

The Trinity

1. Our God is **ONE. The Godhead is singular.**
 - a. Deuteronomy 6:4, “Hear, O Israel: **The LORD our God is one LORD:**”
 - b. Mark 12:29, “And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; **The Lord our God is one Lord:**”
 - c. Galatians 3:20, “Now a mediator is not a mediator of one, but **God is one.**”
2. Our God is **THREE One Father, One Son, One Spirit. 1+1+1=3**
 - a. One Father
 - i. Zechariah 14:9, “And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be **one LORD**, and **his name one.**”
 - ii. 1 Corinthians 8:6, “But to us there is but **one God, the Father**, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.”
 - iii. 1 Timothy 2:5, “For there is **one God**, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;”
 - b. One Son
 - i. 1 Corinthians 8:6, “But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and **one Lord Jesus Christ**, by whom are all things, and we by him.”
 - ii. 1 Timothy 2:5, “For there is one God, and **one mediator** between God and men, the **man Christ Jesus;**”
 - c. One Spirit
 - i. Ephesians 4:4, “There is one body, and **one Spirit**, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;”
 - ii. Ephesians 2:18, “For through him we both have access by **one Spirit** unto the Father.”
3. Our God is **Tripartite** in nature. The 3 working in **pairs!**
 - a. Father and Spirit:
 - i. Matthew 10:20, “For it is not ye that speak, but **the Spirit of your Father** which speaketh in you.”
 - ii. Luke 11:13, “If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall **your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit** to them that ask him?”
 - iii. John 4:24, “**God is a Spirit:** and they that worship him must worship him in **spirit** and in truth.”
 - b. Son and Spirit:
 - i. Matthew 4:1, “**Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit** into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.”
 - ii. Mark 2:8, “And **immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit** that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts?”
 - iii. Luke 4:1, “And **Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost** returned from Jordan, and **was led by the Spirit** into the wilderness,”



- iv. Luke 23:46, “And when **Jesus** had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend **my spirit**: and having said thus, **he gave up the ghost**.”
 - v. Romans 8:9, “But ye are not in the flesh, but in **the Spirit**, if so be that **the Spirit of God** dwell in you. Now if any man have not **the Spirit of Christ**, he is none of his.”
 - vi. Galatians 4:6, “And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the **Spirit of his Son** into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.”
- c. The Father and Son
- i. John 1:1-3, “In the beginning was **the Word**, and **the Word was with God**, and **the Word was God**. The same was in the beginning with God. **All things were made by him**; and without him was not any thing made that was made.”
 - ii. John 1:14, “And the **Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of **the only begotten of the Father**,) full of grace and truth.”
 - iii. John 10:30, “I and my Father are one.”
4. The Father, Son and Spirit – The Triune Godhead:
- a. Matthew 3:16-17, “And **Jesus**, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw **the Spirit of God descending** like a dove, and lighting upon him: And lo **a voice from heaven**, saying, **This is my beloved Son**, in whom I am well pleased.”
 - b. John 15:26, “But when the **Comforter** is come, whom **I** will send unto you from the **Father**, even the **Spirit** of truth, which proceedeth from the **Father**, he shall testify of **me**.” (Jesus speaking)
 - c. 1 Peter 1:2, “Elect according to the foreknowledge of **God the Father**, through **sanctification of the Spirit**, unto obedience and sprinkling of **the blood of Jesus Christ**: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.”
 - d. 1 John 5:7, “For there are **three** that bear record in heaven, **the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost**: and **these three are one**.”
5. **Godhead:**
- a. Colossians 2:9-10, “For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the **Godhead** bodily. And ye are **complete** in him, which is the **head** of all principality and power:”
6. **Seven Spirits of God:**
- a. Isaiah 11:1-4, “And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: And **the spirit of the LORD** shall rest upon him, **the spirit of wisdom** and **understanding**, the **spirit of counsel** and **might**, the **spirit of knowledge** and of **the fear of the LORD**; And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.”
 - i. The spirit of the LORD
 - ii. The spirit of Wisdom (not judge after the sight of his eyes)
 - iii. The spirit of Understanding (quick understanding)
 - iv. The spirit of Counsel (neither reprove after the hearing of his ears)
 - v. The spirit of Might (he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked)
 - vi. The spirit of Knowledge (with righteousness shall he judge and reprove with equity)
 - vii. The spirit of the Fear of the LORD



- b. Revelation 3:1, “And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath **the seven Spirits of God**, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.”
- c. Revelation 4:5, “And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were **seven lamps** of fire burning before the throne, **which are the seven Spirits of God**.”
- d. Revelation 5:6, “And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having **seven horns** and **seven eyes**, **which are the seven Spirits of God** sent forth into all the earth.”

7. The Soul in Jesus Christ:

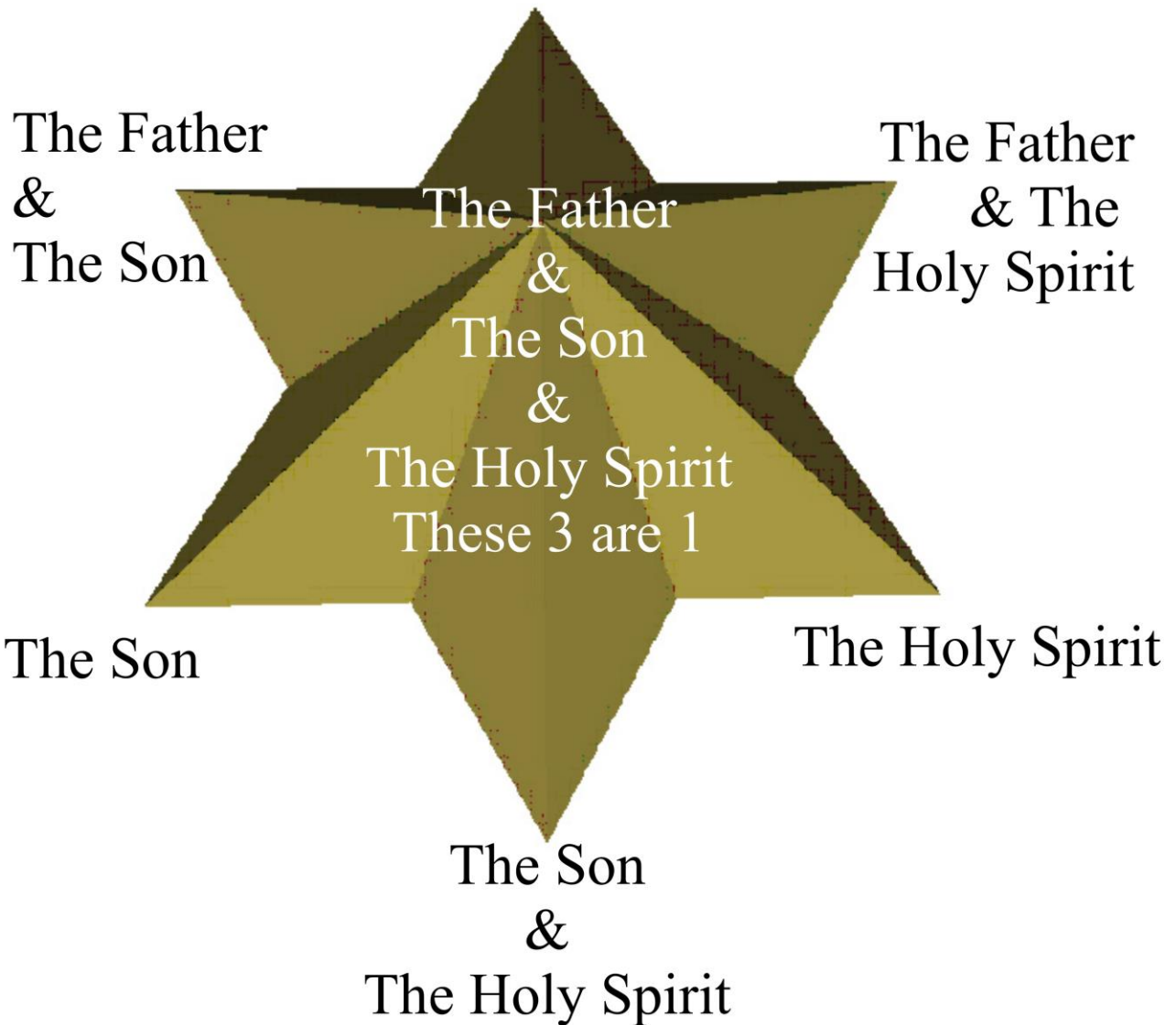
- a. His soul was made an offering for sin:
 - i. Isaiah 53:10-11, “Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make **his soul an offering for sin**, he shall see his seed, **he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. He shall see of the travail of his soul**, and **shall be satisfied**: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.”
- b. His soul was created at birth:
 - i. Genesis 2:7, “And the LORD God **formed man of the dust of the ground**, and **breathed** into his nostrils **the breath of life**; and **man became a living soul**.”
 - ii. John 1:1-4, “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men.”
 - iii. John 1:14, “And **the Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.”
 - iv. John 1:18, “No man hath seen God at any time; **the only begotten Son**, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.”
 - v. 1 Timothy 3:16, “And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: **God was manifest in the flesh**, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.”
 - vi. 1 Corinthians 15:45-47, “And so it is written, **The first man Adam was made a living soul**; the **last Adam was made a quickening spirit**. Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual. The **first man is of the earth, earthy**; the **second man is the Lord from heaven**.”
- c. His soul rose from the dead and entered back in his body:
 - i. Psalms 16:10, “For thou **wilt not leave my soul in hell**; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.”
 - ii. Acts 2:27, “Because thou **wilt not leave my soul in hell**, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.”
 - iii. Acts 2:31, “**He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ**, that **his soul was not left in hell**, neither his flesh did see corruption.”
- d. His Spirit was God in Him
 - i. John 4:24, “**God is a Spirit**: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.”
 - ii. 2 Corinthians 5:19, “To wit, that **God was in Christ**, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.”



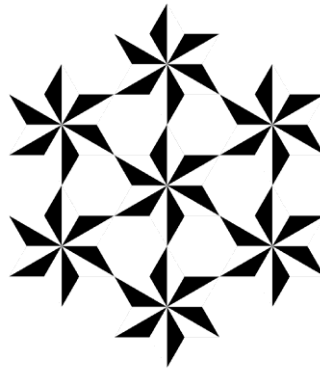
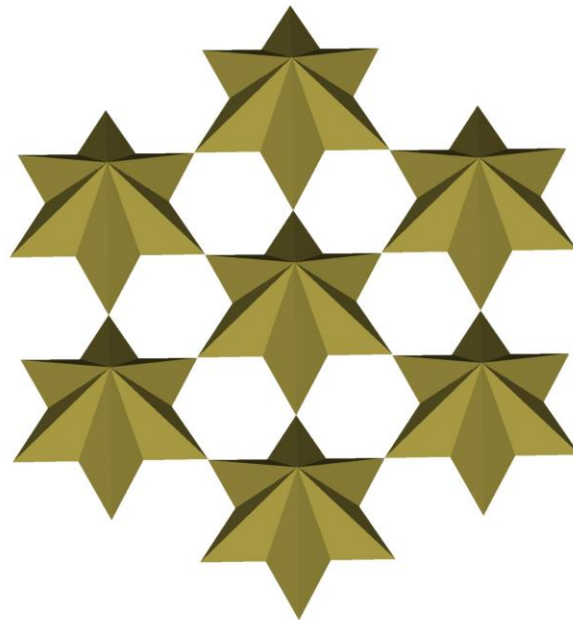

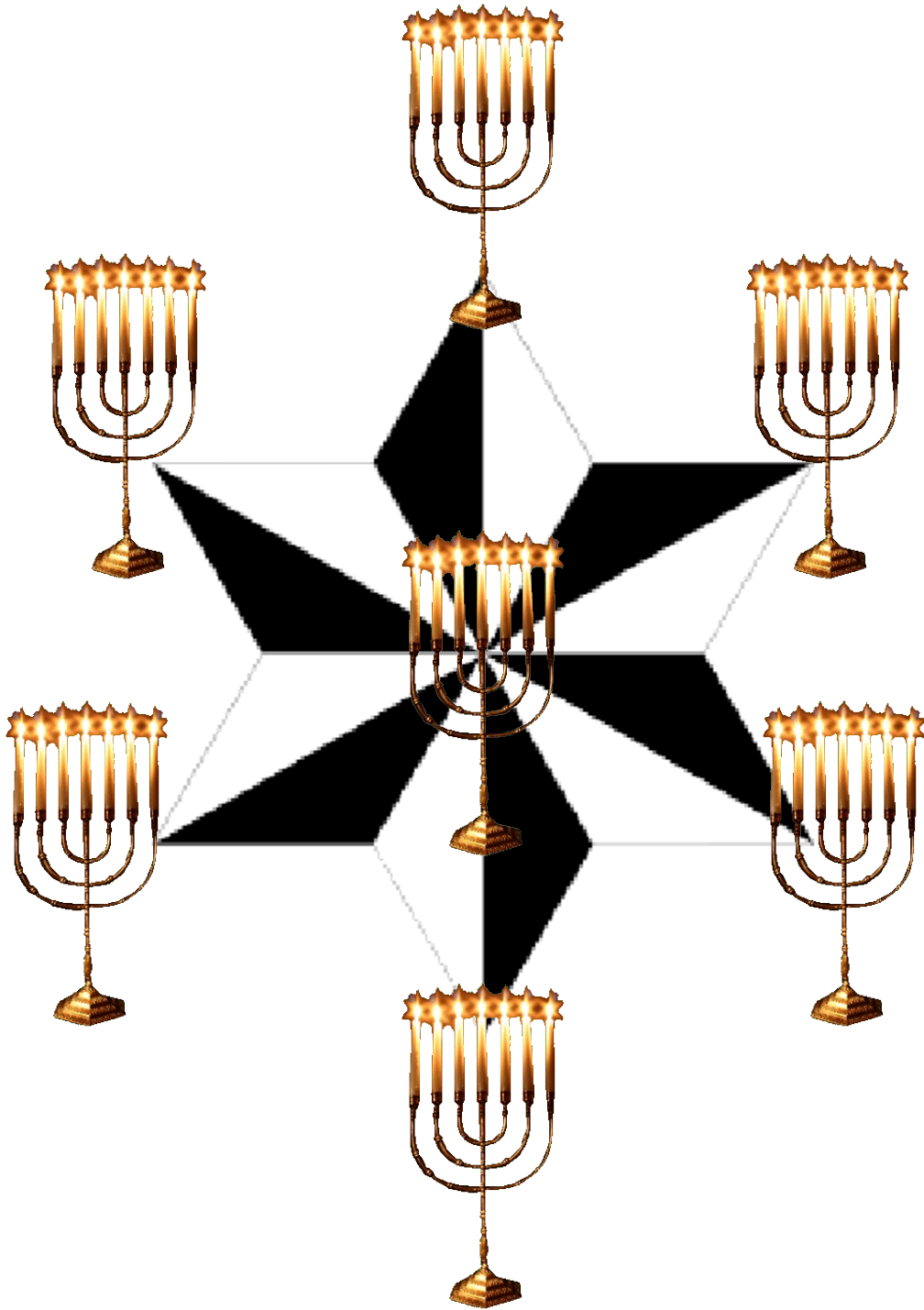
