- 1. Proverbs 4:1, "Hear, ye children, the <u>instruction</u> of a father, and <u>attend</u> to know <u>understanding</u>."
 - a. Instruction: Proverbs 15:33, "**The fear of the LORD is the instruction** of wisdom; and before honour is humility." And Proverbs 4:13, "**Take fast hold of instruction**; let her not go: keep her; for she is thy life." And Proverbs 12:1, "Whoso **loveth instruction** loveth knowledge: but he that hateth reproof is brutish."
 - b. Knowledge: Proverbs 1:7, "**The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge**: but fools despise wisdom and instruction." And Proverbs 23:12, "<u>Apply</u> thine heart unto instruction, and thine ears to **the words of knowledge**."
 - c. Understanding: Proverbs 16:22, "Understanding is a wellspring of life unto him that hath it: but the instruction of fools is folly."
- 2. Proverbs 4:20, "My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings."
 - a. WORDS: Job 19:23, "Oh that my **words** were now written! oh that they were printed in a book!" They are; it is called The Holy Bible: Psalms 50:17, "Seeing thou hatest instruction, and castest my **words** behind thee." Hatred of the Bible has caused a hatred for attention to instruction.
 - b. Inclination: Psalms 17:6, "I have called upon thee, for thou wilt hear me, O God: **incline** thine ear unto me, and **hear my speech**." Psalms 71:2, "Deliver me in thy righteousness, and cause me to escape: **incline** thine ear unto me, and save me." To incline to something takes personal attention to it. If you want God to incline to you; you MUST incline to Him.
 - c. Sayings: Proverbs 2:2-6, "So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding; Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding; If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures; Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God. For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding."
- 3. Proverbs 5:1, "My son, attend unto my wisdom, and bow thine ear to my understanding:"
 - a. Attending: Proverbs 7:24, "**Hearken** unto me now therefore, O ye children, and **attend** to the words of my mouth." And 1 Timothy 4:13, "Till I come, give **attendance** to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine."
 - b. Wisdom: Proverbs 9:10, "The fear of the LORD is the **beginning of wisdom**: and the **knowledge of the holy is understanding**."
 - c. Understanding: Psalms 119:130, "The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth **understanding** unto the simple." And Proverbs 10:13, "In the lips of him that hath **understanding** wisdom is


found: but a rod is for the back of him that is void of **understanding**." And 1 John 5:20, "And we know that the Son of God is come, and **hath given us an <u>understanding</u>**, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life."

Proverbs 7:24, "Hearken unto me now therefore, O ye children, and attend to the words of my mouth."

Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD, similar to hyperkinetic disorder in the ICD-10) is a neurodevelopmental psychiatric disorder [1][2][3][4] in which there are significant problems with executive-functions (e.g., attentional control and inhibitory-control) that cause attention deficits, hyperactivity, or impulsiveness which is not appropriate for a person's age. <a href="[5][6][7] These symptoms must begin by age six to twelve and persist for more than six months for a diagnosis to be made. Despite being the most commonly studied and diagnosed psychiatric disorder in children and adolescents, the cause in the majority of cases is <u>unknown</u>. The <u>World Health Organization</u> estimates that it affected about 39 million people as of 2013. [11] It affects about 6–7% of children when diagnosed via the <u>DSM-IV</u> criteria [12] and 1–2% when diagnosed via the <u>ICD-10</u> criteria. [13] Rates are similar between countries and **depend mostly on <u>how</u> it is diagnosed**. [14] ADHD is diagnosed approximately three times more in boys than in girls. [15][16] About 30–50% of people diagnosed in childhood continue to have symptoms into adulthood and between 2–5% of adults have the condition. [11][17][18] The condition can be <u>difficult to tell apart from other disorders</u> as well as that of <u>high normal activity</u>. [9]


Romans 6:18, "Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness."
