a very unique way because when God sanctified something or made a thing holy like the seventh day; God made it the Sabbath. Of the days of the week in the Hebrew calendar the seventh day is **יום שבת**: Yom Shabbat also known as **יום שבת קודש**: Yom Shabbat Kodesh. However more commonly called **שבת**: Shabbat or Sabbath. So the name of the day of the week Sabbath is a designation of the number of the days of the week Seven. Sabbath can refer to Seventh as it is not only the day of the week; but the seventh week, the seventh month, the seventh year, the seventh, the seventh year of years, etc. For this study see my Bible Study page for the study on Doctrine - The Seven Sabbaths.

Dealing with the math again we see this number seven comes into play because of the nature of  $3 = 1$ .

What we are dealing with here is Digitary Math which adds the digits of any number to see the

base digit value of that number.

The importance of this shows how numbers interact with each other in a way that  $3 = 1$  is true in dealing with the Godhead.

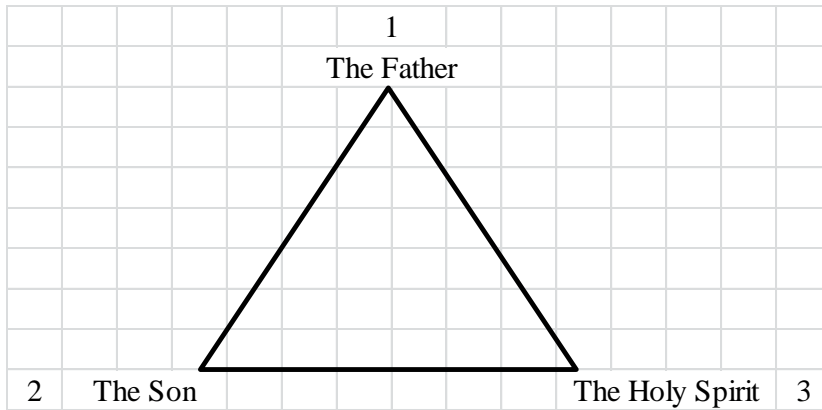

So in dealing with numbers and in particular Numerology we are seeing numbers in a different way than what you were taught in the public school system.

The reason for this is that they do not teach God in the public schools. They cannot understand  $3 = 1$  or the application of such a truism.

The easiest way to view this is to see it in a geometric form. However understand that this is not a divine geometry; nor does it show or represent the Godhead 100%.

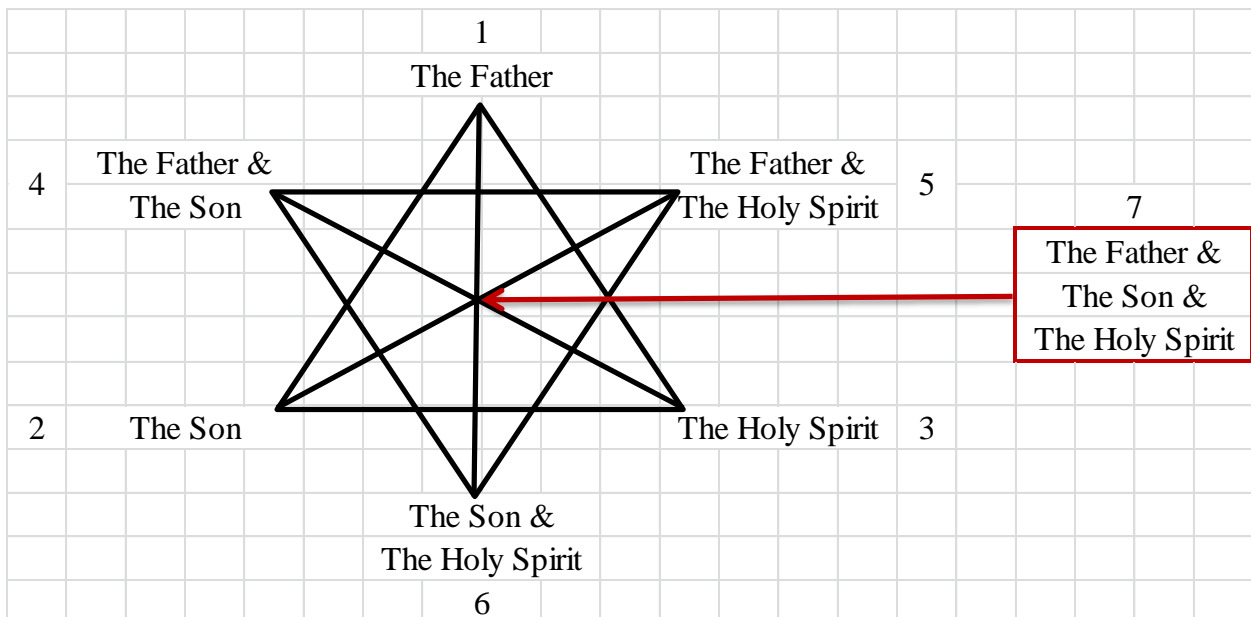


This is meant to only show a three that is one. So we can continue with this understanding.

From the Bible we know that the Father is 100% God; and that the Son is 100% God and that the

Holy Spirit is 100% God. This is the nature of the Godhead. In this the  $\Delta$  represents the one true God. So that each one of the three are the one true God; and as we will see they are  $3 = 1$ .

Like I said before if  $3 = 1$ ; then it would be substantiated that  $1 = 3$ ; because within each one are all three. There is another understanding of this by the nature of  $3 = 1$ ; there is the working of together of two of each of the three and then there is all three together working together. This working or agreeing is combined in that they are all the same one Godhead. Thus:

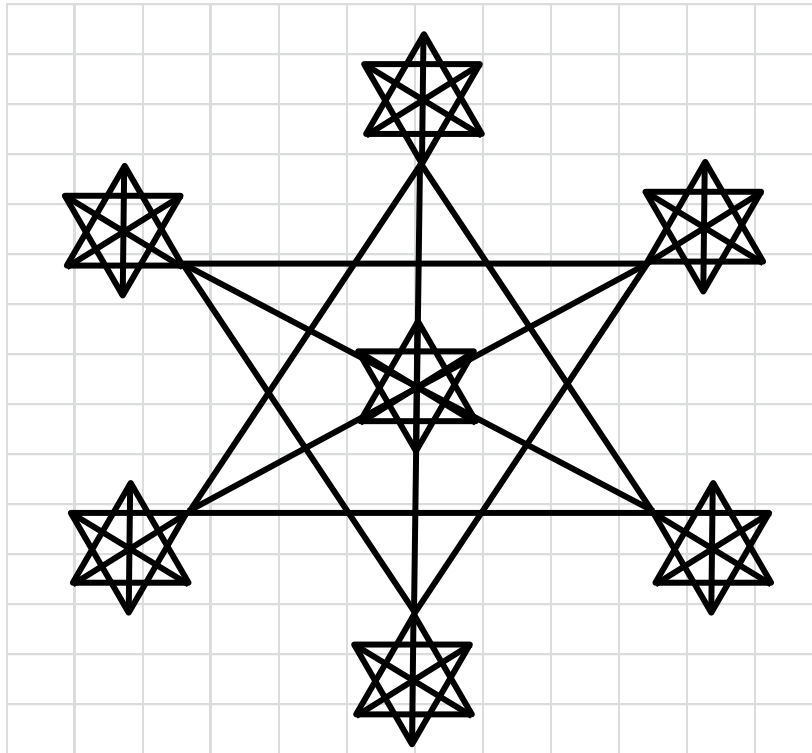


$$1 = 3 = 7$$

Each are IN each other so that each one is also 7 and all are still ONE. This simultaneous understanding dispenses with any notion of the Godhead being pantheistic or polytheistic (multiple gods) or anthropomorphic (only on person like

man). The one God shows a personal God with simultaneously three separate persons of the Godhead; where one, two or all three are at work whether together or apart. However this conjoining fact can continue because of God's attribute of His eternal nature.

So like I said: each are IN each other so that each one is also 7 and are still ONE.

So either 49 or 84 at this level; either way you go this shows that this construct is a never ending promotion based on the equation  $3 = 1$ .

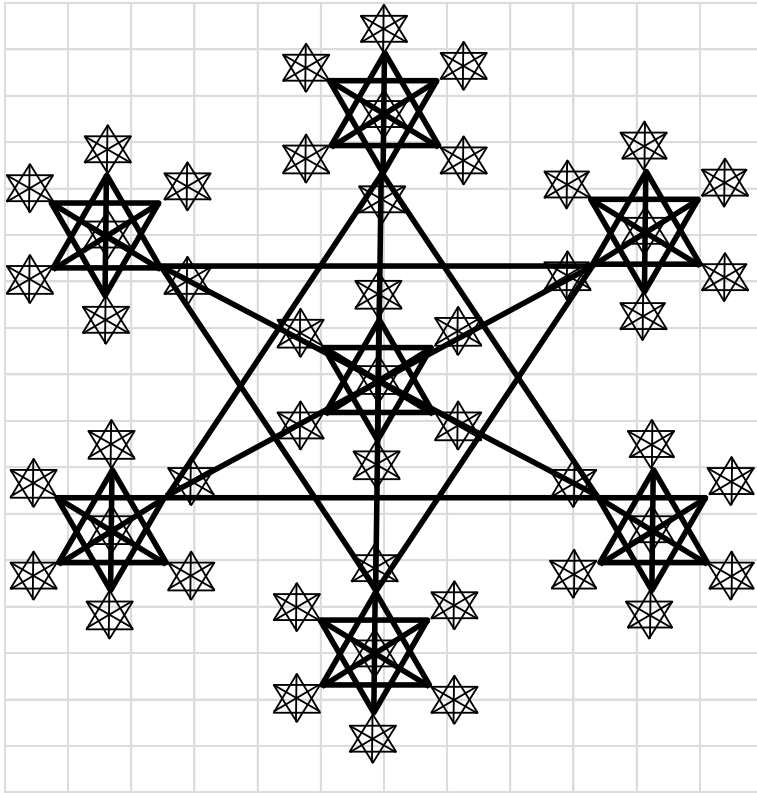

The use of Digitary Math allows us to see the value of a number in a single digit. However this line is like I said complicated, convoluted and can cause way too much stress. So to keep things a little bit simpler; we will revert back to the basic 7

At this point you should see the pattern 4, 1, 7. This pattern shows in the Digitary Math values and repeats every three (3) levels. Showing a 1, 3, 4, 7 pattern.

If 3 = 1 then this is goes out to infinity: ∞ in both directions.

This anomaly shows that the basic constructs for all things are in these basic numbers. However what is important about these levels is that they go on forever. There may be a hierarchy to this; but the fact remains that if 3 = 1 in anything it would be an eternal thing and would also be an infinite thing. Because we are dealing with the Godhead: that makes God Eternal and Infinite in His nature of persons. Not finite like man. Now wrapping our finite brain around this can be a bit tricky; but suffice it to say God is the Godhead. This is the same as saying God is a Trinity with a definite number of who is involved in the Godhead. And according to 1 John 5:7 it is "...the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost..." and mathematically THESE three (3) are (=) one (1)!

There is no way around this regardless what you want to believe; as a Bible Believer, I believe what the Bible says regardless what other so called proof is given for anyone's pantheistic or polytheistic (multiple gods) or anthropomorphic (only on person like man) that is alien from the Biblical text in the Authorized Version known most commonly as the King James Bible.
