

THE Illogical FROM Logic AND Reason

Logic and Reason do not produce a sound understanding of Right and Wrong. There MUST be a RULE that is followed that is TRUE and RIGHT. Just because a sound reasoning through a pattern of logic deduces a systematic logical outcome, does not make that outcome right. The premise must be accurately correct and right for the outcome to be so. In programming college they say: garbage in garbage out! This is true of all logical processes. The programming of computers follows a logical pattern. But if your data input is incorrect, the outcome will also be incorrect. This seems to be common sense; however, there are some who enjoy the somewhat illogical processing of wrong data to prove that they can give a logical answer based on the logical pattern to ascertain the illogical answers derived thereby.

I found this math statement online:

If $1+5=12$ and if $2+10=24$ and if $3+15=36$ then what is $5+25=?$

They logic would dictate that $1+5=12$ means $1x2+5x2=12$. In mathematics there is a hierarchical logic of the operands when there is no parenthesis “()”. So that the parenthetical segregated operands come first. So where there is no parenthesis then working from high to low multiplication, division, addition then subtraction in that order. So that $1x2+5x2=2+10=12$ is true and $1x2+5x2=2+5x2=7x2=14$ is wrong. Unless the statement was $((1x2)+5)x2=14$ which then would be true.

Now that we have established this mathematical fact the logic dictates that $1+5=12$ means $1x2+5x2=12$ so that:

However the logic is faulty because the data is FALSE:

Assuming $1+5=12$ means $1 \times 2 + 5 \times 2 = 12$ is a logical error because:

$1+5=12$ is False. The correct answer is 6.

$2+10=24$ is False. The correct answer is 12.

$3+15=36$ is False. The correct answer is 18.

Ergo $5+25=?$ The correct answer is 30.

Saying "IF something" does not make it RIGHT. Once you put "=" in the mix you MUST make it a true statement or it is FALSE and therefore INCORRECT. The assumptions produced by this ERROR are also FALSE. Assuming for a moment $1+5=12$ you MUST put the equation through a mental gymnastics so that the right answer doubles. However that is NOT the statement. $1+5=(1+1)+(5+5)$ is still NOT TRUE. However $(1+1)+(5+5)=12$ is true. This is NOT a solution to the original problem it is an assumption read into the problem. Things that are not the same are NOT EQUAL.

People don't like to deal with RIGHT and WRONG or TRUE and FALSE. They are too absolute for most people that want to assume these things do not exist. The abstract illogical thinker will strive at great lengths to prove that there are no absolutes:

If $1+5=12$ and if $2+12=24$ and if $3+15=36$ were actually true, then there would be no way to make a CORRECT statement about “ $5+25=?$ ” unless you followed that same false assumptions and illogical fallacies. Fact is to make things EQUAL they must be the SAME. If you add $1+5$ you get 6, but 6 does NOT EQUAL 12 that is therefore an INCORRECT STATEMENT; Ergo a FALICY.

If the argumentative statements are invalid, the outcome will also be invalid even if the logic is sound. Sound logic never implies a correct answer. The answer of a logical statement is always based on the premise being true. If the premise is FALSE the outcome of the logic will also be FALSE.

If Sam is a man, and all men have beards, than Sam has a beard.

This is sound logic, however: the statement that “all men have beards” is not true. But if you follow the logic it produces a true sounding logical statement which is only true IF the premise is also true. It is logically true, but is it actually TRUE? NO. Because not all men have beards! ERGO Sam may or may not have a beard, it is UNCERTAIN because there is not enough information to KNOW for certain because the premise is incorrect.

In plain English: if $2+2$ is not 4 then you cannot count on ANY equation equaling its counterpart. $2+2=4$ will always be the same. $2+2$ will never equal 8 or 5 or 16 or 37. IF you were to say $2+2=37$ you would get a big red X on your test sheet because it is WRONG!

Numbers are precise and exact. You can't build a house or construct a machine with fake math or abstract logic, or assumptions in logical calculations. It is therefore not only illogical, but also a production of futility resulting in uselessness.

Job 15:31, “Let not him that is deceived trust in vanity: for vanity shall be his recompence.”

Job 15:35, “They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit.”

Psalms 12:2, “They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak.”

Psalms 62:9, “Surely men of low degree are vanity, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than vanity.”

If _____ + _____ = _____ is incorrect it is a false balance. The balance is the “=” of any equation.

If you cannot COUNT, do not show to others your ignorance lest you reveal yourself a FOOL and IGNORANT. You ARE going to REAP what you SOW!
