The Church vs. The Churches

Revelation 1:11, "Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto <u>the seven churches</u> which are in Asia; unto <u>Ephesus</u>, and unto <u>Smyrna</u>, and unto <u>Pergamos</u>, and unto <u>Thyatira</u>, and unto <u>Sardis</u>, and unto <u>Philadelphia</u>, and unto <u>Laodicea</u>."

Johns Letters to the Churches:

Acts 13:13-14, "Now when Paul and his company loosed from Paphos, they came to Perga in Pamphylia: and John departing from them returned to Jerusalem. But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and sat down."

Acts 14:24-26, "And after they had passed throughout Pisidia, they came to Pamphylia. And when they had preached the word in Perga, they went down into Attalia: And thence sailed to Antioch, from whence they had been recommended to the grace of God for the work which they fulfilled."

Acts 16:14-15, "And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul. And when she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us."

Colossians 4:16, "And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in <u>the</u> <u>church of the Laodiceans</u>; and that ye likewise read <u>the epistle from Laodicea</u>."

Lost people IN the Local Church

2 Peter 2:1-22, "But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not. For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment; And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly; And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly; And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;) The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished: But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them



before the Lord. But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. Spots they are and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they feast with you; Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. These are wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever. For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage. For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire."

The difference between the Churches that John writes to in Revelation and the Church that Paul writes to in his Epistles is that Paul is writing to the Body of Christ: the Church of the born again. John on the other hand is writing to the Angles at local churches. A number is issues with the doctrinal aspects of these overcomers at these local churches:

1. Ephesus: Revelation 2:7, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God." Why eat from the tree of life IS we already HAVE Eternal Life? And what IF someone is NOT an overcomer? They don't get to eat from the tree and don't get eternal life? They lose salvation? John 10:28, "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand." And Romans 5:21, "That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord." With: Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." With 1 John 5:11-13, "And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God, that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

- 2. Smyrna: Revelation 2:11, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death." And IF you are NOT an overcomer? You WILL be hurt of the second death? Is this the loss of salvation? (See above for eternal security) this does not match Paul's security of the believer: Romans 8:35-39, "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Christ overcame FOR HIS CHURCH!
- 3. Pergamos: Revelation 2:14-16, "But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth." This is a local church with lost people in it who if they do not Repent, the Lord will fight them with the sword of His mouth which is a reference to Revelation 19:15. That is not the half of it with this church: Revelation 2:13, "I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth. "Satan's seat was in Pergamos. Antipas was a martyr there where Satan dwelleth. Was Satan going to the church at Pergamos? With all that doctrine of Balaam, eat things sacrificed unto idols, commit fornication, hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans which God HATES; sounds like Satan was one of the members at that church!
- 4. Thyatira: Revelation 2:20, "Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman <u>Jezebel</u>, which calleth herself a <u>prophetess</u>, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols." They ALLOWED this woman to do this? Revelation 2:22, "Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her <u>into great tribulation</u>, except they repent of their deeds." So members of this church if not overcomers can go to the Great Tribulation?
- 5. Sardis: Revelation 3:3, "Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, <u>I will come on thee as a thief</u>, and thou shalt <u>not know what hour</u> I will come upon thee." Who WOULD know what hour he comes? And what is the reference to the Lord coming as a thief? Is that the rapture, or is that the Second Coming? Revelation 3:4, "Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have <u>not defiled their garments</u>; and they shall walk with me in white: <u>for they are worthy</u>." They didn't defile their garments? They are WORTHY? So what about the ones

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that did defile their garments are they UNWORTHY? And what happens to THEM? Revelation 3:5, "He that overcometh, the same shall be <u>clothed in white raiment</u>; and I <u>will not blot out his name out of the book of life</u>, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels." So the ones that did defile their garments and are unworthy get their name blotted OUT of the book of life! He loses his salvation! Unless this is a local church and he was NOT saved, but a lost member.

6. Laodiceans: Revelation 3:16, "So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth." This is a similitude to lukewarm water and how that it make you want to spit it out. This has nothing to do with the Lord eating the church or drinking the church. Revelation 3:18, "I counsel thee to <u>buy</u> of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and <u>that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear</u>; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see." Where are we to buy the gold and white raiment and eyesalve from? How much does it cost if we are to buy it? Perhaps we need to go shopping. If this is a local church that would make complete sense especially one that is going through the tribulation when buying and selling only happen when you take the mark. The trouble with this church and all these churches is that they ARE in the tribulation: Revelation 3:20, "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will <u>come in to him</u>, and will sup with him, and he with me." <u>Jesus Christ is OUTSIDE the door and inside are a bunch of church goers that got left behind</u>.

These things do NOT match Paul's epistles to the 7 churches he wrote to. The above references have cross reference to Tribulation and Second Coming implications doctrinally, therefore notwithstanding there is significant typology involved as the local church is also in the church age; but when the church proper (the body of Christ) leave at the rapture, the local churches full of lost people that were playing church will be here going through the tribulation and these churches are for THEM. Because they did not overcome IN CHRIST, now THEY must overcome themselves: Revelation 12:17, "And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ." And Revelation 14:12, "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus."

The issue having to do with garments to Sardis and the Laodiceans is that they had to wash their robes in the Lambs blood: Revelation 7:14, "And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb." This is during the great tribulation like Thyatira.

This is also reference in Revelation 16:15-16, "Behold, I come <u>as a thief</u>. Blessed is he that watcheth, and <u>keepeth his garments</u>, <u>lest he walk naked</u>, and <u>they see his shame</u>. And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue <u>Armageddon</u>." Just compare the passages: Laodiceans: "...white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and <u>that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear</u>..." with "...keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his



shame..." Notice the context is the Armageddon, this event is the Second Coming. If that is not enough look at 2 Peter 3:10, "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up." And to understand the day of the Lord go back a few verses: 2 Peter 3:8, "But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day." A thousand year reign: so from the Second Coming till when the heavens and earth pass away and burn up. This is when the Lord comes as a THIEF IN THE NIGHT. Matthew 24:43, "But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up." And Luke 12:39, "And this know, that if the goodman of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through." Notice in Luke that this happens after the Lord comes back from a wedding: Luke 12:36, "And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately." That is the Second Coming not the rapture. Notice the Laodicean church where Christ is knocking at the door, is the last church when the Lord is returning IN THE TRIBULATION.

The fact is that when the Tribulation starts the Body of Christ will be up in Heaven at the Judgment Seat of Christ. This is why we are warned to "...persuade men..." in light of this TERROR of the LORD happening at the same time that the Judgment Seat of Christ is going on. One group goes to Heaven, and the other is left behind to the Terror and Wrath of Almighty God which WE are to persuade men to flee from. 2 Corinthians 5:10-11, "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad. Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences." There is no precedent to make this terror the same as the Judgment Seat of Christ, because in the context: 2 Corinthians 5:3-4, "If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked. For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life." This relates to 1 Corinthians 15:51-54, "Behold, I shew you <u>a mystery</u>; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory." Which is a mystery not found in the Old Testament as is 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18, "But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall

descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words." That last verse does respite to the idea of the Judgment Seat of Christ being a terror, after all how is terror comforting?

The Terror of the Lord is **NOT** on the Church proper which is the Body of Christ, The Terror of the Lord is on <u>the LOST</u>: John 3:36, "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and <u>he</u> <u>that believeth not</u> the Son shall not see life; <u>but the wrath of God abideth on him</u>." The terror of the Lord is the wrath of God.

The Terror of the Lord is on LOST people:

Isaiah 13:11, "And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and will lay low the haughtiness of the terrible."

Terror to Egypt:

Deuteronomy 10:17-18, "For the LORD your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward: He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment."

Deuteronomy 26:8-9, "And the LORD brought us forth <u>out of Egypt with a mighty hand</u>, and with an outstretched arm, and with <u>great terribleness</u>, and with signs, and with wonders: And he hath brought us into this place, and hath given us this land, even a land that floweth with milk and honey." Notice God's people did not get that terror: Egypt DID.

Terror in the Tribulation in Typology:

Job 6:4, "For the arrows of the Almighty are within me, the poison whereof drinketh up my spirit: the terrors of God do set themselves in array against me."

Job 7:14-15, "Then thou scarest me with dreams, and <u>terrifiest</u> me through visions: So that my soul chooseth strangling, and death rather than my life."

Job 20:25, "It is drawn, and cometh out of the body; yea, the glittering sword cometh out of his gall: <u>terrors</u> are upon him."

Job 27:20, "Terrors take hold on him as waters, a tempest stealeth him away in the night."

Job 30:15, "<u>Terrors</u> are turned upon me: they pursue my soul as the wind: and my welfare passeth away as a cloud."



Job 31:23. "For <u>destruction</u> from God was a <u>terror</u> to me, and by reason of his highness I could not endure."

God the Father as King:

Psalms 47:2, "For the LORD most high is <u>terrible</u>; he is a great King over all the <u>earth</u>."

Psalms 66:5, "Come and see the works of God: he is <u>terrible</u> in his doing toward <u>the children of</u> <u>men</u>." NOT on the Children of God.

Death is a Terror:

Job 24:17, "For the morning is to them even as the shadow of <u>death</u>: if one know them, they are in the <u>terrors of the shadow of death</u>."

Psalms 55:4, "My heart is sore pained within me: and the terrors of death are fallen upon me."

God is a Terror but NOT to His people:

Psalms 68:35, "O God, thou art terrible out of thy holy places: the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. Blessed be God."

The Desolation of the Abomination of The son of perdition is a terror:

Psalms 73:19, "How are they brought into <u>desolation</u>, as in a moment! they are utterly consumed with <u>terrors</u>."

The Lord at the Second Coming:

Song of Songs 6:10, "Who is she that looketh forth as the morning, fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and <u>terrible</u> as an army with banners?"

Isaiah 2:19, "And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for <u>fear</u> of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake <u>terribly</u> the earth."

Isaiah 2:21, "To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for <u>fear of</u> the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake <u>terribly</u> the earth."

Isaiah 10:33, "Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the haughty shall be humbled."

Joel 2:11, "And the LORD shall utter his voice <u>before his army</u>: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word: for the day of the LORD is great and very terrible; and who can abide it?"

Joel 2:31, "The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come."



Lamentations 2:22, "Thou hast called as in a solemn day <u>my terrors</u> round about, so that in the day of the LORD'S <u>anger</u> none escaped nor remained: those that I have swaddled and brought up hath mine <u>enemy</u> consumed."

God's people will be a Terror to the lost:

Isaiah 19:17, "And the land of <u>Judah</u> shall be a <u>terror</u> unto <u>Egypt</u>, every one that maketh mention thereof shall be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts, which he hath determined against it."

God calls somebody a terror:

Ezekiel 26:21, "<mark>I will <u>make thee a terror</u>, and thou shalt be no more</mark>: though thou be sought for, yet shalt thou never be found again, saith the Lord GOD."

Ezekiel 27:36, "The merchants among the people shall hiss at thee; <u>thou shalt be a terror</u>, and never shalt be any more."

Ezekiel 28:19, "All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: <u>thou shalt</u> <u>be a terror</u>, and <u>never shalt thou be any more</u>."

Terror in the land of the living:

Ezekiel 32:23, "Whose graves are set in the sides of the pit, and her company is round about her grave: all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which caused <u>terror in the land of the living</u>."

(Also in Ezekiel 32:24-27, 32 "...<u>terror in the land of the living</u>.")

Romans 13:3-4, "For <u>rulers are not a terror to good works</u>, <u>but to the evil</u>. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But <u>if thou do that which is evil</u>, <u>be afraid</u>; for <u>he beareth not</u> <u>the sword in vain</u>: for <u>he is the minister of God</u>, <u>a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil</u>."

The Body of Christ is NOT the same as The Local Churches:

Revelation 2:7, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God."

Revelation 2:11, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death."

Revelation 2:17, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it."



Revelation 2:29, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."

Revelation 3:6, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."

Revelation 3:13, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."

Revelation 3:22, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."

The Works of the Flesh:

Galatians 5:16, "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. Now <u>the works of the flesh are manifest</u>, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, <u>heresies</u>, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and <u>such like</u>: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God."

Galatians 5:24-26, "And <u>they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh</u> with the affections and lusts. <u>If we live in the Spirit</u>, <u>let us also walk in the Spirit</u>. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another."

Galatians 6:7-8, "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting." Life Everlasting is NOT Everlasting Life:

Life Everlasting:

Luke 18:30, "Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and <u>in the world to come</u> <u>life everlasting</u>." Life Everlasting is the inheritance in the world to come.

The Church:

Romans 3:23-26, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus."
