

Biblical Trinitarianism or Oneness Pentecostal Modalism

Someone said: “Trinitarians believe in three gods!”

Sargent answers: I am a Trinitarian and I do NOT believe what you said I believe; that makes you a LIAR... Did you know that? Liars cannot be trusted. Did you know that? Your redefining what



Trinitarians believe is utter nonsense. But this would figure as you have not given ONE proof text for your pseudo-Christianity; not ONE proof text to disprove the Trinity – You have no idea WHO you are dealing with when you are dealing with the Godhead. You seem to think that God is LIKE YOU!



1. Man is tripartite in nature: that is, humans are ONE person with three distinct different major parts. 1 Thessalonians 5:23, “And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God **your whole spirit and soul and body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”
2. God is a Trinity in nature: that is, the Godhead is THREE distinct PERSONS all equally almighty, holy and righteous, with justice, grace, mercy and truth. Distinctly One Lord God Almighty ergo “**Godhead**”.
 - a. The Father is distinct from the Son: John 17:11, “And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and **I come to thee. Holy Father**, keep through **thine own name** those whom thou hast given me, that **they may be one, as we are.**” Are you ONE person with GOD? Are you the SAME person as GOD? NO! “...that they may be one, as we are.” If God the Father is ONE person that is also His Son they you are to be ONE like that with God! That is just a boneheaded idea. But some of these people actually think they are HOLY like GOD! They are to be one together as ONE body of Christ. But they are not ONE and the same person. Oneness Pentecostalism leads to an exploitation of the Scriptures making them fraudulent. Like Jehudi and his penknife these self-righteous charlatans cut the

Scriptures to shreds. (Jeremiah 36:23)

- b. The Son and the Father are distinct from the Holy Spirit: John 14:26, “**But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name**, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.” With John 15:26, “**But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:**” and John 16:7, “**Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away:** for if I go not away, **the Comforter** will not come unto you; but if I depart, **I will send him unto you.**” The Comforter is the Holy Ghost and the Spirit of Truth; He is a “...whom...” and is sent from the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Three separate PERSONS.
3. All three are ONE God; but they are also distinctly THREE persons:
 - a. 1 John 5:7, “**For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.**” If it said these ONE are one; then you might have something else to teach me; it did NOT say that like you suppose. You also are probably of the opinion that this verse does not belong in the Bible. And that is fine after all you are entitled to your own opinion; which is all I have seen from any Oneite’s diatribe. If this is the case about this verse; I know one thing for sure: you are NOT a Bible Believer. If you think this verse doesn’t belong in your Bible; then NEVER use the King James Bible. After all there is no sense in being a hypocrite. I mean if you think this verse is a mistake or an error or worse a LIE. Then you need to get a version that promotes your doctrinal beliefs; Right? And never allow the Bible to tell you what you SHOULD believe; I mean that would make you hypocritical. Your faith after all is in your own mind and your own opinion.



If God manifest Himself in three Persons at the same time why would you ever think that God is ONE PERSON? That is: a one person God

is NOT a Godhead!

- b. Matthew 3:16-17, “And **Jesus**, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw **the Spirit of God descending** like a dove, and lighting upon **him**: And lo a **voice from heaven**, saying, **This is my beloved Son**, in whom I am well pleased.”
- c. Mark 1:10, “And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and **the Spirit** like a dove descending upon **him**: And there came a **voice from heaven**, saying, **Thou art my beloved Son**, in whom I am well pleased.”
- d. Luke 3:21-22, “Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that **Jesus** also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened, And **the Holy Ghost descended** in a bodily shape like a dove upon **him**, and a **voice came from heaven**, which said, **Thou art my beloved Son**; in thee I am well pleased.”



All three passages agree the Father was IN HEAVEN; Jesus Christ was ON EARTH; and the Holy Spirit descended FROM HEAVEN and TO EARTH and LIGHTING UPON Jesus Christ. That is three distinct passages telling you there are three distinct persons in the Godhead. If they were the same PERSON; then this could NOT have taken place. God is NOT LIKE YOU! If God is ONE person He would be finite like YOU. But the issue here is that the Godhead resides in each Person of the Godhead. But you did not know that because you have not believed the Bible.

- e. The Spirit of Christ is the Holy Spirit: Romans 8:9, “But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that **the Spirit of God** dwell in you. Now if any man have not **the Spirit of Christ**, he is none of his.”
- f. The Spirit of the Father is the Holy Spirit: Luke 11:13, “If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your **heavenly Father** give the **Holy Spirit** to them

that ask **him**?" Was not Jesus Christ on EARTH? Why call himself heavenly when He was on earth? Wait; he had to go up there to be the heavenly Father and then come back right? See how stupid that is?

- g. The Father is IN Jesus Christ: John 10:38, "But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that **the Father is in me, and I in him.**" The Lord Jesus Christ did not say The Father IS ME and I am HIM! Wow, I guess you missed that one!
- h. Jesus Christ is WITH the Father: 1 John 1:1-3, "That which was from the beginning, which we have **heard**, which we have **seen** with our eyes, which we have **looked upon**, and our **hands have handled**, of **the Word of life**; (For **the life** was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that **eternal life**, which was with the Father, and **was manifested unto us**;) that which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly **our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.**" You have fellowship with the Father? Or with the Father AND the Son? Why not just believe the Bible. God says what He means and means what He says. Oneites have made up a doctrine and only USE the Bible to promote their agenda. You cannot make the Bible your instrument of regression. Oneites prostitute the Bible.
- i. The Word was God and was WITH God: John 1:1, "**In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.** The same was **in the beginning with God.** All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men." So which is it: was the Word WITH God or was the Word God? Or, is it both? Oneites can only have the Word IS GOD; with God implies two persons. So by implication Jehudi, take out your penknife and start hacking!
- j. The Word was made flesh NOT the Father and NOT the Holy Spirit: John 1:14, "**And the Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld **his glory**, the glory as of the **only begotten of the Father**,) full of grace and truth." The Word was made flesh. This is



the summation of the incarnation of the eternal Word; that became the Son of God when He was begotten of the Father; unless you are a Oneite; you MUST believe that the Word was the Father and the Father was the Word and when God entered into the world and was born of a woman that this was the Father who was begotten by the Father and is the Father not the Son; or the Son is the Son of Himself. Wow, that is just too confusing. That is just an age old digenesis of God. Making God a mortal man. This is NOT what happened at all.

4. The nature of the Godhead is infinite which would mean that though God is ONE God; The Godhead is a plurality. It is this very nature that makes all created beings NOT LIKE GOD! But you want a God like unto yourself: one person regardless what the Bible SAYS! So, have it your way and make your god like you. Modalism is a man-made god like unto man. You can have more than one hobby.

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So when you are doing one hobby (I have many) that say take your entire person to devote to it like painting or knot tying and if you are good at it you can even be called a painter or a macramé hobbyist (both right brain hobbies) whatever that hobby is. If you were to take on a different hobby like construction of a spreadsheet

(totally left brain) and change MODES all the while being the same person and called a macramé hobbyist or a mathematician yet remain the same person. You cannot split yourself to do BOTH at the same time (I'd like to see you try), else there would be conflicts of interest; not enough hands to handle both; etc. Our nature is obviously limited. Even spirit beings like Angels, the Seraphim and Cherubim are limited in their being because they are ONE PERSON.

The Law is ONE Law with many commandments: James 2:10-11, “For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet **offend in one point**, he is **guilty of all**. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, **thou art become a transgressor of the law.**”

God is ONE God with three Persons all equally God. This is the nature of the Godhead. James 2:19, “**Thou believest that there is one God; thou**

doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.” Oneites believe what the devils believe; I wonder if they tremble?

God is NOT limited; after all you do know that there are SEVEN Spirits of God? The limitations of our modes exist because we are finite. God is NOT limited:

- a. Revelation 1:4, “John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from **him which is**, and **which was**, and **which is to come**; and from **the seven Spirits** which are before his throne...”
- b. Revelation 3:1, “And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith **he that hath the seven Spirits of God**, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.”
- c. Revelation 4:5, “And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and **there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.**”
- d. Revelation 5:6, “And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood **a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.**”



All seven of those spirits were in the Lord Jesus Christ! They were sent forth into all the earth. SEVEN SPIRITS! Yet there is only ONE!

5. Do you know where the Seven Spirits are? Shut up and **Pay Attention:**

- a. This is a Messianic Prophecy: Isaiah 11:1, “And there shall come forth **a rod out of the stem of Jesse**, and **a Branch** shall grow **out of his roots:**” Isaiah 11:2, “And...
 - i. the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him,

- ii. the spirit of wisdom
- iii. and understanding,
- iv. the spirit of counsel
- v. and might,
- vi. the spirit of knowledge
- vii. and of the fear of the LORD...

How come you don't know this? What have you been wasting your time with? Staying in Acts 2:38 will keep you blind to these things because the book of Acts kept going and going in a transitional direction from the old Jewish ways to the new Christian ways and Acts is the history of that as it happened.



b. The seven attributes of the Trinity are still ONE GOD:

i. The Seven in ONE

1. The Father
2. The Son (the Word)
3. The Holy Spirit (Holy Ghost, Spirit of Truth, etc.)
4. The Father & God the Son
5. The Father & The Holy Spirit
6. The Son & The Holy Spirit
7. The Father & The Son & The Holy Spirit

c. This means then that all Seven are in EACH!

i. They being ONE Godhead makes this true.

1. John 17:21-23, "**That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us:** that the world may believe that **thou** hast sent me. And the glory which **thou** gavest **me** I have given them; that **they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one;** and that the world may know that **thou** hast sent

me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.”

2. John 17:26, “**And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.**” What name did Jesus Christ declare? What name? What is the Father’s name? You don’t know!
3. 1 Timothy 2:5, “For there is **one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus...**”
 - ii. The fact that God is Omnipotent (meaning all powerful)
 1. Revelation 19:6, “And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the **Lord God omnipotent reigneth.**” Also makes Trinitarianism true.

All powerful reaches farther than the Oneites care to see much less believe.

6. The trouble with the ONENESS Pentecostal:

- a. James 2:19, “**Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.**” You are no better than the devils if you believe there is one God! That is not saying much for the doctrine of Onenessism. So one God is NOT what should be preached or you are preaching what devils believe!
- b. 1 Corinthians 8:6, “**But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.**” There is ONE GOD. Trinitarians do NOT believe in polytheism; that is not an accurate assumption of the doctrine. Trinitarians do NOT believe in a greater and lesser God; once again that would be the same as polytheism. So



COUNT: ONE God, the Father of WHOM; and ONE Lord Jesus Christ **by** WHOM. Notice it is still ONE God. Connect this with Ephesians 2:18, “For **through him** we **both** have access **by one** Spirit unto **the Father.**” And 1 Corinthians 6:17, “But he that is **joined unto the Lord is one spirit.**” Perhaps you are not even aware of the fact that it is your spirit that was born of God IF you are born again. That makes your spirit joined to the Lord in birth. (John 3:5-7). Born of the Spirit is spirit. That is where your eternal life is. If you could lose salvation God would have to KILL HIS OWN SPIRIT that is IN YOU. Perhaps you have not thought this through all the way.

- c. 1 Timothy 2:5, “For there is **one God**, and **one mediator** between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;” A mediator is a DIFFERENT PERSON than the two that are at odds; and brings them together. You



were God’s enemy and God was your enemy. Jesus Christ brought the two together IN HIM being both God and Man! Just because Jesus is both God and Man does not mean that salvation is automatic. You MUST receive Him as your personal Saviour: John 1:12-13.

- d. 1 Timothy 6:14-16, “That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebutable, until **the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:** Which **in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting.** Amen.” Trouble if you make the Lord Jesus Christ the same as the Father when it is Jesus Christ who shows who is the blessed and only Potentate; dwelling in the light WHICH NO MAN CAN APPROACH; and NO MAN HAS SEEN, NOR CAN SEE! 1 John 1:5, “This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that **God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.**” God the Father NEVER became a man! That means they are different persons; or you make a liar out of Jesus Christ.

- e. Romans 8:34, “**Who** is he that condemneth? It is **Christ** that died, yea rather, that **is risen again, who** is even **at the right hand of God, who** also maketh **intercession** for us.” Making intercession for us to WHO? Who is it that Jesus Christ is sitting BESIDE; at WHOSE right hand?
 - f. Hebrews 12:2, “Looking unto **Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who** for the joy that was set before **him** endured the cross, despising the shame, and **is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.**” He is sitting down at his own right hand? He must be beside himself! How does a person sit at their own right hand? Must be at least TWO persons there. One on the Throne and One at the right hand. Perhaps just an oversight on the part of the Oneite.
7. Another thing about your coined word: “deputationalism” by that you mean that Jesus Christ is a lesser god; as you have put it “the eternal son of God” I have never said that phrase; nor have I ever said it was in the Bible; so what. Just because you want to vilify the Trinitarian with no actual Biblical proof does not mean that you can coin words that LIE about what we believe.



- a. 2 Corinthians 5:17-21, “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And **all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ**, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that **God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself**, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. For **he hath made him to be sin** for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.” Who made who to be sin? The Father never became sin for anyone! That would be blasphemy and heretical. But the context tells you the Father made Jesus Christ to be sin for us! This is obvious by the context. A text without a context is a pretext. You may want to look up the word pretext. Pretext: con, ruse, red herring, fraud, scam, rip-

off, etc. Sounds familiar in light of the financial scandals in the Charismatic circles of denominations which include the Oneites.

- b. John 1:1-3, “**In the beginning was the Word**, and **the Word** was **with God**, and **the Word was God**. The same was in the beginning **with God**. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.” So was the Word God or was the Word **WITH God or Both?**”
- c. John 1:14, “And **the Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.” So the Father begot himself: that would make **TWO GODS!** However, this is NOT the case at all. Someone is just not thinking here. There is **ONLY ONE GOD!** WHO is doing the begetting and who is begotten? If God is begetting god, that makes two gods! When a Trinitarian says God the Father; and God the Son; we are making a distinction between Father and Son; not God! One God in Three distinct Persons of the Godhead obviously.

Sign Gifts

The sign gifts are not spiritual; they are physical... They are SEEN! That is what makes them signs. They are not for the believers. They are not for the gentiles. If a lost Jew is not present they are NOT to be done at all. The signs are for Israel. People just don't want to believe the Bible. Taking out of context is the whole idea of 1 Corinthians 14. Contextually it has to also agree with the rest of the book; and the Pauline Epistles. Context is inclusive of the whole Bible. Where Paul's writings are concerned being that they are written to the Body of Christ; Paul is not going to write one thing for the Corinthian believers and it not be applicable for the Thessalonians as well. So if this issue of the sign gift of tongues is so important why is it not mentioned in EVERY epistle Paul



wrote? He wrote to seven churches and there is only ONE chapter devoted to tongues. It is the carnal church of Corinth. There are many doctrines that he wrote to more than one church. The idea that an unknown tongue is the same as an interpreted tongue is ridiculous. There were no unknown tongues in Acts 2. The tongues were spoken languages from the obvious context. Through Acts; the issue of speaking in tongues, healing, and all the sign gifts ended. The Apostleship also ended with the close of the New Testament and John being the last Apostle. The sign gifts ended before Paul was killed in Rome.

Physical THINGS do not save people from hell fire and damnation.

1. Speaking in tongues does not save anyone. NO sign gift does!
2. Water baptism NEVER saves anyone.
3. The LAW never saves anyone.
4. Repentance NEVER saves anyone.
5. Going to church (or joining a church) NEVER saves anyone.
6. Giving Money NEVER saves anyone.
7. There is only ONE that saves: Salvation is found in a PERSON: the Lord Jesus Christ and Him ALONE.

You can do all the signs there are but if you have never received the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour; then you will go to hell when you die. The sign gifts do not save! If you received the Lord Jesus Christ and NEVER do any of the sign gifts: ARE YOU SAVED FROM HELL? But not if you are a Pentecostal (By the way: Pentecost is a Jewish Feast Day not a Christian denomination!)



If you have repented of your sins and have been water baptized: when you die you will go straight to hell. There is no such thing as “repent of your sins” or “repent from your sins”. The baptism in water of repentance is the same baptism that John was doing. It is a national issue having to do with Israel’s Messiah. This is a continuation of that same baptism in light of the fact that they murdered their Messiah. No one has been told anything about being saved from hell or what happens to them after death. Peter was preaching about them killing their Messiah and THAT is why they were pricked in their hearts and asked what THEY must do. That is NOT an individual getting saved.

If water baptism saves then it would not be a figure of anything it would be the “real thing”. However it is a figure in Hebrews 11:6-7, “But without faith it is



impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark **to the saving of his house**; by the which he condemned the world, and **became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.**” And in 1 Peter

3:18-22, “For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited **in the days of Noah**, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, **eight souls were saved by water**. The **like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us** (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by **the resurrection of Jesus Christ**: Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.”


1. Noah was physically saved from drowning, not from hell fire and damnation. It was the saving of his house. The people that were baptized in the water, drown, died and went to the nether regions of the earth. It even tells you it was a figure.
2. Eight souls were saved by water, because they were NOT water baptized! The water saved them because the boat floated on top of the water. So it was the Ark that saved them FROM the watery grave.
3. The water is a FIGURE of baptism. So if water is the figure of baptism then water baptism is a figure of spirit baptism. This is why it says: “...not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God...” It is having to do with a good conscience and NOT the putting away of the filth of the flesh! That was accomplished “...by the resurrection of Jesus Christ...” So water baptism is for conscience sake to show the body of Christ what happened already INSIDE when you got saved and God put away the filth of your flesh by the death, burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 4:23-25, “Now it was not written for his

sake alone, that it was imputed to him (Abraham Romans 4:13); But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.” Justification is the very putting away of the filth of the flesh by imputation. Your sin is imputed to the Lord Jesus Christ and His righteousness is imputed to you when you receive Him as your Saviour. That is what makes you justified. This is why you cannot lose your salvation.

4. It is the Ark that saved them in reality; not the water. But a boat cannot float without water. Nevertheless they were dry when they went in the boat; they were dry inside the boat and they came out dry. So water baptism is only a FIGURE and NOT a sacrament of any kind. There are no sacramental elements in the water “holy water” that sanctifies your soul. Physical water touches your physical body; it has no holy significance and cannot touch your soul or spirit to do anything to them even if it were holy water. Who made your baptismal pool holy anyway? You have someone that has that kind of power and they profess to be able to raise the dead? Why do they not go through the hospitals and touch everyone that is maimed with missing legs and arms or burned victims or people that have cancerous tumor lesions hanging off their bodies? You know why they don’t do that? Because they are LIARS!
5. Noah did obey God in doing what God required him to do to save his families physical life. This has nothing to do with being saved from hell fire and damnation. That is NOT what the flood was about at all.

Stupid Things People Say

Stupid things people say: “The Apostolic Teaching: Have you ever stopped to compare the religion of today with that of the apostles? They baptized (immersed) all their converts in Jesus’ name (not in the titles Father, Son, and Holy Ghost), They were baptized with the Holy Ghost and spoke in other tongues. They believed and practiced divine healing. Any one of these things is called fanaticism by many modern churches. Who is wrong – the Bible or modern churches? Jesus



Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Hebrews 13:8). There is one Lord, one faith, and one baptism (Ephesians 4:5)."

Sargent answers: The Bible did not say titles but this figures from someone that can't read or understand simple English. Matthew 28:19b, "...baptizing them **in the name of** the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost..." That says "...IN THE NAME OF..." it did not say titles anywhere. I suppose you are greater than God and can alter His words to suit your doctrinal persuasion. So who is wrong – the Bible or YOU? I think YOU are wrong! Just about everything in the above is Stupid Things People Say! Misusing Hebrews 13:8 and Ephesians 4:5 will just add to the lies. The misuse comes from yanking this right out of their context! The quoted Hebrews passage was used to tell you that because Jesus is the same then Acts 2:38 MUST be the Gospel! WRONG! The Bible IS right but YOU are



WRONG! Hebrews 13:7-14, "Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, **considering the end** of their conversation. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. **Be not carried about with divers and**

strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein. We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle. For the bodies of those beasts, **whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin**, are burned without the camp. Wherefore **Jesus** also, that he might sanctify the people **with his own blood**, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach. **For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come.**" Simply put, the Lord God Almighty never changes; but HOW God deals with men does. By just quoting that one verse you miss the context and teach a LIE! In the Book of Acts God DOES change the WAY in which He works and deals with men. God altered the way He deals with men from the Old to the New Testament (which is what this passage is all about) and the transitional time (the book of Acts) is God dealing with Israel and progressively dealing with the Gentiles. So why get stuck at the beginning of Acts and NOT consider the END of the book or for that matter the rest of the book.

Again in Ephesians the verse is being used WRONG as it also has a context: Here they are placing this one baptism on the water baptism in Acts 2:38 when water is not there but even if it was in Ephesians is NOT about water baptism. Ephesians 4:4-10, "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of

your calling; One Lord, one faith, **one baptism**, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. (Now that he ascended, what is it but that **he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth? He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.**)” Water baptism is a figure of something else. In the context baptism is a figure of Jesus Christ death, burial and resurrection; and in this case after His death He descended first into the lower parts of the earth; like going under water; and then ascended back out and into the heavens and far above the heavens; coming up out of the water at the resurrection from the dead. It is a figure of this; and when the Believer is water baptized He is identifying with the death burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. There is no holy water or any significance of a sacrament in water baptism to save anyone or gain any favor with God. Water does not save; only Jesus Saves!

Stupid things people say: “Many people have inherited religious beliefs from their mothers and fathers and have never stopped to compare those beliefs with our only guidebook – the Bible. There are also “blind leaders of the blind” (Matthew 15:14), who have never been born again themselves and therefore cannot properly interpret the truths of the Bible. The natural man cannot understand the things of the Spirit, for they are spiritually discerned (I Corinthians 2:14).”

Sargent answers: Interpret the truths of the Bible? When you alter the Bible then you are just calling God a liar. You said they were titles and the Bible said NAME. You ALTERED the words of God to suit your “inherited religious beliefs” and have become the very “blind leaders of the blind” that you are talking about. You cannot understand the Scriptures because you ALTER THEM! Spiritual discernment has nothing to do with interpretation of the Scriptures when you ALTER the WORDS you are interpreting? God NEVER told you to ALTER HIS WORDS! God did tell you in Genesis 40:8b, “...Do not interpretations belong to God?...” The trouble is that you altered the Bible to suit your belief; then after altering it you placed verses with it that now seem to match what you have altered. This is NOT interpretation it is CORRECTING WHAT GOD SAID! Interpretation allows the Bible to interpret what it SAYS by:



1. Context: a text without a context is a pretext (This is Primary)
2. Comparison of same types of verses (within their context)
3. Contrast of different types of verses (within their context)
4. Parables: that show HOW to interpret (within their context)
5. Similitudes: that show things “as” or “like” something else (within their context)
6. Metaphors: usually a word or short sentence that reflects an Old Testament word or idea as vied by the New Testament. (within their context)
7. Allegories: showing how stories in the Old Testament are viewed in the New Testament doctrinal application that is much different (within their context)



Stupid things people say: “The death of Jesus Christ purchased a far greater salvation than most people know anything about today. Many people believe that by repenting of their sins and striving to live as best as they can they experience all there is to salvation.”

Sargent answers: This is a form of double-speaking. They are not saying here what they believe about Acts 2:38. They believe that repenting of their sins and water baptism is necessary for salvation and as I have shown they are not. They are trying to act like Baptists here when they are NOT even Baptist at all. This deception is usually how they ignore what they teach and deceive people into thinking they are Baptistic in their doctrine when they are NOT. Salvation is simple it is not complicated. The question is when someone says saved: what are they talking about? Saved from WHAT? Physical death? Physical Pain? Physical financial troubles? Physical disease? Physical loneliness? Physical heartache? Physical weakness? Physical, Physical, Physical! This is all these charlatans deal with and this is there form of double-speaking. How do you “experience all there is to salvation” what? This is such sophistry that it seems right; but is very deceptive and diabolical. It reminds me of Genesis 3.


Now dealing with: “...repenting of their sins and striving to live as best as they can...” THIS IS NOT SALVATION! Acts 2:38 does not say to repent of their sins! If this is what it means; then you are in trouble! You do know that you cannot repent of your sins enough to be good enough for heaven? Living the best you can will wind you up in Hell Fire and Damnation! You have to be Perfectly HOLY all your life to make it! You cannot commit ONE sin! If you did; you broke the WHOLE Law! Romans 10:3-4, “For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted

themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.” What you have done will not get you to heaven because of what you ARE! You need to BE something else! You need to be HOLY! You are NOT HOLY! You are a SINNER!

The double-speak use of the words: “... a far greater salvation than most people know anything about...” is meaning a temporal salvation; one of money, health, healing, money, etc... They want YOUR money and promise that if you give “your seed faith” meaning “give them your money” then you will be blessed with riches and good health. However this is NOT in the Bible. This is what the Charismatic Cult did to the churches. The Pentecostals sprung up after this infiltration of Rome’s Charismatic Cult into the Protestant churches. There are many splinter groups and denominations that have come from this. It is a FAKE Christianity designed to bring people BACK to ROME without coming back to Rome. The two Papist doctrines of ROME that the Charismatic Cultist espouses are Baptismal Regeneration and Apostolic Succession. That was going on during the dark ages! With the springing up of the Charismatic Cult the churches have been deceived back into the dark ages without even knowing it. What is amazing about all this is how little the Pentecostals know about their history and their connection to ROME.

Stupid things people say: “On the Day of Pentecost, when the New Testament church was inaugurated, the Holy Ghost filled all who were waiting for Him, and they all spoke with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance (Acts 2:4). Peter explained, “This is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh” (Acts 2:16-17).”

Sargent answers: The local church was started there; but the body of Christ (church) in the New Testament started at the death of the Testator. Hebrews 9:16, “For where a testament is, there must also **of necessity be the death of the**



Luke 10:18, “And he said unto them, I beheld **Satan as lightning** fall from heaven.” And 2 Corinthians 4:4, “In whom **the god of this world** hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.”

testator.” This is obvious from the Lord Jesus Christ’s statement as well: Matthew 26:28, “For **this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.**” And Mark 14:24, “And he said unto them, **This is my blood of the new testament,** which is shed for many.” And Luke 22:20, “Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood,** which is shed for you.” And Paul refers to this also in 1 Corinthians 11:25, “After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood:** this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, **in remembrance of me.**”

Notice the theme here: “...the blood of the new testament...” So we see that it is the BLOOD of the New Testament and NOT water baptism. Also notice that it says “...blood of the new testament, which is shed for many **for the remission of sins.**” So remission of sins in the New Testament matches remission of sins in the Old Testament by the Passover Lamb. But we have something BETTER than just remission of sins. We have redemption: Hebrews 9:15, “And for this cause **he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament,** they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.” So to be redeemed is better than being in remission. In the Old Testament you had remission of sins but no one was redeemed back to God permanently. We get THIS in the New Testament.



Stupid things people say: “How terribly this method has been changed and twisted today! No wonder many churches do not have the results the apostles did. If it is to stand the test of these last days, a person’s experience must be “built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone”(Ephesians 2:20). In fact, Paul declared, “Though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel ... let him be accursed” (Galatians 1:8).” Religion

Sargent answers: Yet the issue here is that Paul said the Gospel that he was talking about was NOT Acts 2:38. Paul is clear what the Gospel is that he declared: 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, “Moreover, brethren, **I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you,** which also **ye have received,** and wherein ye stand; **By which also ye are saved,** if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all **that which I also received,** how **that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;** And **that he was buried,** and **that he rose again the third day according to the**

scriptures..." If you are preaching any other gospel other than THAT one that Paul preached then Galatians 1:8-9, "But though we, or an angel from heaven, **preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you**, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, **If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received**, let him be accursed."

This method of bait and switch is a tactic used by many con-men in the pulpits altering the Bible to suit their bias doctrines of devils. The Apostles did not have the results that came out of the Reformation. This potato head has no idea about history; let alone church history. The last days will NOT be like the first days and the Bible TOLD you that! But because these charlatans have disparaged the Bible to the point of teaching ERROR after ERROR; they will NOT find the Truth and God will give them strong delusion. Notice their subtlety in double-speak. He said: "...a person's experience must be 'built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone' (Ephesians 2:20)". Wait! Is that what that verse said? Remember a text without a context is a pretext!



Ephesians 2:14-22, "For **he** is our peace, **who hath made both one**, and hath **broken down** the middle wall of **partition between us**; Having **abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances**; for **to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace**; And that he might **reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby**: And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh. For through him we both **have access by one Spirit unto the Father**. Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but **fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God**; And are built upon the **foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone**; **In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord**: In whom **ye also are builded together** for an habitation of God through the Spirit." See this is not just talking about the foundation of the Apostles and Prophets and Jesus Christ being the chief corner stone; but the whole body of Christ that is the church of the born again believers. In the context it gives the two between the Hebrew and Gentile; and the similitude of the spirit and the flesh. That is in Christ He made both in one new man; in the person of the Lord Jesus Christ. That is why we are no longer Jews or Gentiles. Because the Lord Jesus Christ is

God AND Man! Because the Lord Jesus Christ has joined Body and Spirit with His Soul; by his death, burial & resurrection.



Zephaniah 3:8, “Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until **the day** that I rise up to the prey: for my determination is **to gather the nations**, that I may **assemble** the kingdoms, to pour upon them **mine indignation**, even **all my fierce anger**: for **all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.**”

Acts 2:38 is NOT the Gospel; and it is NOT the fulfilling of Joel’s prophecy at all: Acts 2:16-7! Remember these diabolical degenerates NEVER tell you the whole truth! Acts 2:16-21, “But this is that which was **spoken by the prophet Joel**; And it shall come to pass **in the last days**, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit **upon all flesh**: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: And I will **shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:** And it shall come to pass, that **whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.**” Joel’s prophecy ends with the Second Coming of the Lord Jesus

Christ. And notice that the Spirit was not poured out on ALL flesh at Pentecost! Did you actually READ Joel’s prophecy?

Joel 2:28-32, “And it shall come to pass afterward, that **I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh**; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit. And I will shew **wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come.** And it shall come to pass, that **whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance**, as the LORD hath said, and in **the remnant** whom the LORD shall call.” This is a direct prophecy that is fulfilled

during the Tribulation time; not the Church age; and it ends with the Thousand Years Reign when the Spirit of God is poured out on ALL FLESH! That has NEVER happened yet! These blind guides are deceived; and deceiving others by their lack of READING; and by their ALTERATION of the words of God.

The fulfillment of Joel 2:28-32 is in Revelation 6:12-17, “And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and **the sun became black as sackcloth of hair**, and **the moon became as blood**; And **the stars of heaven fell unto the earth**, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind. **And the heaven departed as a scroll** when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, **hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains**; And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and **hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?” and Revelation 16:16-21, “And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue **Armageddon**. And the seventh angel poured out his vial **into the air**; and there came a **great voice out of the temple of heaven**, from the throne, saying, It is done. And there**

were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.” And Revelation 19:11-16, “And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a

rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and


another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.” And Revelation 21:1-6, “And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be



with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and **there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain:** for the former things are passed away. And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, **I make all things new.** And he said unto me, Write: for **these words are true and faithful.** And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.” One more: Revelation 21:22-27, “And I saw no temple therein: for **the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.** And **the city** had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for **the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.** And **the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it:** and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it. And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there. And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it. And **there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.**” This is when the Spirit is poured out on ALL FLESH!

Stupid things people say: “First, we must repent, turning our back on all sin and turning to God in faith. Repentance is motivated by godly sorrow, and it includes confession of sins to God.”

Sargent answers: This is NOT the Gospel that Paul preached at all. True repentance is to turn. If you define repentance in any other way you are calling God a sinner. (Genesis 6:6; Exodus 32:14; Judges 2:18; 1 Samuel 15:35; 2 Samuel 24:16; 1 Chronicles 21:15; Jeremiah 26:13, 19; Amos 7:3, 6 and Jonah 3:9-10.) You are to repent (turn) from trusting in your own righteousness to save you and turn (repent) to trust God’s righteousness to save you. God’s righteousness is the Lord Jesus Christ. If you think repenting by confessing your sins will help then you had better remember ALL of them; you had better confess correctly; you had better live by the law and never sin, ever! I guess that negates confessing any sins.



Perhaps you are not that wicked right? Perhaps you CAN remember all of your sins. Tell me all about it; and I will call you a liar. How about the sins of omission? Do you remember all the things you didn’t do that were right? James 4:17, “Therefore to him **that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.**” How about the sin of doubt? Do you remember every doubtful thought? Romans 14:23, “And **he that doubteth is damned if he eat,** because he eateth not of faith:

for whatsoever is not of faith is sin.” Are you going to remember every lie to confess them to get saved? What if you left one out? What if the water you were baptized in had some poison or impurities in it? Would you be saved anyway? The trouble is: THINGS do not save you! John 8:24, “I said therefore unto you, that **ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.**” You are going to die in your sins if you think that salvation from HELL is anything but the Lord Jesus Christ. You MUST receive HIM; salvation is NOT in things; it is in a PERSON: the Lord Jesus Christ and Him ALONE!



Stupid things people say: “Second, we must be baptized (immersed) in the name of Jesus Christ...”

Sargent answers: So why the name of “Jesus Christ” and not just the name of “Jesus”? You do know that Christ is a title right? Remember above your deal about titles: Matthew 1:16; Matthew 2:4; Matthew 16:20; Mark 8:29; Mark 12:35; Luke 2:26; Luke 9:20; why not be consistent? Now definitively we see what this means: John 1:41, “He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found **the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.**” Notice how the Bible is self-interpreting? God just told you that Christ is the same title as Messias. How does water baptism put out the fires of Hell?

Next let’s look at the name in particular: Baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus? Is this the same as being baptized in the name of Jesus Christ? You see? Acts 8:16 is after Acts 2:38 so why would you go by Acts 2:38 when you have Acts 8:16? Wait then what if you were reading a history that is unfolding from Old to New Testament and it is progressive? Perhaps you didn’t think about that: Acts 10:48, “And he commanded them **to be baptized in the name of the Lord.** Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.” They were baptized in the name of the Lord. So we see it went from the name “Jesus Christ” to the name “Lord Jesus” to the name “Lord” So what if you got baptized in water in the wrong name? Would you go to Hell Fire and Damnation even if you receive the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour? You know water baptism and in what name of the Lord is not a means of salvation at all. Acts 19:5, “When they heard this, **they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.**” It goes back to “Lord Jesus” and if that weren’t enough Paul NEVER told you to do what these people are saying to do. Matter of FACT Paul said: 1 Corinthians 1:17-18, “For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. For **the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness;** but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.” So Paul was

NOT sent to baptize? But, but wait; if he was NOT sent to baptize then how is baptism needed for salvation? And in fact he was sent to PREACH THE GOSPEL which again is interpreted in the passage as “preaching of the cross” not water baptism or repentance from sins. He was sent to preach the gospel and told you what the gospel was which we have already dealt with. These con artists are the world’s worse scammers; fraudulent and deceptive. They are playing on the chance that you do not know your Bible and will believe just about anything. They will stop at nothing to pull the wool over the sheep’s eyes; while skinning them and wearing their clothing, but they are ravening wolves.

Stupid things people say: “These three roles of God...”

Sargent answers: I want a verse that says
“...these are the three roles of God...” Just
ONE verse will do! Must be three rolls of God



or three cakes or unleavened bread! How is 1 John 5:7, “For **there are three that bear record in heaven**, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and **these three are one.**” Have anything to do with roles? These people spend too much time watching TV and role playing! They have no idea what they are talking about. The THREE listed here are persons and there are THREE and these THREE are ONE. You don’t want to understand that because you are committed to ALTERING what God SAID; and making the Bible TEACH something that it does not SAY! Why would anyone think God is ROLE PLAYING? The word ROLE is NOT in the Bible! God isn’t in the business of ACTING like something that He is NOT! That is what “role playing” is! That is NOT in the King’s Bible. Might be in your

perverted Bible; but NOT the Holy Bible! Must be from the Common English Bible (CEB) where the word shows up 7 times or the Easy-to-Read

Version (ERV) where it shows up 2 times. How about just a little leaven in your lump how about the GOD’S WORD Translation (GW) where it only shows up 1 time and like the J.B. Phillips New Testament Translation

(PHILLIPS) it shows up 1 time as well. Then there is The Message Translation (MSG) that perverts the text with 3 references to the word “role” and the New

American Bible (Revised Edition) (NABRE) has it 3 times as does the New English Translation (NET) and if that weren't enough: The Voice Translation (VOICE) Copyright © 2012 Thomas Nelson, Inc. Shows up PLAY ACTING and ROLE PLAYING 37 times! There's you a hypocritical Bible if you ever say one.

Now if you think God is a Role Playing Actor then your theology is a lie. You are saying that God is LYING about WHO He is when He shows up. He is just ACTING like something that He is NOT. That is what Playing a Role IS.



Role Playing and Acting like God. Did God Role Play and ACT like Jesus? How about Krishna? Wouldn't God show up in All Religions? If NOT why not?

Stupid things people say: "Third, God will pour out the gift of the Holy Ghost on us as He did on the disciples, and we will receive the same Bible evidence – speaking in other tongues. (See Acts 2:4; 10:46; 19:6.) As Jesus said, "These signs shall follow them that believe ... they shall speak with new tongues" (Mark 16:17). It takes all three steps to complete God's plan of salvation for the New Testament church."

Sargent answers: Again this is total blasphemy calling salvation a work that you can do a certain way else you are not saved. This is saying that the work that the Holy Ghost did in the death, burial and resurrection is not good enough. The Holy Ghost is that Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth and the Comforter. What these charlatans are saying is exactly that! The Lord Jesus Christ's death, burial and resurrection is NOT good enough to save you! You need to add to that or just overlook it and get water baptized in the right name repenting from your sins by confessing all of them and speaking in a foreign known or new or other or an unknown tongue to be saved. They insist that if you have NOT done these THINGS then you are LOST; you are NOT saved! This is a false guilt and subtle tactic of Satan to deceive people to think they cannot get saved; and if they think they have gotten saved in this way then they can lose it by sinning again or doubting any one or all of those things were not done just the right way. The trouble is they are still SINNERS. They have not received the Lord Jesus Christ alone for salvation.

Works salvation ideologies always produce unstable souls that cannot cease from sin; because they are not born of God. You cease from sin because it has been paid for by the Lord Jesus Christ. When you get born again your spirit is joined to God's Spirit in a new birth. Your spirit can NEVER sin and can NEVER die; because it gets ETERNAL life. By this nature of your spirit; your soul is SAFE; ergo: Saved! Salvation of the soul is contingent NOT what you have DONE; but on what you ARE! Are you a sinner or a saint? Are you a wicked sinner or are you a son of God? If your spirit is born again; it is a son of God; and then God adopts your soul making it also a son of God by proxy. When the Lord saves you; you are safe: John 10:28, “**And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish,** neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.” That is what eternal security means: **eternally saved: safe forever!** You can't be plucked out of His hand if you are IN the body of Christ! You are NOT in his hands as in being held in the hand: YOU ARE PART OF THE BODY OF CHRIST if you are born again! You are no longer a sinner but a son of God: a saint. You have been spiritually circumcised: Colossians 2:11, “In whom also ye are circumcised with **the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh** by the circumcision of Christ...” That is what divides your spiritual side from your carnal side so that you are no longer eternally responsible for the sins of the flesh. THAT is what being SAVED is! These people are non-knowers that are clueless about this because they pervert the words of God. If they actually believe what they teach; then they are LOST! They are deceived by their familiar spirit and unclean devils. This is why they call themselves Apostles and are LIARS. (Revelation 2:2). These charlatans would take all your money and LIE to you about salvation, faith, repentance, righteousness, imputation, propitiation and sanctification. They have no idea about any of these Bible doctrines because they have PERVERTED THE WORDS OF THE LIVING GOD and 2 Corinthians 11:13-15, “**For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.** And no marvel; for **Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.** Therefore **it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness;** whose end shall be according to their works.” What are they doing? 2 Corinthians 11:3-4, “But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his **subtlety**, so your minds should be **corrupted from the simplicity** that is in Christ. For if **he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached**, or if **ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received**, or **another gospel, which ye have not accepted**, ye might well bear with him.” Is the same group in Galatians 1:6-9, “I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ **unto another gospel:**

Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and **would pervert the gospel of Christ**. But though we, or an angel from heaven, **preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you**, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, **If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.**" These jack-legs do NOT preach the Gospel that Paul preached or that the Corinthians or Galatians received! These monsters are pagans posing as Christians. They are wolves in sheep's clothing. What gospel did Paul preach? You do know it was NOT Acts 2:38? 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, "Moreover, brethren, **I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received**, and wherein ye stand; **By which also ye are saved**, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, **how that Christ died for our sins** according to the scriptures; And **that he was buried**, and **that he rose again** the third day **according to the scriptures...**" If you do not receive this as the gospel and preach or teach a different gospel you are accursed!

Stupid things people say: "Now is the time to examine yourself to see whether or not you are in the faith of the apostles."

Sargent Answers: Nothing like a Bible to clear of a misquote: 2 Corinthians 13:5, "Examine yourselves, **whether ye be in the faith**; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, **how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?**" They added "...of the apostles." Why? By what Agenda would they do that? What Ulterior motive? Perhaps they will just write their own Bible or go by a modern version of the Reconstructionist. Whose faith are you to be IN? Your OWN?

Romans 3:22-28, "**Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe**: for there is no difference: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; **Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood**, to declare **his righteousness for the remission of sins** that are past, **through the forbearance of God**; To declare, I say, at this time **his righteousness**: that **he might be just**, and **the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus**. Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but **by the law of faith**. Therefore **we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.**" Your faith is in the faith OF Jesus; read it again. Notice these elements:

1. Righteousness of God (which is by faith of Jesus Christ)
2. Justification (freely)
3. Redemption (that is in Christ Jesus)
4. Propitiation (through faith in his BLOOD)
5. Remission of sins (to declare his righteousness for the)
6. Forbearance (God's grace and mercy)
7. Believeth in Jesus (to all that Believe)

So why deal with an unclear passage when there are more clear passages that are precise and to the point? Like that last one! That has just about every doctrinal element in it. Without baptism or repentance which are unclear. You don't know when it says baptism if it is water or Spirit baptism. You don't know when it just says repentance if it means the national repentance or repentance from dead works or repentance from something you are fixing to do; like God did on many occasions.

So what you gave me is an unclear formula; and references that you gave you have to interpret for me because just to be honest they are by themselves unclear. You have to add words to interpret them the way you do. You can't allow them to remain the way they are because it would not TEACH what you think it teaches when it does not SAY what you want it to SAY! So you make it TEACH what it does not SAY! This is called bait and switch used by con-men to make a buck off suckers!

So you would add water in Mark 16:16, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." So you are saying that it should say: "He that believeth and is **water** baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not (**and is not water baptized**) shall be damned." Right? Is that what you believe? Yes it is! You Bible pervert!

So let me get this one straight you think this means what it says or do you have to interpret this for me too? Acts 2:38, "Then Peter said unto them, **Repent**, and **be baptized** every one of you **in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins**, and ye shall **receive the gift of the Holy Ghost**." So when it says "Repent" what is that meaning? When it says "baptized" what is that meaning? And is the name to be baptized in the name "Jesus Christ" as it says here or is the name "Jesus" or in the name of the Lord? Just clear these things up for me; I'm not smart enough to add, subtract or alter the Bible. So which is it?

1. Baptized in the name of Jesus Christ: Acts 2:38
2. Baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus: Acts 8:16

3. Baptized in the name of the Lord: Acts 10:48
4. Baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus: Acts 19:5
5. Baptizing in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost: Matthew 28:19
6. Baptism of repentance for the remission of sins: Mark 1:4; Acts 13:24
7. Baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead: Romans 6:4; Colossians 2:12; Ephesians 4:5.

Please explain what “...for the remission of sins...” means... Is the sin put in remission? Or what? If that is all it is; then can it come back to attack you and take you to Hell Fire and Damnation? Isn’t remission what they got in the Old Testament that had to be renewed every year? So what is different in the New Testament from the Old? Then please explain:

Hebrews 9:19-26, “For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, **he took the blood of calves and of goats**, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and **sprinkled both the book, and all the people**, Saying, **This is the blood of the testament** which God hath enjoined unto you. Moreover **he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry**. And **almost all things are by the law purged with blood**; and **without shedding of blood is no remission**. It was therefore necessary that the **patterns** of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but **the heavenly things themselves** with better sacrifices than these. For **Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands**, which are the **figures** of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear **in the presence of God** for us: Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into **the holy place every year with blood of others**; For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared **to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself**.” Putting away sin is NOT remission of sin; it is God making Jesus Christ to BE SIN FOR US. When He died; He killed sin and took it on his soul when He went to Hell. He is NOT Guilty of that sin and because He was innocent when He entered into Hell Fire: His light was brighter than Hell and hotter than the blast furnace of Damnation. He dropped off sin in Hell and crossed the great gulf to Abraham’s Bosom (paradise and Eden) and on the third day Rose FROM the dead. If remission of sins is by water baptism then what happened to the BLOOD? You have made this void by perverted judgment as to what the Bible SAYS. You can make the Bible teach ANYTHING. But you can NOT alter what it says; I can read it for myself like anyone can and find out that you are LYING!

So let's see if I have that right and please correct me if I have this backwards because I am not good at adding to, subtracting from or altering the Bible. "Then Peter said unto them, **Repent of your sins, and get baptized in water** every one of you **in the name of Jesus or Jesus Christ or Lord Jesus or Lord to get the remission of sins**, and ye shall **receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost (and fire).**" That is about what sums up the extent of your belief as you would alter the Bible to teach what it does not say instead of going by what it says. If you alter what it says then you can teach what it says without looking like a FOOL. But you are CAUGHT! FOOL! That is a foolish thing to alter God's words!

When I was saved in 1981 I read three passages and knew what I needed:

John 1:12, "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: **Which were born**, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but **of God.**"

John 3:5-7, "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born** of water and **of the Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and **that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.** Marvel not that I said unto thee, **Ye must be born again.**"

Romans 10:9-10, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." I had what I needed; and received the Lord Jesus Christ by faith as my personal savior. I confessed the Lord Jesus and believed in my heart that God raised Him from the dead. I got a peace that I had never known. The next morning I got up and was totally at awe with what happened. I was different INSIDE! Something happened and I had to find out what. I got an insatiable desire to read and study the Bible. That has not left me from that time till now.

Another fellow got me to memorize Bible verses and when we came to this one which was the day after I was saved I got total assurance and know that I am going to heaven. 1 John 5:11-13, "And **this is the record**, that **God hath given to us eternal life**, and **this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life**; and **he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.** These things have I written unto you **that believe** on the name of the Son of God; **that ye may know that ye have eternal life**, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

See I got hold of that: “...These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; **that ye may know that ye have eternal life...**”

Do you know what I didn’t do? I didn’t repent of sins; I didn’t get water baptized; I didn’t do any works in obedience to any law or program or formula; I just did what the Bible told me to do. I received the Lord Jesus Christ by faith alone plus NOTHING. I could not repent of all my sins... too many to count or remember! I could turn from trusting in my own self-righteousness to save me and turn to trust Jesus Christ to do it for me. I was incarcerated in the military brig; I had no way to get out and get water baptized until months later. The formula you have come to believe would have been of no use for me and would be no hope for me. Perhaps that formula is for people of noble birth; for people that are NOT sinners. Your repentance from dead works to serve the living God is NOT salvation. Confessing your sins is not salvation. Salvation has already been taken care of in Jesus Christ; you MUST receive HIM to be saved from Hell Fire and Damnation. Jesus claimed to be the ONLY way. There is no other way; no formula from unclear passages that you have to add to them for clarity. How do you KNOW you got that right? You don’t! It is guesswork. There is no guesswork in salvation; God made it simple to get saved even a child can get saved if they understand that they are a sinner.

The View of Trinitarianism

There are just about as many views of Trinitarianism as there are of Onenessism. But the fact remains that the Bible calls God and defines God as the Godhead. Deal with this word as it is a singular plurality. It does not mean Gods; because it is a singular word. It does imply however a plurality of that singularity. I am sure you would have no idea what this means if you are a Onenessite you cannot give a clear definition of the word Godhead.

Next is the name of God. God being three persons in ONE Godhead would mean that there is more than ONE name for God.

Proverbs 30:4, “**Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?**”

There in that passage there are TWO names that you obviously do not know.

The word “God” can be interpreted in seven different ways in light of the fact that He is the Godhead. And revealed has the 3 that are 1. Isaiah 7:14, “Therefore the

Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and **bear a son**, and shall call **his name Immanuel**.” Is Immanuel His name?

Matthew 1:21-23, “And she shall bring forth a son, and **thou shalt call his name JESUS**: for he shall save his people from their sins. Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was **spoken of the Lord** by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and **they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.**” We see by this that by definition Jesus means Emmanuel “...**which being interpreted is, God with us.**” So Jesus Christ’s name is “God with us” Does that mean that Jesus Christ is NOT God? No! We have seen that God has more than one name. The Father has a name and His Son has a name. Perhaps Oneites are not very read in the Scriptures about these things. You would think that if your doctrinal persuasion was about the name of God you could find these verses. However it is to their best interest to AVOID these verses seeing that the Bible rips and tears apart their pagan papist doctrines which are baptismal regeneration and apostolic succession.

So we see that in Exodus 6:3, “And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, **by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.**” Two more names are listed. God was not known by Jehovah until Moses. Abraham, Isaac and Jacob did not know God by this name. He was known as God Almighty.

Exodus 6:3, “And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of **God <0410> Almighty <07706>**, but by my name **JEHOVAH <03068>** was I not known to them.”

By the name of God <0410> אל – ‘ĕl: ale; short. Strength; mighty; the Almighty: God (deity). Short for<0430> אלֹהִים – ‘ĕlōhîym: el-o-heem’; plurality in the ordinary sense: gods; but specifically used of the supreme God. The Godhead!

Almighty <07706> שָׁדַי – **Shadday**: shad-dah ’ee; the Almighty: Almighty!

By my name JEHOVAH <03068> יְהֹוָה - **Yehôvâh**: yeh-he-vaw’; the self-Existent or Eternal: Jehovah, Jewish national name of God: Jehovah, the **LORD**. Here is the reference for the King James Bible usage of the all upper case for this word “**LORD**” And in the text for the word “**JEHOVAH**”.

So literally you have Exodus 6:3, “And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, **by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.**” Notice the articles “the name” and “my name” Both are names of the Godhead.

So you have two persons with two names: Proverbs 30:4, “Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath

bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth?
what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?" Good question:
do YOU know what THEIR names are? If you can tell or not; by the profession of
any Oneite they can't tell! They are by their own admission: ignorant!

So how many names does God have?

1. the name of the LORD: Genesis 12:8; 13:4; 16:13; 21:33; 26:25; Exodus 15:3; 33:19; 34:5; Leviticus 24:11, 16; Deuteronomy 5:11; 18:5, 7, 22; 21:5; 28:10; 32:3; etc. Mark 11:10; Luke 13:35; 19:38; John 12:13; Acts 2:21; 10:48; 22:16; Romans 10:13; James 5:10, 14;
2. the name of God Almighty: Exodus 6:3
3. by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them: Exodus 6:3

And that is just a drop in the bucket for the names of God. Perhaps you think God's attribute is a mode or a particular state of being that changes from time to time so that God has manifestation modes as one person. The particular mode would morph into a model which would morph into a module which would morph into modalism which would morph in to module-glyphs which would morph into model-gifs which would morph into molten-gods. God is NOT a person like a man. God's nature is the Godhead. A singular plurality personage whose nature is the Godhead.

A Pentacostalite said that Trinitarians believe in three Gods!

Sargent Answers: Oneness Pentagramcostalites can't read... I do not know of one real Trinitarian that believes there are three Gods! I am a Trinitarian and I believe there is only ONE Godhead and by definition ONE God. I have never WROTE that there are three gods. Trinitarianism is monotheistic; it always has been monotheistic. So from this standpoint an argument about One God is superficial in the debate against Trinitarianism. There is only ONE Godhead; but then the word Godhead is NOT what the Pentacostalites care to talk about. So deal with that word. Stop ignoring the obvious. IS THAT ONE GOD THE GODHEAD OR NOT? Oneites never deal with this because they know this word shows them to be wrong; and this word shows them to be liars. You can say all you want to say about Jesus Christ being the One True God and you would be right. 1 John 5:20, "And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life." But that NEVER DEALS WITH THIS SUBJECT. It is a round-about way to NOT deal with the actual subject. It is a smoke screen to hide from dealing with the Godhead. The Trinity: 1 John 5:7, "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one." The fact is even in 1 John 5:20 that one true God is in the passage in the words "Son of God" and "know HIM that is true" and "in HIM that is true" and then "EVEN in HIS Son Jesus Christ. THIS is the true God and eternal life." Notice there are three in the verse!

1. Know Him that is True (the Spirit of Truth)
2. We are IN Him that is True (IN the Father)
3. EVEN in His Son Jesus Christ (In the Son [the Word])

The dispute is NOT about three gods or four or thousands of gods. That is NOT even an issue here. But I guess some people just can't read. The question about God is this: Is God infinite? Is God all powerful? Can God create stuff out of nothing? So if these are attributes of this Godhead; why would you limit God to being finite; somewhat powerful and only able to make things out of things that are already here? The trouble with any Pentecostal is that they are thieves. Pentecost is NOT a denomination; it is a Jewish Feast Day! It is NOT a Christian day at all. It was a Jewish feast day from the time of Moses. It is 50 days after the Passover and there was a Pentecost day EVERY YEAR and Acts 2:38 never happened again on any of them. So why call a denomination by a Jewish Feast day? If you cannot discern this simple thing; how can you be expected to grapple with the doctrine about the Godhead! No one preached what Peter preached in Acts 2 again. Steven came close in Acts 6 but instead of dealing with what must we do about murdering the Messiah; they just MURDERED Stephen too. None were told to be repent and be baptized, etc.

So now about that Godhead that the Oneites don't want to deal with:

Romans 1:19-23, “Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, **even his eternal power and Godhead**; so that they are without excuse: Because that, **when they knew God, they glorified him not as God**, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, **And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man**, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.” This is exactly what the Oneites do.

“...even his eternal power and Godhead...” The term “Godhead” here is in reference to one of God's attributes like the words “eternal power”; with this in mind what can a Oneite say about this word besides it is meaningless. How can God have an attribute that is “Godhead”? How can they without recognizing that God IS a SINGULAR PLURALITY? They can't!

The next thing is that Jesus Christ was a MAN and the Bible says about him: Colossians 2:8-10, “Beware lest any man spoil you through **philosophy** and **vain deceit**, after the **tradition of men**, after the **rudiments of the world**, and **not after**

Christ. For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power..." Yet one day after death is defeated (the last enemy) the Lord Jesus Christ gives the Kingdom to the Father: 1 Corinthians 15:23-28, "But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming. Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all."

It is obvious that there will be a time: "...then the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all." Notice that it is God, EVEN the FATHER.

You didn't know God's name and that His name is NOT the same as His Son's name? What planet are you from? Proverbs 30:4, "Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? **what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?**" By your own profession you must answer this NO that you cannot tell. Because you only have the Son's name. You wouldn't know the Father's name if it was right in front of your face!

If Jesus Christ is the Father, then He LIED when He said: John 5:37, "**And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.**" Because they are standing there seeing Jesus Christ and hearing Him say this! If you think the Father is Jesus Christ and Jesus Christ is the Father; you are calling the Lord Jesus Christ a liar!

Forget about all the argumentation about three gods junk. That is just a smoke screen to keep you from dealing with THIS and finding the TRUTH.

Now perhaps you are reading this and got this far and still have no idea what it is all about. The simplest things to understand are simple things:

1. God cannot lie.
2. God says what He means and means what He says.
3. The Bible is self-interpreting.

4. Never try to understand a simple passage by a complex passage.
5. Never try to understand a clear passage by an unclear passage.
6. Never add, subtract or alter the passage to prove your theology.
7. Context: a text without a context is a pretext.

The clear gospel is given in the Bible by definition in a clear passage without having to add anything or subtract anything or alter anything.

1 Corinthians 15:1-4, “Moreover, brethren, **I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you**, which also **ye have received**, and wherein ye stand; **By which also ye are saved**, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For **I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received**, how **that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures**; And **that he was buried**, and **that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures**...” This is the gospel that Paul said about:

2 Corinthians 11:3-4, “But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent **beguiled** Eve through his **subtlety**, so your minds should be **corrupted** from the **simplicity** that is in Christ. For if he that cometh **preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached**, or if ye **receive another spirit**, which ye have not received, or **another gospel, which ye have not accepted**, ye might well bear with him.”

Galatians 1:6-9, “I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ **unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ**. But though we, or an angel from heaven, **preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed**. As we said before, so say I now again, **If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.**”

2 Corinthians 2:17, “For we are not as many, **which corrupt the word of God**: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.”

2 Corinthians 11:13-15, “For such are **false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ**. And **no marvel**; for **Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light**. Therefore it is no great thing if **his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness**; whose end shall be according to their works.”
