WHO IS JUDAS ISCARIOT'S FATHER?

Matthew 10:4, "Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him."

Mark 3:18-19, "And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and <u>Simon</u> the Canaanite, And <u>Judas Iscariot</u>, which also betrayed him: and they went into an house."

Luke 6:15-16, "Matthew and Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, and <u>Simon</u> called **Zelotes**, And Judas the brother of James, and <u>Judas Iscariot</u>, which also was the traitor."

John 6:70-71, "Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil? He spake of <u>Judas Iscariot</u> the son of <u>Simon</u>: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve."

John 12:4, "Then saith one of his disciples, **Judas Iscariot, Simon's son**, which should betray him,"

John 13:26," Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to **Judas Iscariot**, the son of Simon."

Judas Iscariot's father was one called Simon, the implication is that it was Simon the Canaanite who was called Zelotes. The way that the statements are about Judas' father is like we would know who that is and in the context Simon Zelotes and Simon the Canaanite is the same person showing up in the list with Judas Iscariot.

The Simon's in the Bible:

Acts 1:13, "And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus, and <u>Simon Zelotes</u>, and Judas the brother of James." This Simon is the only possible candidate for the father of Judas Iscariot.

Mark 3:16, "And **Simon** he surnamed **Peter**" Not the Simon that was the Father Judas Iscariot.

Mark 6:3, "Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, **the brother of** James, and Joses, and of Juda, and <u>Simon</u>? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him." Not the Simon that was the Father Judas Iscariot.

Mark 14:3, "And being in Bethany in the house of <u>Simon</u> the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured it on his head." Not the Simon that was the Father Judas Iscariot.

Mark 15:21, "And they **compel** one **Simon** a **Cyrenian**, who passed by, coming out of the country, **the father of Alexander and Rufus**, **to bear his cross**." Not the Simon that was the Father Judas Iscariot.

Acts 8:9, "But there was a certain man, called <u>Simon</u>, which beforetime in **the** same city used **sorcery**, and **bewitched** the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:" Not the Simon that was the Father Judas Iscariot.

Acts 10:32, "Send therefore to Joppa, and call hither Simon, whose surname is Peter; he is lodged in the house of one **Simon** a tanner by the sea side: who, when he cometh, shall speak unto thee." Not the Simon that was the Father Judas Iscariot.

Ruling out all the Simons but one, it looks like Simon Zelotes and Simon the Canaanite is in fact the father of Judas Iscariot. In fact the Bible NEVER says Judas Iscariot is the Son of Perdition. It is assumed:

Is Judas the <u>son</u> of perdition?

John 17:12 "While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but **the son of perdition**; that the scripture might be fulfilled." The name Judas Iscariot does not show up in the chapter. The Lord has kept ME in his name and I am one of the ones that was given to the Lord to keep, and not lost. So the son of perdition could be a future person.

Acts 1:25, "That he may take part of this ministry and apostleship, from which <u>Judas</u> by transgression fell, <u>that he might</u> <u>go to his own place</u>." The assumption of this is that his OWN place is Hell that belongs to Judas because Judas is really Satan incarnate. But the passage does NOT say that. An own place can be a statement not of ownership, but a place where he belongs like all lost people who die in their sins. They all go to their own place. Hell may have been made for the devil and his angels, so to make that a statement for Judas' case is to make it for every man that goes to hell. The in fact is the case because all lost people go to hell, and therefore hell is their own place because they lose their own soul there. Further, they were all "of the devil" as we will see.

Is Judas the son of Satan?

Luke 22:2-6, "And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people. <u>Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot</u>, being of the number of the twelve. And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them. And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money. And he promised, and sought opportunity to betray him unto them in the absence of the multitude." Satan entered into Judas, so why would he have to do that if Judas was already Satan incarnate?

John 13:2, "And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;" Satan entered into Judas, so why would he have to do that if Judas was already Satan incarnate?

John 13:26-27, "Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to <u>Judas Iscariot</u>, <u>the son of Simon</u>. And <u>after the sop Satan entered into him</u>. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly." So Judas Iscariot is the son of Satan? Or is it Simon. After the sop, Satan entered into him. So he was not Satan incarnate. The son of perdition IS Satan incarnate, but Judas was NOT.

Is Judas Iscariot a devil? Or is the statement one of demonic intent in the heart; a heart usable by Satan?

Matthew 10:8, "Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give." All the apostles were sent out to do this: even Judas Iscariot.

Parable: Mark 3:23-25, "And he called them unto him, and said unto them in parables, How can <u>Satan cast out Satan</u>? And if a kingdom be <u>divided against itself</u>, <u>that kingdom cannot stand</u>. And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand."

John 6:70-71, "Jesus answered them, **Have not I chosen you twelve, and <u>one of you is a devil</u>?** He spake of <u>Judas</u> <u>Iscariot the son of Simon</u>: <u>for he it was that should betray him</u>, being one of the twelve." The implication is that Judas was a devil because he betrayed Jesus Christ, not that he was BORN a devil or a devil incarnate.

John 18:2-6, "And <u>Judas</u> also, which betrayed him, **knew the place**: for Jesus ofttimes resorted thither with his disciples. <u>Judas then, having received a band of men</u> and <u>officers</u> from the <u>chief priests</u> and <u>Pharisees, cometh thither with lanterns and torches and weapons</u>. Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, Whom seek ye? They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, <u>I am he</u>. And <u>Judas</u> also, which

betrayed him, stood with them. As soon then as he had said unto them, <u>I am he</u>, <u>they went backward</u>, and <u>fell to the</u> ground." They all fell backwards including Judas.

Luke 10:18, "And he said unto them, I beheld <u>Satan</u> <u>as <u>lightning fall</u> <u>from heaven</u>." Jesus Christ said this. Why would he not tell us that Judas is Satan incarnate if he was?</u>

Who all is of the devil?

Zechariah 3:2, "And the LORD said unto Satan, The LORD rebuke thee, <u>O Satan</u>; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: is not this a <u>brand plucked out of the fire</u>?" Isn't it a strange thing the use of "O" when dealing with Satan: Isaiah 14:12, "How art thou fallen from heaven, <u>O Lucifer</u>, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!" and Ezekiel 28:16, "By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, <u>O covering cherub</u>, from the midst of the stones of fire." Must be just mere coincidence with the "O" Thing.

Jude 1:23, "And others <u>save</u> with fear, <u>pulling them out of the fire</u>; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh." So is this Satan getting saved as a brand plucked out of the fire? How can the Lord lose someone that he has not saved? All men are already lost.

John 8:44, "Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a <u>murderer</u> from the <u>beginning</u>, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he <u>speaketh a lie</u>, he speaketh of <u>his</u> <u>own</u>: for he is a <u>liar</u>, and <u>the father of it</u>." Who is "of the devil"? Who is it that the devil is their father? Who is the devil a father of? Might it be "a liar".

1 Timothy 3:7, "Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; **lest he <u>fall</u> into reproach** and <u>the snare</u> of the <u>devil</u>." Is the snare of the devil being born of the devil?

2 Timothy 2:26, "And <u>that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the</u> devil, who are <u>taken captive by him at his will.</u>" How do you recover yourself out of the snare of the?

Ephesians 2:2-3, "Wherein **in time past** ye walked according to the course of this world, **according to the <u>prince of the power of the air</u>**, the spirit that now worketh in **the <u>children of disobedience</u>**: Among whom also we all had our conversation **in times past** in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature **the <u>children of wrath</u>**, even as others." What time past is this talking about? A saved person's past; prior to their salvation?

1 John 3:8-10, "<u>He that committeth sin is of the devil</u>; for <u>the devil sinneth from the beginning</u>. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God. In this the children of God are manifest, and <u>the children of the devil</u>: whosoever doeth <u>not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.</u>" So if you sin you are of the devil; and who is the children of the Devil. Who is it that are the children of the devil?

1 John 3:12, "**Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one**, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous." If Judas was the son of perdition, who was Cain; he was after all the Man of Sin.

Revelation 12:9, "And the <u>great dragon</u> was cast out, that <u>old serpent</u>, called <u>the Devil</u>, and <u>Satan</u>, which deceiveth the whole world: he was <u>cast</u> out <u>into the earth</u>, and <u>his angels</u> were cast out with him."

Jesus Christ is the ONLY person to face off with the Devil and overcome!

Matthew 4:1, "Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil."

Luke 4:2, "Being forty days tempted of the devil..."

Mark 1:13, "And he was there in the wilderness **forty days**, **tempted of Satan**; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him."

We have the power IN CHRIST to overcome the Devil.

Acts 5:3, "But Peter said, Ananias, why hath <u>Satan filled thine heart</u> to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?" Why didn't they overcome?

John 13:2, "And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;" Satan entered into Judas, so why would he have to do that if Judas was already Satan incarnate? So what is the difference with Satan filled the hearts of Ananias and his wife to lie and the devil putting into the heart of Judas Iscariot Simon's son to betray Jesus Christ? The trouble is the heart of man: Jeremiah 17:9, "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" The Devil knows a wicked heart: all he has to do is plant a thought and watch that heart turn to the wickedness that is already in it.

2 Corinthians 2:11, "<u>Lest Satan should get an advantage of us</u>: for we are not ignorant of his devices." What are Satan's Devices? They are NOT lying, Stealing, Cheating, and such like. Those are man's devices. Satan is much more subtle:

2 Corinthians 11:3-4, "But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him." Notice Satan is the serpent that beguiled Eve:

2 Corinthians 11:13-15, "For such are <u>false apostles</u>, <u>deceitful workers</u>, <u>transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ</u>. And no marvel; for <u>Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light</u>. Therefore it is no great thing if <u>his ministers</u> also <u>be transformed</u> as <u>the ministers of righteousness</u>; whose end shall be according to their works." Satan can transform into an angel of light, or a serpent, or whatever would deceive YOUR wicked deceitful heart. Where did Satan LIE to Eve in the deception? Genesis 3:1, "Now the serpent was **more subtil** than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, <u>Yea</u>, <u>hath God said</u>, <u>Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden</u>?" It was Eve that lied! Genesis 3:2, "And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, **neither shall ye touch it**, lest ye die." No; God did NOT say that!

Satan is very tricky and subtil. Subtil: So slight as to be difficult to detect or describe; elusive; not obvious; difficult to understand or comprehend. Subtilty would be the attribute of someone that is subtil. Subtil is also used in: 2 Samuel 13:3 & Proverbs 7:10. Subtilty is also used in: Genesis 27:35; 2 Kings 10:19; Proverbs 1:4; Matthew 26:4 & Acts 13:10.

1 Thessalonians 2:18, "Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; <u>but Satan hindered us</u>." How did Satan hinder Paul? And if Paul can be hindered by Satan, you don't think Satan can hinder you? Paul warned Timothy about Satan's ability over the saints: 1 Timothy 5:15, "For some are <u>already turned aside after Satan</u>." So you better not think to highly of yourself that is a first step to Satan hindering you: 2 Timothy 2:25-26, "In meekness instructing those <u>that oppose themselves</u>; if God peradventure will give them repentance <u>to the acknowledging of the truth</u>; And that <u>they may recover themselves</u> out of the <u>snare of the devil</u>, who are <u>taken captive by him at his will</u>."

First rule of engagement: **NEVER** underestimate the power of the enemy. Or into their hands you put yourselves. Some Christians never grow up in the Lord and remain just like the lost.

2 Timothy 3:2-5, "For men shall be <u>lovers</u> of <u>their own selves</u>, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, <u>Ever learning</u>, and <u>never able to come to the knowledge of the truth</u>. Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also <u>resist the truth</u>: men of <u>corrupt minds</u>, <u>reprobate</u> <u>concerning the faith</u>. But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was."

These are the ones who and the children of the wicked one (Matthew 13:38), and the children of disobedience (Ephesians 2:2, 6; Colossians 3:6), and the children of wrath (Ephesians 2:3), and children of darkness (John 1:5; 3:19; Acts 26:18; Ephesians 5:8; Colossians 1:13; 1 Thessalonians 5:5; 1 Peter 2:9), and the children of the devil (1 John 3:10). They do, and enjoy the of the things of man a not the things of God: "...savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men." Matthew 16:23; which the list shows plainly and coincide with the works of the flesh: Galatians 5:19-21, "Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God." But the lost are not saved, they do not have an inheritance to lose.

Which also coincide with false prophets and false teachers (2 Peter 2:1) and are cursed children (2 Peter 2:14) and are ungodly men (Jude 1:4) and have gone in the way of Cain (Jude 1:11) and ran greedily after the error of Balaam, and if that weren't enough to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever. (Jude 1:13) These are LOST false teachers.

Jude 1:15-19, "To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him. These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage. But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ; How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit." They have NOT the Spirit of God and are therefore LOST.

Jesus Christ is the ONLY one that is HOLY. It is to HIM to whom we look for life, light and salvation because He is the One True God: 1 John 5:20, "And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we

may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life."

The Seven "I AM's"

- 1. John 6:48, "I am that bread of life."
- 2. John 8:12, "...I am the light of the world..."
- 3. John 10:7, "...I am the door of the sheep."
- 4. John 10:11, "I am the good shepherd..."
- 5. John 11:25, "...I am the resurrection, and the life..."
- 6. John 14:6, "...I am the way, the truth, and the life..."
- 7. John 15:1, "I am the true vine..."

He is the TRUE Vine; and there is a false vine, it is a bitter vine, and a false god:

False Vine:

Deuteronomy 32:17-18, "They sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not. Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee."

Deuteronomy 32:31-33, "For <u>their rock</u> is not as <u>our Rock</u>, even our enemies themselves being judges. For their <u>vine</u> is of the <u>vine</u> of <u>Sodom</u>, and of the <u>fields</u> of <u>Gomorrah</u>: their <u>grapes</u> are <u>grapes</u> of <u>gall</u>, their <u>clusters</u> are <u>bitter</u>: Their <u>wine</u> is the <u>poison</u> of <u>dragons</u>, and the <u>cruel venom</u> of <u>asps</u>."

Judas Iscariot was a man born of Simon (whoever that was) not Satan. The son of perdition is that same spirit that drove Judas to betray the Lord Jesus Christ; but the man Judas was not the son of Satan. The spirit behind all lost people is the same spirit of the devil, and devils. It is the spirit of antichrist, which are many. Judas was one of them as he never was converted to a Christian; instead he murdered Jesus Christ and then himself. If he was a devil incarnate he was not have killed himself; he would have reveled in his victory. It is sad to see how twisted some people teach the Bible. The spirit of Cain was antichrist and that spirit can be followed down through the ages: Ham, Nimrod, Saul, Goliath, etc. all these have that spirit of antichrist, anti-God, anti-bible, anti-good. It is that same spirit of evil, which prevails over all men to turn from their creator and offer a substitute to replace the Godhead. It doesn't have to be all bent towards Satan to be satanic; it can be just towards man and NOT towards God: Matthew 16:23, "But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men." And Mark 8:33, "But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things of man. All Satan has to do is get your eyes off the Lord and on yourself and he has won his victory over you.

The trouble is all people born in this life are no good; they are evil, wicked and vile. They are all SINNERS before a Holy God. The spirit of man is dead to God, and dies because of the sins of that individual. They have ALL followed Satan in the same path of SIN and rebellion against God. It is because of this, that the Bible says: 1 John 3:10, "In this the children of God are manifest, and **the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God**, neither he that loveth not his brother." The trouble with this is that most Christians cannot understand that they are BOTH! The sinner is the child of the devil and the born again spirit is the Child of God. The sinner does not righteousness while the spirit always does righteousness. YOU however are the SOUL, caught in the middle of the battle between the flesh (the sinner) and the spirit (the sinless). Choose sides! Your conscience awareness is YOU, the soul. If you are saved, you are in a battle between right and wrong; good and evil, God and Satan, the spirit and the flesh. You cannot serve two masters. Why halt you between two? Choose who you will serve. YOU WILL SERVE ONE OR THE OTHER. A child of the Devil will do

the works of the Devil: SIN. It was Lucifer who was the first sinner and became Satan; and he it was that deceived Eve to make the whole human race fall into darkness and sinful wretchedness. So in that manor all humans are children of Satan. Your birth is no good because you are born into that sinful line whose father is Satan, not Adam.

If you are lost, you are a child of the devil; and the lust of the devil you WILL do. You do not have a right spirit in you and you are the soul that is stuck to your flesh so that you are accountable for everything your body does, every sin, every thought, everything you love and every action. You are fallen short of perfection: you are fallen short of godliness, you are fallen short of righteousness, you are fallen short of God. You cannot do enough right to FIX the wrong and you cannot make up for ruined time without going back in time to alter it which is impossible. You are between a rock and a hard place: in the valley of decision. But yours is a decision of what to do about Jesus Christ: one who was perfect, godly, righteous, and God manifest in the flesh. He died in YOUR place to take your sin upon himself to become sin for you, and die to kill your sins in himself. You however, MUST choose to receive HIM as your saviour, to be safe from paying for your own sins in Hell Fire and Damnation.

About who is Judas' father was: Judas was like all lost men: he lost his soul and went to hell. His human spirit was dead to God and went back to God like all spirits do. The spirit he that he had that was an antichrist spirit of the Devil went out at his death to find a new home in someone else. His human father is given as Simon, not Satan. Someone is coming on the

seen soon; that will be THE antichrist, and he will be the son of Satan. There will be a time where he will reign on earth for several years. He will not only have that spirit of antichrist, but he will be the man of sin, the son of perdition. He is born of perdition, and will emulate the works of his father Satan.

Now to wrap this up let's deal with the spirits so that there is no misunderstanding. God made spirit beings, soul beings & body beings.

Angels:

Psalms 104:4, "Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire:" The term angel is the same as messenger. Spirit beings do not have souls, and can manifest physically in what appears to be a body, but is not sustained in the physical world, nor is it retained physically to the natural laws of physics. It is a spiritual body, and not a carnal body. The spirits include God, Angels, The sons of God, Seraphim, Cherubim, Teraphim, The Morning Stars, The Holy Ones, The Watchers, and some others.

The sons of God that Fell:

There were some Angels that fell in Genesis 6 called The sons of God. We know that these were angles by Jude 1:6, "And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day." These angels had children who were a race of hybrids that God never intended for them to come into being and this is the reason for the flood. This group had to be vanquished. However it is only the Angels that fell that were chained up, not their children. Their children that were "...mighty men which were of old, men of renown." Genesis 6:4. Drowned out, and on the other side of the flood became the disembodied spirits we know as devils. Some of which were recruited by Satan to be his angels. These are the gods of the nations in the Old & New Testament and the familiar spirits that were trying to regain bodies. Which when the Lord approached, he cast them out of the people.

The SOUL beings:

Genesis 2:7, "And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." The body that was formed from dust was not alive until God breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and his body became alive but Adam as not his body, he was the living soul inside. The trouble is that this soul and body were stuck together so that they both became alive at the time the breath of life entered into him. He has a living body and a living spirit; he is the living soul.

The Body Beings:

The Animals are body beings with a spirit; but they are their bodies, not their spirits. The Plants are body beings without their own spirit. The familiar spirits above can inhabit body beings but prefer humans, as plants cannot move around, and animals are incapable of speech and understanding.

All men are in the same boat: born in a sin cursed world with their body stuck to their soul, and as soon as they are born they start dying. There are spirits out in this world that want to inhabit you and take your soul to hell fire and damnation. John 3:7, "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again."
