

The Map of the Bible

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Someone asked “How do you know the Bible is true?”

My short answer is: “I know the author...”

But let’s delve into a Bible Study that deals with the Map of the Bible. For a thorough study on the map please see: “*AV1611KJB - Bible Map of The Books In The Bible*” located on my web site at <http://biblestudies.av1611kjb.org>

The map of the Bible is in Isaiah. There are 66 books in the Bible. There are 66 chapters in Isaiah. Each chapter of Isaiah for each book of the Bible is the map and here is a small sampling of the map:

Genesis 1:1, “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”

Isaiah 1:2, “Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth...”

Revelation 21:1, “And I saw a new heaven and a new earth...” this is the 66th book in the Bible.

Isaiah 66:22, “For as the new heavens and the new earth...”

Now check this out:

Isaiah 40:3, “The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.”

The 40th book is Matthew...

Matthew 3:3, “For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.”

The reference point’s right to the location in the Book of Isaiah in the right SPIT between the testaments numbering the Old and New Testaments 39 & 27.

Now, God's two numbers are 3 & 7 that constitute the Nature of the Godhead “3” and for some reason His favorite number “7”.

They have amazing properties when considering the Bible itself.

Consider the number of books in the Bible and the fact that they are divisible by 3 in three particulars:

1. **The OT: $39 \div 3 = 13$**
2. **The NT: $27 \div 3 = 9$**
3. **The Bible: $66 \div 3 = 22$**

Let’s take each of these and see what these numbers actually mean.

First the number 13 in the Old Testament from above: The OT: $39 \div 3 = 13$

Notice the numbers 13 and the fact that there are three major curses in the Old Testament:

1. The curse of DEATH: Genesis 2:16-17; Genesis 3:7...
2. The curse of the LAW: Galatians 3:10; Romans 3:19-20...
3. The curse of the Old Testament: Malachi 4:4-6 Last 6 words: "...smite the earth with a curse."

Now notice this anomaly found in Galatians 3:13. For a thorough study on Galatians 3:13 see:

Galatians 3:13, "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:"

See the chapter and verse reference 3 & 13 that is the Old Testament $3 \times 13 = 39$. But look closer the word "curse(d)" is in the verse THREE times. Now count the words in the verse.

Word 7, 14 & 21... Seven words apart: 777.

Now here is a little math to get things figured out:

$$3 \times 7 = 21 \text{ \& } 21 \times 37 = 777 \text{ \& } 7 + 7 + 7 = 21 \text{ \& } 2 + 1 = 3$$

The three "curses" are in the passage:

1. The Curse of DEATH: "being made a curse for us" notice: Philippians 2:8.
2. The Curse of the LAW: "...redeemed us from the curse of the law..." Galatians 3:13
3. The Curse of the OT: "...for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:" Deuteronomy 21:22-23

1. Now notice there is also word 10 is "LAW"
2. That word number 20 is "WRITTEN"
3. Together that is the "Written Law" with the value 30. The Law x3!

Notice that Christ is #1 in the verse.

Redeemed is # 3 because all the three parts of you are redeemed. 1 Thessalonians 5:23, "And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." Or they could not be sanctified or preserved blameless.

1. Spirit: Psalms 31:5
2. Soul: Psalms 49:8
3. Body: Romans 8:23

You are redeemed:

1. Past: Colossians 1:14
2. Present: Hebrews 9:12 and
3. Future: Ephesians 1:14.

That deliverance is three fold: 2 Corinthians 1:10, "Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us;" With a past, present and future deliverance.

Word #4 is “US” that is the “world” John 3:16

The verse is an enigma that spans eternity past, runs through the present and goes out into eternity future.

With the 777 becoming the 13 13 13 a threefold curse 4 US having redeemed us from the three fold CURSE of the law (OT).

There is so much more in this verse that can be discovered and many other verses in the Bible that hold a “thumb print” of the Godhead that is the author of the Holy Bible.

The bottom line is you can KNOW the Bible is TRUE by FAITH because FAITH is a substance:

1 Thessalonians 2:13, “For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.”

It WILL effectually affect YOU when you BELIEVE it. God will show YOU something in His words through the eye of FAITH. Faith is a substance; that is it is substantial; it is evidential: Hebrews 11:1, “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.” Faith in what God SAID is paramount to the question: “How do you know the Bible is true?” You MUST believe the author.

Seeing is NOT believing! **Believing is seeing!**

Read this very carefully and THINK about what you are reading: 1 John 5:9-10, “If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son. He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.”

It is by faith we are saved and it is by faith wherein we walk. But that faith is in what God SAID and God words say:

Ephesians 3:17-21, “That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.”

Next is the number 9 in the New Testament from above: The NT: 27 ÷ 3 = 9

So as not to be repetitive see the Bible Study: “*Numerology - The 54 Fruits of The Spirit & 9*” located at <http://biblestudies.av1611kjb.org>

The number 9 is emphatically the number for fruit and fruits of the Spirit. The NT shows this in the tripling of 9. And the numbers show that the Fruits of the Spirit are in fact the direct opposite of the works

of the flesh which is represented in the very inversion of 9. The flesh is made up of mainly carbon. Carbon has the elemental weight of 6 with 6 protons, 6 neutrons & 6 electrons. It is not a coincidence that the number system uses characters that represent these things after all it is in God's control to produce "clues" in His creation that line up with the Bible to vindicate the Bible as the absolute truth. 9 is an upside down 6 and 6 is an upside down 9. They are opposed one to the other just like the Spirit and the Flesh are opposed.

Next is the number 22 for the whole Bible from the above: The Bible: $66 \div 3 = 22$

There are three 22's that make up the Bible and again so as to not be too repetitive in the studies you can refer to the Bible Study: "*Numerology - The Bible Wheel*"

The Bible is seen in the temple as the bread on the table in the holy place arranged in two rows of 6 each. The light in that room from the 7 prong candle stick gave light on the word of God the bread lined up as 66. The Bible Wheel study shows a division of the books in perfect harmony of three 22's in three circles of 22 books each. Psalms 119 goes 8 verses with each group heading of the Hebrew alphabet that has 22 characters in 176 verses. So that is $22 \times 8 = 176$ which is another MAP of the Bible.

So we have seen three fold "MAPS" of the Bible that prove divine authorship and "thumb prints" with three different views contained in the Bible.

1. Isaiah is a map of the Bible
2. Galatians 3:13 is a map of the Bible
3. Psalms 119 is a map of the Bible

2 Corinthians 13:1, "This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established." See: Deuteronomy 17:6; 19:15; Matthew 18:16; 1 Timothy 5:19 & Hebrews 10:28.

What is important to end this with is that there are more witnesses to the TRUTH than this. The Bible is vindicated by DOING what it says. A true scientist will work out the experiment to see and vindicate the truth of it. But when it comes to the Bible they alter their way of doing things and become totally unscientific because of their preconceived ideas that the Bible is not a valid source of information. So they esteem the words of God as nothing. These words of God are the RECORD of God to man. If you do not believe them you are calling God a LIAR:

1 John 5:6-13, "This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one. If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son. He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."
