Pentagramacostalism theology dictates that the SOUL in the Lord Jesus Christ MUST be the Father because they are the SAME person.

1 Timothy 3:16, "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory."

It said "God" not "God the Father" was manifest in the flesh...

John 1:1-4, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men."

The Word was WITH God and the Word WAS God, it never says the Word was the Father...

John 1:14, "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

The Word was made flesh, this is to take into account for being a man, with a body, soul and spirit as men are made flesh this way. But it never says the Father was made flesh.

Proverbs 30:4, "Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?"

SO, what is His name? And what is His Son's Name, if thou canst tell? But you CAN'T, because you think they are the same person! They must have the same Name!

Isaiah 53:10-12, "Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul

unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors."

But the SOUL of the Lord Jesus Christ went to HELL; and the FATHER did NOT! That soul was to bear that sin in a death like a lost man and it got dumped off into that hell and the Lord showed up there brighter than hell fire and damnation without sin, and flew across that great gulf. But you can't tell can you?

It is obvious to a Bible Believer that the Trinity is the nature of the Godhead; in fact the word Godhead appears THREE times in the King's Bible.

John 5:37, "And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape."

Godhead? Do you know what the word MEANS? It means God is a singular plurality! God is both ONE and ∞ (INFINATE) at the same time. You have no idea WHO you are dealing with when dealing with the Godhead!

Acts 17:29, "Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device."

Romans 1:20, "For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:"

Colossians 2:9, "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily."

Consider that YOU might be wrong about this; and God's nature is "...these three are one" like 1 John 5:7 says it is after all.
