Numbers 23:19, "**God is not a man**, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?"

God is INFINITE:

Psalms 147:5, "**Great** is our Lord, and of **great power**: his **understanding** is **infinite**."

God is ALL POWERFUL:

Revelation 19:6, "And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for **the Lord God** <u>omnipotent</u> reigneth."

God ONLY has IMMORTALITY:

1 Timothy 6:15-16 "Which in his times he shall shew, who is **the blessed and only** <u>Potentate</u>, **the King of kings**, and **Lord of lords**; **Who only hath** <u>immortality</u>, <u>dwelling in the light</u> which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be <u>honour</u> and <u>power everlasting</u>. Amen."

God inhabits ETERNITY:

Isaiah 57:15, "For thus saith **the** <u>high</u> and <u>lofty</u> <u>One</u> that inhabiteth <u>eternity</u>, whose name is <u>Holy</u>; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones."

God is the GODHEAD:

Acts 17:27-31, "That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring. Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the <u>Godhead</u> is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device. And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now

commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead."

Romans 1:20, "For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and <u>Godhead</u>; so that they are without excuse:"

Colossians 2:8-10, "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the <u>Godhead</u> bodily. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:"

God's words are ABSOLUTE TRUTH:

Proverbs 30:5, "**Every word of God is pure**: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him."

Psalms 12:6-7, "**The words of the LORD are pure words**: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, **purified seven times**. Thou shalt **keep** them, O LORD, thou shalt **preserve** them from this generation **for ever**."

John 3:34, "For he whom God hath sent speaketh **the words of God**: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him."

One of the Names of God is "The Word of God":

Revelation 19:13, "And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and **his name is called The Word of God**."

Faith comes by hearing the word of God:

Romans 10:17, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by **the word of God**."

The word of God ONLY effectually works in you THAT BELIEVE:

1 Thessalonians 2:13, "For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received **the word of God** which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but **as it is in truth**, **the word of God**, which **effectually worketh also in you that believe**."

The word of God is a DISCERNER of YOUR THOUGHTS AND INTENTS OF YOUR HEART:

Hebrews 4:12, "For **the word of God** is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and **is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart**."

The word of God framed the worlds:

Hebrews 11:3, "Through faith we understand that **the worlds were framed by the word of God**, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear."

2 Peter 3:3-7, "Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were **from the beginning of the creation**. For this they willingly are ignorant of, that **by the word of God the heavens were of old**, and **the earth standing out of the water and in the water**: Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men."

You are BORN AGAIN by incorruptible seed: the word of God:

1 Peter 1:23-25, "**Being born again**, not of corruptible **seed**, but of **incorruptible**, **by the word of God**, which **liveth and abideth for ever**. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But **the word of the Lord endureth for ever**. And **this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you**."

It is through this gospel that immortality comes to us:

2 Timothy 1:10-11, "But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath <u>abolished death</u>, and <u>hath brought life</u> and <u>immortality</u> <u>to light through the gospel</u>: Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles."

1 Corinthians 15:51-54, "Behold, I shew you a **mystery**; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and **the dead shall be raised** <u>incorruptible</u>, and **we shall be changed**. For **this corruptible must put on** <u>incorruption</u>, and **this**

mortal must put on <u>immortality</u>. So when this corruptible shall have put on <u>incorruption</u>, and this mortal shall have put on <u>immortality</u>, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory."

1 Thessalonians 4:13, "But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For <u>if we believe</u> that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and <u>the dead in Christ shall rise</u> first: Then <u>we which are alive and</u> <u>remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."</u>

You MUST be IN CHRIST to be safe:

1 Corinthians 1:29-31, "That no flesh should glory in his presence. But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord."

HOW do you get IN HIM?

John 1:12-13, "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God."

John 3:7, "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again."

1 Peter 1:23, "Being **born again**, not of corruptible **seed**, but of **incorruptible**, **by the word of God**, which liveth and abideth for ever."

Romans 3:19-27, "Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and **all the world may become guilty before God**. Therefore **by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight**: for by the law is the knowledge of sin. But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; Even **the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe**: for there is no difference: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; **Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus**: Whom **God hath set** forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith."

Ephesians 2:8-9, "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."

Romans 10:3-4, "For they being ignorant of **God's righteousness**, and going about to establish **their own righteousness**, have not submitted themselves unto **the righteousness of God**. For **Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth**."

2 Corinthians 5:17-21, "Therefore **if any man be in Christ**, **he is a new creature**: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath **reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ**, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that **God was in Christ**, **reconciling the world unto himself**, **not imputing their trespasses unto them**; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, **be ye reconciled to God**. For **he hath made him to be sin for us**, **who knew no sin**; **that we might be made the righteousness of God in him**."

Romans 10:9-10, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."
