

# The Roman Perversion of the Ten Commandments and other Perverted Doctrines of Rome

What does the Bible say? I am not saying anything. God is our guide and he gave us the Bible to know the truth: Paganism graven images? All graven images made for worship are pagan. Rome is pagan. Rome KILLED Jesus Christ and murdered the Apostles and killed the saints during the Reformation. Pagan Rome altered itself and became Mystery Babylon still pagan, but hidden in the guise of a "Christian" church. Image worship is image worship: Idolatry is Idol worship regardless who is doing it. Do you have any idols in your heart? You do know there are non-graven idols?

Here are the Ten Commandments:

1. Exodus 20:3, "Thou shalt have no other gods before me."
2. Exodus 20:4-6, "Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments."
3. Exodus 20:7, "Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain."
4. Exodus 20:8-11, "Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it."
5. Exodus 20:12, "Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee."
6. Exodus 20:13, "Thou shalt not kill."
7. Exodus 20:14, "Thou shalt not commit adultery."
8. Exodus 20:15, "Thou shalt not steal."
9. Exodus 20:16, "Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour."
10. Exodus 20:17, "Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's."

From the King James Bible with the splits at each period showing the division of the Ten Commandments as God intended. The second commandment: Exodus 20:4-6, "Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the

water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.” Not any where does it say “pagan idols”, and therefore it is all inclusive. The law was given to the children of Israel, not to pagans.

Rome altered the text so that **they removed this verse** about **graven images** and split the last commandment to make two and renumber them:

1. I, the Lord, am your God. You shall not have other gods besides me.
2. You shall not take the name of the Lord God in vain
3. Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day
4. Honor your father and your mother
5. You shall not kill
6. You shall not commit adultery
7. You shall not steal
8. You shall not bear false witness
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods

By splitting the last law, they altered the text and then split the last command at a comma when all the others are split at a period. **Liars and deceivers will always be found out.**

The obvious commandment is there as attested to by these other passages: Leviticus 19:4, “Turn ye not unto idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods: I am the LORD your God.” And Leviticus 26:1, “Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.” And Leviticus 26:30, “And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcasses upon the carcasses of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.”

And also attested by the New Testament: Acts 15:19-20, “Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.” And Acts 15:29, “That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.” And Acts 21:25, “As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication.” And 2 Corinthians 6:14-18, “Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.” And 1 John 5:21, “Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.”

So do you eat human flesh? And do you drink human blood? What does that make you? Physical things cannot wash away your filthy dirty rotten sins; physically things do not touch your soul or spirit to make you clean.

Water baptism is the same, it is physical; it can do nothing to wash away your dirty rotten filthy sins... if you die in your sins you will burn in Hell. None can save you but Jesus Christ. You must BELIEVE on HIM alone for salvation and stop believing in trinkets, magic and superstitions. Christ's death is spiritually infused on us inside when we believe on him: Romans 3:23-26, “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ

Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.”

The Bible makes it clear and simple: If you are not born again you are going to burn in hell: John 3:5-7, “Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.” See it is physical birth and then spiritual birth. The born of water is not water baptism. Water baptism is NOT being born of water. The water birth is the physical birth. That is just someone rewriting the Bible for their own purposes. You get born again by receiving Jesus Christ but not physically: John 1:12-13, “But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.” If you reject him or add something else with him, he will not save you. It must be faith in Jesus Christ ALONE: Galatians 2:16, “Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.”

Thus the conclusion of the matter is: Galatians 3:22, “But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.”

So read that last verse carefully: “...that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that are water baptized.” Is THAT what it said? NO! So what about: “...that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that eat Jesus’ human flesh and drink his human blood.” Is THAT what it said? NO! It said: “...to them that believe.” When you believe the gospel God counts your faith like Abraham’s faith for righteousness. Nothing else will do. Don’t trust in your own righteousness or any church or person from that church. TRUST THE BIBLE: Romans 10:3-4, “For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.” See what is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believes is CHRIST: he is ALIVE. He is not dead and hanging on a cross. No priest can pull him out of heaven and sacrifice him again on an altar of human flesh and human blood; Christ died ONCE for all: Hebrews 10:10-13, “By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.”

You can do this, it is so easy; but you MUST trust in Christ ALONE: Romans 10:9-10, “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

Get rid of all the junk that will hinder real faith in Christ alone, the free gift of God is eternal life, and many will miss it because they are trying to earn it.

# Was it actual **FLESH** and **Blood** or **BREAD** and **GRAPE JUICE**?

John 6:47-55, “Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. I am that bread of life. Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us his flesh to eat? Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.”

John 6:56-58, “He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.”

So Jesus Christ also ate the flesh of the father? And told the Apostles, here cut my flesh and eat some! But let’s continue with the passage:

John 6:59-62, “These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum. Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it? When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you? What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?”

It did offend them, and rightly so as it should. Jesus Christ was meaning to offend them by this to weed out the unbelievers. It is not about the FLESH it is about the spirit that makes alive: the WORDS that he spoke; because the WORDS are spirit and the WORDS are life, not his flesh. Keep reading:

John 6:63, “It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.”

Now the reason for doing this:

John 6:64-69, “But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him. And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father. From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him. Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life. And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.”

Then he tells about Judas who was there:

John 6:70-71, “Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil? He spake of Judas Iscariot the son of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.”

There were some that left after that hard saying of eating his flesh and drinking his blood, but it is obvious that he meant it in a spiritual way about the words that he was speaking and not the literal flesh and blood which would be contrary to the Old and New Testaments. Blood was forbidden to eat:

Genesis 9:4, "But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat."

Leviticus 19:26, "Ye shall not eat any thing with the blood: neither shall ye use enchantment, nor observe times."

Deuteronomy 12:16, "Only ye shall not eat the blood; ye shall pour it upon the earth as water."

Acts 15:20, "But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood."

Acts 15:29, "That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well."

Acts 21:25, "As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication."

If you take the passage in John literally then you have to alter the Bible in these places to promote your form of cannibalism. So as it was at the last supper:

Matthew 26:26, "And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body." So the Lord proceeds to cut off a part of his body and pass it around so they could eat his body and then:

Matthew 26:27-28, "And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it; For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins." So he bleed out into the cup and passed that around so they could drink his blood of the new testament, right? And then the obvious happens:

Matthew 26:29, "But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom." Oh it was not blood after all it was fruit of the vine; and it was new wine not old so it was not even fermented! So it was NOT blood, and therefore the bread was NOT flesh and so this is in complete agreement with the whole Bible NOT TO DRINK or EAT BLOOD. And to not drink strong drink as it was grape juice.
