Acts 8:9-11, “But there was a certain man, called **Simon**, which beforetime in the same city used **sorcery**, and **bewitched** the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God. And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had **bewitched** them with **sorceries**.”

Acts 13:6, “And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain **sorcerer**, a **false prophet**, a Jew, whose name was **Barjesus**: Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God. But **Elymas the sorcerer** (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith. Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him, And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, **thou child of the devil**, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand.”

Exodus 7:11, “Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the **sorcerers**: now the **magicians** of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their **enchantments**.”

Leviticus 18:21, “And thou shalt not let any of thy **seed pass through the fire to Molech**, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I am the LORD.”

Leviticus 20:27, “A man also or woman that hath a **familiar spirit**, or that is a **wizard**, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones: their blood shall be upon them.”

Deuteronomy 18:9-12, “When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after **the abominations** of those nations. There shall not be found

among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to **pass through the fire**, or that useth **divination**, or an **observer of times**, or an **enchanter**, or a **witch**, Or a **charmer**, or a **consulter with familiar spirits**, or a **wizard**, or a **necromancer**. For all that do these things are an **abomination** unto the LORD: and because of these **abominations** the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee.”

1 Kings 11:7, “Then did Solomon build an **high place for Chemosh, the abomination** of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for **Molech, the abomination** of the children of Ammon.”

2 Kings 17:17, “And they **caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire**, and used **divination** and **enchantments**, and **sold themselves to do evil** in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.”

2 Chronicles 33:6, “And he **caused his children to pass through the fire** in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he **observed times**, and used **enchantments**, and used **witchcraft**, and dealt with a **familiar spirit**, and with **wizards**: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.”

Isaiah 47:9, “But these two things shall come to thee in a moment in one day, the loss of children, and widowhood: they shall come upon thee in their perfection for the multitude of thy **sorceries**, and for the great abundance of thine **enchantments**.”

Jeremiah 27:9, “Therefore hearken not ye to your prophets, nor to your **diviners**, nor to your dreamers, nor to your **enchanters**, nor to your **sorcerers**, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon:”

Daniel 2:2, “Then the king commanded to call the **magicians**, and the **astrologers**, and the **sorcerers**, and the Chaldeans, for to shew the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.”

Revelation 9:21, “Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their **sorceries**, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.”

Revelation 21:8, “But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and **sorcerers**, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.”

Revelation 22:15, “For without are dogs, and **sorcerers**, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.”

Note: “The word "necromancy" is adapted from Late Latin necromantia, itself borrowed from post-Classical Greek νεκρομαντεία (nekromanteía), a compound of Ancient Greek νεκρός (nekrós), "dead body", and μαντεία (manteía), "prophecy or divination"; this compound form was first used by Origen of Alexandria in the 3rd century CE. The Classical Greek term was ἡ νέκυια (nekyia), from the episode of the Odyssey in which Odysseus visits the realm of the dead

and νεκρομαντεία in Hellenistic Greek, rendered as necyomantīa in Latin, and as necromancy in 17th-century English.” From: <http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Necromancy>
